Sir,

I have the honour to submit my report on the working of the Indian Companies Act, 1913, combined with the Societies Registration Act, 1860, the Provident Insurance Societies Act, 1912, and the Indian Life Assurance Companies Act, 1912, and attach thereto several statements showing the statistics of public and private companies separately in the forms prescribed therefor.

The Indian Companies, Act, 1913.

2. The year opened with 583 working companies,—564 limited by shares and 19 limited by guarantee. The number in the former class rose to 743 by the addition of 208 new companies and deduction of 29 companies therefrom. There was no registration and addition to the latter class which was reduced by two. Thus the number of companies at work at the close of the year was 760 made up of 743 share capital and 17 non-share capital companies.

New Registration.

3. Of the 208 new companies registered during the year 158 were public and 50 private against 35 companies registered in the previous year. The table below affords a comparison of the registrations in the years 1918-19 and 1919-20 classified according to the nature of the business they have undertaken :—

The large increase in registration had been anticipated by Mr. Mellor and myself as a result of the cessation of hostilities but the Indian Companies Registration-Act (XII of 1918) which was repealed on the 24th September 1919 retarded the registration in the early part of the year under review. On the repeal of that Act a boom in company promotion set in both in new industries and in the conversion of established concerns into limited companies.

4. The Safety Insurance Company, Limited, floated by a Turkish Subject and refused registration in 1918, was registered during the year.

Companies ceased to exist.

5. Thirty-one companies ceased to exist during the period under report. Amongst these there were 23 public and six private companies with and two public companies without share capital. Of the 31 companies three were wound up by Court, 19 went into voluntary liquidation and nine were removed from the register under section 247.

6. Sixteen companies were dissolved during the year. They were comprised of one company that closed its business and finally disappeared in the year and the remainder were in course of liquidation on or before 31st March 1919 of which two were dissolved by Courts, 11 wound up completely by liquidators and two struck off the register under section 247.

Alterations in Capital.

7. The noticeable feature in this new registration was the great increase in the average authorised capital of the new companies as compared to the companies previously registered. This, I believe, was partly due to the decreased purchasing value of the rupee, partly to the ease with which subscriptions were obtained in the market and partly to a realisation that many of the older companies on the register were very much under-capitalised. The authorised capital of the companies registered during the year amounted to Rs. 1,33,41,43,518 as against Rs. 10,70,85,000 in the preceding year. The authorised capital of companies registered this year exceed the total authorised capital of all the companies working at the close of the preceding year by Rs. 41,37,17,313. The average registered capital of the new concerns works out at over 64 lakhs per company of which a large portion is said to have been subscribed. 8. Of the older companies 128 increased their capital by Rs. 5,03,10,000 as against 137 companies and Rs. 8,42,00,250 in the previous year.

9. The returns received during the year showed an advance in the subscribed and paid up capital which rose by Rs. 10,08,76,815 and Rs. 4,43,68,575, respectively, as against Rs. 15,65,48,640, and Rs. 5,55,03,569,

respectively, in the previous year; but these figures do not include returns in respect of the new companies which cannot be received until at least a year after registration.

10. Only eleven companies reduced their capital, during the year. The total reductions in the authorised, subscribed and paid up capitals amounted to Rs. 95,73,075, Rs. 31,10,375 and Rs. 5,25,011 as against reductions of Rs. 92,41,000, Rs. 45,67,800 and Rs. 7,72,212, respectively, in the preceding year.

Alteration in the number of members.

11. The number of members in the case of companies having no share capital was reduced by 20 owing to collapse of 2 companies and consequently the number at the close of the year was 12,650.

Alteration in classification.

12. The following companies changed from public companies into private companies and *vice versa*.

Branch Registers.

14. The provisions of section 41 of the Act in respect of British Registers were not availed of by any company.

Registration of mortgages and returns of allotments.

15. So far as registration of mortgages or debentures is concerned the provisions of section 109 are as a rule duly complied with by the companies

themselves or by their creditors. But as regards returns of allotments there has been considerable difficulty owing to ignorance of the provisions of the Act and an apparent shortage of clerical labour which has necessitated referring companies to the Court for an extension of time. Circulars and reminders issued by this office have, however, improved matters latterly.

Publication of Form G.

16. The offices of the companies referred to in section 136 were visited and in all cases the section was found to have been satisfied.

Auditors.

17. On 31st March 1920 the number of persons holding certificates from Government for auditing accounts of companies under section 144 was 62 as against 53 in the year preceding.

Foreign Companies.

18. Prosecutions.—

23. During the year under review it became clear that the provisions of the Companies Act as regards prospectuses were imperfectly understood and a number of advertisements, etc., were published which were prospectuses within the meaning of the Act but which had not been registered. I accordingly prosecuted in two cases in Ahmedabad in which the respective Managers were fined Rs. 460 and Rs. 1,040 and two cases in Bombay in which the Companies were fined Re. 1 each and since these convictions have not had any more breaches of the law in this respect brought to my notice.

Financial Results.

24. During the year under reference the revenue from fees amounted to Rs. 1,44,955-3-6 against Rs. 23,200-9-6 in the preceding year. The subjoined
