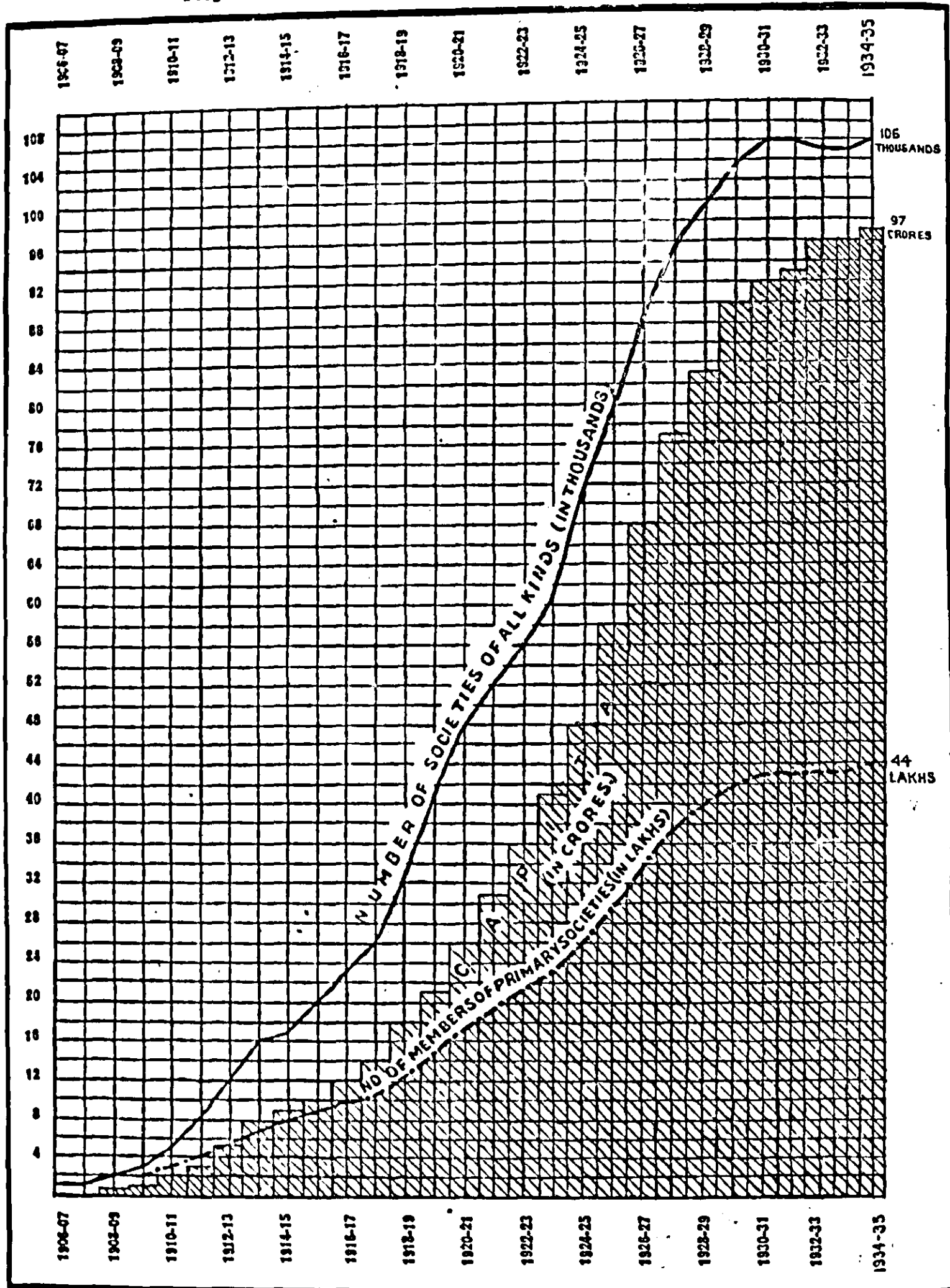

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

This is the seventeenth of the series of the publication "Statements showing progress of the Co-operative Movement in India" (re-styled "Statistical Statements relating to the Co-operative Movement in India" since 1927-28) issued by this Department under instructions from the Government of India in the Department of Education, Health and Lands. The statements have been compiled, with certain modifications, on the lines recommended by the Committee on Co-operation in India held in 1915, and are arranged as shown in the table of contents on the opposite page.

2. The **Abstract Tables** indicate some of the leading features of progress in the co-operative movement during the year 1934-35. They show the numbers of societies and members and the amount of working capital, both for the whole of India and by Provinces and States. The progress since 1905-07 is illustrated graphically in the diagram in the frontispiece.

In *Abstract Tables II and III*, when comparing the figures for the years 1915-16 to 1934-35 with those for years prior to 1915-16, the following points should be borne in mind:—

- (i) that in the case of Guaranteeing Unions and Re-insurance Societies the number of members represents the number of affiliated societies and not the number of individual members included in such societies;
- (ii) that with effect from 1917-18 individual members of Central and Provincial Banks, Banking Unions, and Guaranteeing Unions are not included in the total number of members shown in Abstract Tables II(a) and II(b) as it is assumed that these have already figured once as members of an agricultural or non-agricultural primary society;
- (iii) that the figures for working capital given in Abstract Table III do not include the working capital of Unions and Insurance and Re-insurance Societies as these are not furnished in Statements D, E and F, respectively;
- (iv) that with effect from the year 1915-16 the loans and deposits of society-members have been transferred in Abstract Table III from the head "Loans and deposits held at the end of the year from members" to the head "Loans and deposits held at the end of the year from societies", and that the latter head no longer includes loans and deposits from Provincial or Central Banks for which a separate head has been provided; and
- (v) that with effect from the same year (1915-16) the figure given against the head "Loans and deposits held at the end of the year from non-members and other sources", includes all loans and deposits held by Central and Provincial Banks from individuals, Joint Stock Banks, and other sources not included against the preceding headings.

3. The **General Statements** give a detailed record of the main statistics relating to co-operative societies in the several provinces of British India (with the exception of Baluchistan, where the co-operative movement has, as yet, made little progress), and in the Indian States of Mysore, Baroda, Hyderabad, Bhopal, Gwalior, Indore, Kashmir, Travancore and Cochin for the year 1934-35. The sources of the statistics are the statements furnished by provincial Registrars of Co-operative Societies, and by the Indian States concerned. They relate, in the case of Bihar and Orissa to the year ending 31st December, in the case of Bombay and Assam to the year ending 31st March, and in the case of Madras, Bengal, the United Provinces, Burma, the Central Provinces and Berar, Coorg, Ajmer-Merwara, Mysore, Gwalior, Indore and Bhopal to the year ending 30th June. The returns for the Hyderabad State refer to the year ending 7th July, those for the Punjab, Delhi, the North-West Frontier Province and Baroda to the year ending 31st July, those for Travancore to the year ending 14th June, those for Cochin to the year ending 16th August and those for Kashmir to the year ending 15th September.

Statement A exhibits the operations of Central Banks and shows figures separately for Provincial Banks and for Central Banks including District Banks, Banking Unions, and all other societies constituted with the object of lending to individual societies and tapping deposits from a larger area than that of the primary agricultural or non-agricultural society. The figures for Unions other than Banking Unions have been excluded from this statement and are shown in a separate Statement D. The total number of Banks during the year 1934-35 rose from 613 in the previous year to 625 with a membership

and working capital of 196,508 and Rs. 41,04 lakhs, as against 197,633 and Rs. 41,88 lakhs, respectively, in 1933-34. The net profit resulting from the operations of these Banks also increased from Rs. 53,48,152 in 1933-34 to Rs. 56,36,487 in 1934-35.

Statements B and C show the operations of the agricultural and non-agricultural primary societies in the same form. It will be observed that the number of such societies increased during the year from 92,226 agricultural and 11,118 non-agricultural to 92,920 agricultural and 11,428 non-agricultural societies respectively. The number excludes insurance societies in both cases. The total membership and working capital at the close of the year were as follows:—

Statement D shows the operations of unions, other than Banking Unions, which either supervise only or both supervise and guarantee. Unions which do banking business are classed as Central Banks and are included in *Statement A*.

Statement E shows the operations of Cattle Insurance Societies in Bombay and Burma and of Non-Agricultural Insurance Societies in Bombay, Bengal, Madras, the United Provinces, Indore and Travancore.

Statement F exhibits statistics pertaining to Central Re-insurance Societies, that is to say, societies which, in return for a definite share of the insurance premia of the affiliated societies, undertake a definite share of their risks. Societies of this type at present exist only in Burma.
