1937-1938.

Sir,

I have the honour to submit the Annual Administration Report on the working of Co-operative Societies in the Province of Bombay for the year ending 30th June 1938.

#### I. ADMINISTRATION.

##### GAZETTED STAFF.

*Registrar.*—The gazetted staff of the Department saw several changes during the year under report. I was in charge of the office of the Registrar till 11th June 1938, when Mr. S. M. Ikram, I.C.S., who held the post of the Deputy Registrar took over charge from me and acted as Registrar for the remainder of the year.

*Deputy Registrar.*—Mr. S. M. Ikram, I.C.S., held the post till 11th June 1938 when he was appointed to act for me. Thereafter the post was held in abeyance till the end of the year.

*Personal Assistant.*—The post of the Personal Assistant to the Registrar which was retrenched in 1932 as a measure of economy was revived under Government Resolution, Revenue Department, No. 6734/33, dated 12th May 1938, and Mr. D. A. Shah, Assistant Registrar, was appointed in the post from 9th June 1938.

*Assistant Registrars.*—The post of the Assistant Registrar, Land Mortgage Banks, who was doing duty as Personal Assistant to the Registrar, was abolished from 9th June 1933, and the work was entrusted to the Deputy Registrar. The post was, however, again revived from 24th June 1933, in place of the post of the Deputy Registrar which was held in abeyance. The temporary post of the Assistant Registrar in charge of Co-operative Training and Education terminated from 1st August 1937, and Mr. Nayak who held the post was placed on special duty for a period of three and a half months for work in connection with the revision of the Co-operative Societies Manual in the post created under Government Resolution, Revenue Department, No. 6480, dated 17th June 1937. Under Government Resolution, Revenue Department, No. 7353/33, dated 15th February 1938, a post of Assistant Registrar was created for a period of three months for work in connection with the reorganization of the co-operative movement and Mr. D. A. Shah was appointed to hold it. Mr. Shah was also placed in charge of the scheme for Co-operative Training and Education in addition to his other duties on termination of the special post held by Mr. Nayak.
