Sir,

I have the honour to submit the report on the working of the Indian Companies Act VI of 1882, in the Bombay Presidency, for the official year 1911-1912, with the ten statistical statements prescribed by the Government of India.

2. The following table shews the total number of documents registered under different denominations during the year 1911-1912 as compared with that of the preceding year :—

From the above it will be seen that there is a decrease under three heads. The lesser number of companies and societies registered in the year explains the decrease in the number of the notices of situation of offices.

3. The number of companies registered during the year has, as observed, fallen short by 17. Of the 39 new companies, 38 have a share capital and one has no capital, being a Provident Insurance Society limited by guarantee. In addition to these, two—one a flour mill and the other a coal mining company—were transferred from other provinces, thus bringing the number of new companies on the register during the year under report to 41.

4. The companies limited by shares are classified as under and shew comparison with the similar companies in the previous year :—

From the above statement it will appear that there is a noticeable increase under "Banking" and a decrease under "Trading" and "Mills and Presses." Of the banking companies 4 are in Bombay where it appears that such a business is now more attractive. Owing to the failure of the late Dwarkadas Dharamsey, who was the Agent and Director of several mills, whereby a good number of depositors in his mills lost their money, the public now prefer depositing their money in the banks rather than with the mills; hence the banks get deposits freely and at lesser interest which they advance to the public as well as to the mills on good security and higher interest. The other 5 banking concerns are in the mofussil and are minor ones. The decrease in the "Trading" may be explained by the abnormal number of such companies registered in the previous year and which do not seem to have attained good results, no less than 4 of them being already wound up; and from the registers it appears that 7 of the remaining have not been able to start business. The decline in mills and presses may be explained as under :—

Though there are a sufficient number of mills and presses the industry is still a paying concern, and this year too there would have been the usual annual addition of such companies to those on the registers but the mode of management of the agents, etc., of some mills, recently disclosed in certain proceedings in the High Court, has greatly shaken the confidence of the public and it will be some time before this confidence is restored and the public induced to subscribe as freely to the capital of such new companies. It may also be noted that the mills are not able to work with their capital alone and that they have been greatly helped in their business by the deposits made with them by the public as stated above. Since a larger portion of these have now been withdrawn for the reasons given above many companies have had to borrow on the security of the mill property.

5. There was only one company limited by guarantee, which is more in the nature of a Provident Insurance Society, registered during the year against 3 in the year previous. The decrease may be due to the introduction of the Provident Insurance Societies Bill which has now passed into Law.

6. The number of companies that went into liquidation during the year under report was 35. Of these, one was finally dissolved, which together with the four companies that were under liquidation on or before 31st March 1911 and were finally dissolved this year makes a total of 5. One Provident Society limited by guarantee also went into liquidation.

7. The number of companies existing at the close of the year was 575 with a nominal capital of Rs. 46,68,45,750 and a paid up capital of Rs. 26,78,52,519 against 570 with a nominal capital of Rs. 45,49,16,550 and a paid up capital of Rs. 22,76,16,650. This indicates an increase of 5 companies with a nominal capital of Rs. 1,19,29,200 and a paid up capital of Rs. 4,02,35,869. The total

number of companies having no share capital that stood working at the close of the year was 24 against the same number in the previous year.

8. Eleven companies increased their nominal capital by Rs. 31,50,000, one hundred and two their issued capital by Rs. 4,21,02,940 and one hundred and thirty-one companies their paid up capital by Rs. 4,38,58,776.

9. Four companies reduced their nominal capital by Rs. 8,50,000, twelve companies reduced their issued nominal capital by Rs. 3,25,070 and nine companies reduced their paid up capital by Rs. 73,305.

10. The following is a comparative statement illustrating the various heads under which fees were realized in each of the two years 1910-1911 and 1911-1912:—

The above table discloses a decrease of Rs. 7,961 in the receipts of the year under report, which is mainly due to the lesser registrations of new companies and societies than those in the previous year as explained above. The increase under Special Resolutions is due to the larger increase in capital effected thereby.

11. The expenditure for the year under report amounted to Rs. 2,324-15 against Rs. 2,991-12 in the preceding year. If the refund—a rare occurrence—granted in the previous year under Government Resolution, Revenue Department, No. 9791, dated 26th October 1910, of a sum of Rs. 1,008 be taken into account, the expenditure still exceeds that of the previous year by Rs. 341-3 and this is due chiefly to the grant of the Royal Visit bonus and a larger expenditure incurred under the head of Travelling allowance, etc.

12. No advantage has yet been taken of the provisions of Act IV of 1900. The Act has now been in force for 12 years without any company having availed itself of its provisions. The reason of this appears to be that the companies think it an useless expenditure to maintain such a branch office when the capital can easily be subscribed in India and the Act does not make it compulsory on such companies to open such offices for such of the shareholders who are residents in the United Kingdom.

13. Two prosecutions were instituted for infringement of the provisions of sections 69 and 74. The company prosecuted under section 69 was convicted and fined and the Director and Manager in the case under section 74 was warned and acquitted.
