SEASON AND CROP REPORT OF THE STATE OF BOMBAY FOR THE YEAR 1949-50.

CHAPTER I—SEASON.

1. The agricultural season of 1949-50 was fairly satisfactory over a greater part of the State. The pre-monsoon showers were received in adequate quantities in the Karnatak, Konkan and parts of the Deccan and facilitated preliminary field operations. The rainfall received in the month of June was below normal almost throughout the State, and *kharif* sowings were accordingly restricted to places where these rains were received in adequate quantities. The precipitation in July was quite adequate throughout the State, except in parts of the Deccan and Karnatak, where more rainfall was needed both for the completion of *kharif* sowings and for promoting the growth of seedlings in areas where early sowings had been done. The rainfall in August was generally below normal. The rainfall in September was quite adequate, but in some parts of the State it was excessive. The heavy rainfall received in September adversely affected grain formation in *bajri* crop and caused lodging of paddy crop in some places in the Surat District. These rains also hampered interculturing operations and sowing of *rabi jowar* in the Broach District. In the Deccan, the crops which were ready for harvest, were damaged by water-logged conditions in low-lying areas, whilst the young *jowar* seedlings were washed away in many places in the Sholapur District, necessitating re-sowing of *jowar* crops. Standing crops also were damaged in the Bijapur District and in places in the Belgaum and Dharwar Districts. In the Konkan Division, early sown paddy crops were affected to a varying degree by the heavy rains. The rainfall received in the month of October was generally well distributed, except in North Deccan and the Surat District in Gujarat, where these rains were excessive and proved harmful to the crops. In Khandesh and the Nasik District, *bajri*, groundnut, *jowar* and paddy crops were affected by the heavy rains as also paddy crops in the Surat District. Elsewhere in the State, the condition of the *kharif* crops was satisfactory. The rainfall in the month of November was light. There was practically no rain in the months of December and January, whilst the rainfall in February was received in quite substantial quantities in the Ahmednagar District in the Deccan and parts of the Karnatak. As a result of the deficiency of rainfall in the Deccan, the outturn of *rabi* crops in the Poona and Sholapur Districts was reduced considerably. An intensive cold wave which swept over almost all the districts of the State in the month of February damaged fruit, vegetable, cotton, tobacco, wheat and gram crops to varying degrees in many parts of Gujarat and North Deccan. It also caused considerable damage to mango blossoms in the Ratnagiri District. No damage to crops was reported from the Karnatak. The climatic conditions experienced during the year were conducive to the development of insect pests and plant diseases, which caused damage to the crops.

2. *Distribution of rainfall.*—Table I (pages 20-21) compares the rainfall during the year under report, with the average annual rainfall at each headquarters station in the State. The average rainfall figures for each station were obtained from the India Meteorological Department. The following observations may be made from the study of this table:—

Kharif rains.—The *kharif* rains exceeded the average rainfall at all the district headquarters stations in the Konkan, at Surat in Gujarat, at Dhulia, Jalgaon, Ahmednagar and Sholapur in the Deccan and at Bijapur in the Karnataka. At other places in the State, these rains were either normal or below normal.

Rabi rains.—The *rabi* rains also exceeded the average rainfall at Surat in Gujarat, at Dhulia and Nasik in the Deccan and in the hilly tracts of the Karnataka. These rains were either normal or below normal at other stations, except at Kaira in Gujarat where no *rabi* rains were received.

Hot weather rains.—These rains were not experienced at any of the district headquarters stations in Gujarat, at Nasik and Ahmednagar in the Deccan and at Thini and Alibag in North Konkan. At the other stations, they were below the normal precipitation, except at Ratnagiri and Karwar in the Konkan, at Poona, Satara and in the hilly tracts of the Deccan and at Dharwar in the Karnataka, where they exceeded the average.

CHAPTER II—AREA CULTIVATED AND UNCULTIVATED

(Table II, pages 22-28)

(Appendix A, page 14)

3. In 1949, the area of the Bombay State increased considerably due to the merger of Indian States. The post-merger Bombay State comprises 28 districts, of which 20 are old districts and 8 new districts have been created. Of the 8 new districts, the districts of Baroda, Mehsana, Banaskantha, Dangs and Kolhapur have been formed by the integration of the Indian States' areas, whilst the remaining three districts, viz., Sabarkantha, Amreli and Satara South, although newly created from the areas of the old Indian States, include some talukas of the pre-merger Bombay State. Amongst the old districts, East Khandesh, Ahmednagar, Bombay Suburban and North Kanara have remained practically unchanged, whilst the areas of the remaining 16 districts have increased in extent due to the merger of Indian States. The Surat District, which formerly comprised only 9 talukas, has now 18 talukas. The other districts, the areas of which have considerably increased, are Kaira, Breach and Panchmahals. As a result of these changes, it has not been possible to make a comparison of the area and outturns of crops in respect of each district recorded in 1949-50 with the corresponding figures for 1948-49. Moreover, due to the existence of a number of unsurveyed villages in the merged and

integrated areas, where village forms and records are still not being maintained, the agricultural statistics for the new districts and new talukas of the reconstructed districts are not of the same accuracy as those for the other districts of the State. Accordingly, it is now proposed to give the figures of acreages for the different crops under the heads "reported", i.e., the area for which statistics are available and "estimated", i.e., the area for which no returns exist. This practice was in vogue prior to 1940-41. The figures of area and outturn estimates are rounded off to the nearest hundred.

4. *Number of villages.*—The total number of villages in the Bombay State was 36,042 during the year under review.

5. *Total area and reporting and non-reporting areas.*—The total area, i.e., the geographical area of the Bombay State was 6,74,36,000 acres, the reporting area was 6,23,59,000 acres, and the non-reporting area, i.e., the area for which no returns are received, was 50,77,000 acres. These figures are exclusive of the area of the Banaskantha District, for which no details of classification of area are yet available.

6. *Cropped areas.*—The gross cropped area in the State was 4,23,63,000 acres, and the net cropped area was 4,10,82,000 acres. The twice cropped area was 12,81,000 acres. The assessed and un-assessed areas were 4,65,25,000 acres and 4,26,000 acres, respectively. An area of 1,90,000 acres of forest land was given out for temporary cultivation, and of this area, 1,63,000 acres were in the Deccan. About 1,97,000 acres of cultivable waste area or other uncultivable land, excluding current fallows, were also utilized for cultivation. Of this area, 1,14,000 acres were in the Deccan, 50,000 acres in Gujarat and the remaining area in the Karnatak and Konkan. An area of 39,000 acres from "others" was also given out for temporary cultivation, and of this area, 20,000 acres were in the Deccan, 10,000 acres in Gujarat and the remaining area in the Karnatak and Konkan. The total area under cultivation, including current fallows, was 4,69,51,000 acres.

Except for gross cropped area, net cropped and twice cropped areas, figures of other areas in respect of the Banaskantha District are not yet available, and accordingly the statistics given in the above paragraph do not include the figures for the Banaskantha District.

CHAPTER III—CROPPED AREA

(Table III, pages 29-54)

(Appendix B, page 15 and Appendix C, pages 16-17)

7. *Total area under crops and under irrigation.*—The total area under crops in the State was 4,23,63,000 acres, of which 1,30,23,000 acres were in Gujarat, 1,61,21,000 acres in the Deccan, 1,09,86,000 acres in the Karnatak and 22,33,000 acres in the Konkan. The total area under irrigated crops was 20,11,000 acres, and of this area, 4,02,000 acres were in Gujarat, 11,20,000 acres in the Deccan, 4,28,000 acres in the Karnatak and 61,000 acres in the Konkan.

8. *Foodcrops.*—Among the main foodcrops, the area under rice was 31,61,000 acres, of which 11,04,000 acres were in Gujarat, 3,60,000 acres in the Deccan, 5,34,000 acres in the Karnatak and 11,63,000 acres in the Konkan. The area under wheat was 20,79,000 acres, and its distribution in Gujarat, the Deccan and the Karnatak was 7,07,000 acres, 7,22,000 acres and 6,50,000 acres respectively. The area under *jowar* (grain) was 1,17,40,000 acres, and of this area, 19,55,000 acres were in Gujarat, 57,90,000 acres in the Deccan, 34,93,000 acres in the Karnatak and only 2,000 acres in the Konkan. The area under *bajri* was 62,32,000 acres, its distribution in the different divisions being 23,85,000 acres in Gujarat, 28,95,000 acres in the Deccan and 9,52,000 acres in the Karnatak. The area under gram was 8,95,000 acres, of which 1,57,000 acres were in Gujarat, 4,45,000 acres in the Deccan, 2,89,000 acres in the Karnatak and only 4,000 acres in the Konkan. The distribution of 7,12,000 acres under *tur* in the different divisions of the State was 2,54,000 acres in Gujarat, 2,13,000 acres in the Deccan, 2,32,000 acres in the Karnatak and 13,000 acres in the Konkan. The area in the State under sugarcane was 1,84,000 acres.

9. *Non-food crops.*—The area under cotton was 24,91,000 acres, of which 13,90,000 acres were in Gujarat, 2,79,000 acres in the Deccan and 8,22,000 acres in the Karnatak. The distribution of 2,39,000 acres under tobacco in the different divisions was 1,29,000 acres in Gujarat, 7,000 acres in the Deccan and 1,03,000 acres in the Karnatak. The area under oilseeds was 38,72,000 acres, of which 26,37,000 acres were under groundnut. The distribution of the area under groundnut in the different divisions was 4,47,000 acres in Gujarat, 11,35,000 acres in the Deccan, 10,54,000 acres in the Karnatak and 1,000 acres in the Konkan.

10. *Kharif and rabi areas.*—The undernoted table shows the areas under *kharif* and *rabi* crops in the different divisions of the State during the year under report:—

CHAPTER IV—IRRIGATED AREA

(Tables IV and IV-A, pages 54-70)

(Appendix D, page 18)

11. (a) *Irrigated area.*—The irrigated area under different crops was as follows:—wheat 3,68,000 acres, rice 3,08,000 acres, *bajri* 72,000 acres, *jowar* (grain) 3,79,000 acres, maize 60,000 acres, barley 10,000 acres, sugarcane 1,73,000 acres, cotton 24,000 acres and miscellaneous crops 6,17,000 acres.

(b) *Area irrigated under different sources of irrigation.*—During the year under review, the area irrigated by Government canals was 3,78,000 acres, by private canals 64,000 acres, by wells 10,35,000 acres, by tanks 1,54,000 acres and by other sources of irrigation 1,30,000 acres.

The percentage of irrigated area to the net cropped area was 4.3 during the year under report.

CHAPTER V—OUTTURNS OF CROPS AND THEIR AVERAGE YIELDS.

12. *Outturns of crops.*—The undernoted table shows the outturn estimates for the principal *kharif* and *rabi* foodgrain crops:—

In the above table, the outturn estimates for rice, *kharif jowar*, *bajri*, wheat and *rabi jowar* are based on the results of crop cutting experiments, and those for the remaining crops have been calculated from the anna valuation figures supplied by the Revenue Department and the standard normal yields of those crops.

13. *Kharif crops.*—The average yield per acre of *kharif* crops (based on crop cutting experiments) for the four divisions of the State are given below:—

The average yield per acre of rice for the State is estimated at 781 lb. The highest average yield of 949 lb. of rice per acre was obtained in the Konkan, and in the Deccan and the Karnatak the average yield was 543 lb. and 768 lb. respectively. The average yield per acre of *kharif jowar* for the State was 424 lb. In the Deccan and Karnatak the average yield was 550 lb. per acre, whilst the average yield in Gujarat was 236 lb. per acre. The highest average yield of 334 lb. of *bajri* per acre was obtained in Gujarat, which is about 50 per cent. more than the average yield of this crop in the Deccan and about 80 per cent. more than that obtained in the Karnatak.

The average yield per acre of *kharif* crops (based on anna valuation figures) for the four divisions of the State are as shown below:—

It will be seen from the above table that the average yield per acre of sesamum for the State was 250 lb. In the case of *tur*, the average yield per acre for the State was 483 lb. The average yield of this crop for the Karnatak was almost the same as that for the State, whilst the average yield obtained in the Deccan was about 20 per cent. higher than the State average. The average yield obtained in the Konkan was 317 lb.

14. *Rabi crops*.—The average yields per acre of *rabi* crops (based on crop cutting experiments) for the four divisions of the State are as under :—

It will be seen from the above table that the average yield of wheat per acre for the State was 357 lb. The average yield of this crop in Gujarat, the Deccan and Karnatak was 441 lb., 409 lb. and 208 lb. respectively. The average yield per acre of *rabi jowar* for the State was 237 lb. The highest average yield of 406 lb. of *rabi jowar* per acre was obtained in Gujarat, which was almost double that obtained in the Deccan and the Karnatak.

The average yields per acre of *rabi* crops (based on anna valuation figures) for the four divisions of the State are given below :—

The average yield of gram crop for the State was 302 lb. The average yield of this crop for the different divisions was almost the same as that for the State, except for the Karnatak, where the average yield was 248 lb. per acre. The average yield per acre of linseed for the State was 162 lb. The average yield per acre of rape and mustard was estimated at 325 lb. It was almost the same for Gujarat and Karnatak, whilst it was higher for the Deccan, i.e., 397 lb. per acre.

15. *Cotton, Sugarcane and Tobacco.*—The undernoted table gives the average yields per acre of cotton (based on crop cutting experiments), and of sugarcane and tobacco (based on anna valuation figures) :—

The average yield per acre of cotton for the State was 93 lb. of lint. It was 123 lb. per acre in Gujarat and only 47 lb. per acre in the Karnatak. The average yield per acre of sugarcane for the State was 6,581 lb. of gul. It was almost the same for the Deccan and the Karnatak, whilst the average yields for Gujarat and the Konkan were comparatively low, i.e., 4,626 lb. and 3,786 lb. respectively. The average yield per acre of tobacco for the State was 496 lb. of dry leaf. It was nearly the same for the different divisions of the State.

16. *Cotton.*—The total area under cotton in the Bombay State, during the year under review, was 24,91,000 acres, and its yield, as estimated by the number of bales of 392 lb. of lint each, was 5,92,000 bales. The table below gives the total area and outturn of cotton in the different divisions of the State during the year under report :—

CHAPTER VI—PRICES

(Table VI, pages 80-81)

17. The major variations in the average prices, prevailing at harvest time, of the principal commodities as compared with those of the previous year are summarised below :—

The average price of rice was lower by about two-fifths of a seer per rupee in Gujarat, about half a seer per rupee in the Konkan and about one seer per rupee in the Deccan and Karnatak. The average price of wheat was almost stationary in Gujarat, but was lower by about half a seer per rupee in the Karnatak and about one seer per rupee in the Deccan and Konkan. As regards *jowar*, its average price was lower by about one and one-third seers per rupee in the Konkan, about one seer per rupee in the Karnatak, four-fifths of a seer per rupee in Gujarat and two-fifths of a seer per rupee in the Deccan. The average price of *bajri* was lower by about one and a quarter seers per rupee in Gujarat, one seer per rupee in the Konkan, three-fifths of a seer per rupee in the Deccan and about one-third of a seer per rupee in the Karnatak. The average price of *nachni* was lower by three-fifths and four-fifths of a seer per rupee in Gujarat and the Deccan, respectively. Among the pulses, the prices of *tur dal* and gram generally showed slight variations from the prices of these two commodities in the preceding year. However, the price of gram was lower by about one-third of a seer per rupee in the Konkan and about one-fourth of a seer per rupee in Gujarat, and that of *tur dal* by about two-thirds of a seer per rupee in the Karnatak. The average price of *gul* was higher by one and one-sixth seer per rupee in the Deccan, four-fifths of a seer per rupee in the Karnatak and Konkan and about half a seer per rupee in Gujarat. The price of tobacco was practically the same as in last year.

The average price of cleaned cotton was stationary in Gujarat, but was higher by about four-fifths of a seer per rupee in the Deccan and lower by about one-fourth of a seer per rupee in the Karnatak. The price of dry grass was almost stationary in the Deccan and Karnatak, but was higher by about one rupee per maund and eight annas per maund in Gujarat and the Konkan, respectively. The average price of *jowar kadbi* was lower by about four annas, twelve annas and one rupee and two annas per maund in Gujarat, the Deccan and the Karnatak, respectively.

18. The table below compares the prices of Broach and Jarila cottons ruling at Bombay during the year under review, with those of the previous year and the average of the preceding five years :—

N.B.—Prices of Jarila for 1949 and 1950 are for 25/32" staple.

It will be observed from the above table that the price of Jarila cotton, which is controlled, was the same as in the previous year, but was considerably higher (by 30·8 per cent.) as compared with the quinquennial average of the period ending 1948, due to cotton being in short supply in the country.

In the subjoined table, the prices of Broach cotton ruling at Bombay have been given for those months for which these prices were available :—

CHAPTER VII—AGRICULTURAL STOCK

(Table VII, pages 82-85)

(Appendix E, page 19)

19. *Agricultural Stock*.—Under instructions from the Government of Bombay, the annual census of livestock was held in February, 1950, and the results of this census are given in Table VII of the Report.

Appendix E summarises the total number of cattle under each main head during the year under report.

During the year under review, the total number of cattle and buffaloes was 1,57,15,000. The number of bulls and bull-buffaloes for breeding purposes was 1,58,000, and that of cows and she-buffaloes for milk production was 45,27,000. The number of work cattle and buffaloes was 56,15,000 and that of young stock was 44,92,000. The total number of sheep in the State was 30,29,000 and that of goats 40,21,000.

CHAPTER VIII—AGRICULTURAL OUTLOOK.

20. As stated in Chapter I of the Report, the season was fairly satisfactory over the greater part of the State. The rainfall was unevenly distributed and had an adverse effect on the growth of crops. The late rains were either absent or deficient and the cold wave which swept over the State damaged the crops, resulting in lower outturns.

21. The table below compares the actual acreages sown and the estimated tonnage of foodgrain crops produced in the different Divisions of the State during the year 1949-50 :—

22. In furtherance of the "Grow More Food" Campaign, Government rendered assistance to the cultivators by grant of subsidies and *tagai* loans for the construction and repairs of wells and tanks and by providing seeds of improved strains, manures, insecticides, fungicides, etc. Assistance was also rendered to the cultivators in the preparation of compost and farmyard manures with a view to augmenting the supply of bulky organic manures. The formation of co-operative lift irrigation societies was encouraged, and more waste land was brought under cultivation. Contour bunding of fields in the scarcity tracts of this State was carried out on a large scale. In spite of these measures, the yields of crops were low owing to the late commencement of the monsoon and irregular distribution of rainfall during the rainy season.

23. The condition of the cattle was generally satisfactory. Rinder pest, foot and mouth, *haemorrhagic septicæmia* and other cattle diseases were prevalent in some parts of the State, but they did not assume epidemic proportions so as to interfere with the normal agricultural activities.

24. The table below gives the prices of agricultural produce prevailing at harvest time during the years 1945-46 to 1949-50 :—

The centres given in the table above are the most representative markets, and accordingly the prices of agricultural produce in these markets indicate the general tendency in the variations of prices of these commodities in the State.

CHAPTER IX—CONDITION OF AGRICULTURAL POPULATION.

25. During the year under review, there has been no significant change in the cost of living and the agricultural condition of the rural population has remained almost the same as in the previous year. Shortage of consumers' goods, resulting from low crop yields due to adverse seasonal conditions and speculative and inflationary tendencies of the market, continued to maintain the prices of food and commercial crops at high levels. Despite these handicaps, the price control had a steady effect on the prices of principal food-grains and other commodities. The economic condition of the agriculturists, however, remained much the same as the benefits realised by the agriculturists from the high prices of agricultural produce and the concessions granted to them under the "Grow More Food" Campaign were counter-balanced by the

continuance of the upward trend of prices, scarcity of agricultural labour and high wages, resulting in increased cost of cultivation. The Bombay Money-lenders Act and the Bombay Agricultural Debtors Relief Act afforded considerable relief to the cultivators from the usurious practices of the moneylenders, and the Bombay Tenancy and Agricultural Land Act proved beneficial in ameliorating the economic condition of the tenant-cultivator.
