SEASON AND CROP REPORT OF THE PROVINCE OF BOMBAY FOR THE YEAR 1944-45,

CHAPTER I—CHARACTER OF THE SEASON.

The agricultural season of 1944-45 may, in general, be regarded as fair over the greater part of the Province, but judged by crop growth and outturn it was less satisfactory than the preceding one. The regular monsoon commenced from the middle of June and the initial rainfall was fairly adequate, particularly, in the southern areas of the Province. In the first fortnight of July, there were fairly substantial and timely rains in most tracts which enabled the cultural operations to be undertaken on a general scale. The precipitation from mid-July to mid-August was markedly heavy in the northern parts of the Province and as a result cultural operations were impeded and newly germinated crops were damaged. This excessive rainfall was particularly heavy in South Gujarath and North Deccan, where cultivated lands were flooded and in some low-lying places crops were washed away. In the South-eastern regions of the Deccan and the Karnatak, on the other hand, the rainfall was light and irregular and consequently the *kharif* crops deteriorated due to insufficient soil moisture. In Konkan and the western parts of Deccan, and the Karnatak, the rainfall was substantial and the *kharif* crops progressed satisfactorily. Opportune and welcome rains occurred in September, in parts of Gujarat, Deccan and the Karnatak and the fall in the third week of the month greatly benefitted the *kharif* crops and accelerated *rabi* sowings, promising a successful *rabi* season. The rainfall in Konkan was short of normal requirements, which hindered the crop growth and checked grain formation of paddy and *nagli*. The rains in the first fortnight of October had a beneficial effect on crop growth, but the precipitation towards the end of the month was heavy in the southern areas of the Province, where standing and harvested *kharif* crops were slightly damaged, causing shedding of grain and spoiling the quality of the produce. With some showers of rain in the first fortnight of November, in the southern areas of the Province, the season was closed. The absence or inadequacy of later rainfall, combined with other adverse climatic factors, such as dry easterly winds, cloudy dull weather, occurrence of the cold spell, accompanied by rains and strong winds, nullified the early promise of a successful *rabi* season and the outturn realised from the *rabi* crops was below normal, over most areas especially on the lighter types of soils and in the south-eastern districts of the Province. The climatic conditions were also conducive to the increased damage to crops by insect pest and plant diseases. Accordingly, the agricultural season of 1944-45, as far as the *kharif* season was concerned, was disappointing in the Northern areas of the Province, while the *rabi* season, though better in crop acreage than the preceding year, yielded reduced crop returns in most of the areas of the Province.

2. *Distribution of rainfall.*—Table I (pages 16-17) compares the rainfall during the year under review with the average annual fall of rain at each representative recording station in the Province. The average rainfall figures for each station have been supplied by the Indian Meteorological Department.

Kharif Rains.—The *kharif* rains exceeded the average at all the district headquarters stations in the Province, except at Kaira and Broach in Gujarat, Sholapur in the Deccan, Bijapur and the hilly tracts in the Karnatak and Alibag in the Konkan, where they were below normal.

Rabi rains.—In Gujarat, the *rabi* rains were below the amount usually received. In the Deccan, the rainfall in the *rabi* season was below the average at Dhulia (West Khandesh) and Jalgaon (East Khandesh), but elsewhere in the Division it was in excess of it in Karnatak and the Konkan, the rain was appreciably above normal at district headquarter stations, except at Alibag where it was below normal.

Hot Weather Rains.—These rains were practically absent in Gujarat and the Konkan Divisions whereas they were below the average in the Deccan and the Karnatak.

CHAPTER II—AREA CULTIVATED AND UNCULTIVATED.

(Table II, pages 18-20).

3. *Number of villages.*—The total number of villages in the Province decreased by twenty from 22,705 in 1943-44 to 22,685 during the year under report due to amalgamation with adjoining villages for administrative convenience as detailed below :—

- 3 villages in West Khandesh.
 - 6 villages in East Khandesh.
 - 6 villages in Nasik.
 - 2 villages in Satara.
 - 2 villages in Sholapur.
 - 2 villages in Belgaum.
- 21 Total.

Against the decrease of the above 21 villages, there is an increase of 1 village in Eatnagiri District and thus the net result is the decrease of 20 villages in the Province.

4. *Total area and Reporting and Non-reporting area—The total area.*—The total area decreased by 6,759 acres, the decrease being marked mostly in Ahmedabad District and was due to survey corrections.

Reporting and Non-reporting area.—The total reporting area increased by 2,748 acres, while the non-reporting area decreased by 9,507 acres.

5. *Cropped areas.*—The gross and net cropped areas showed slight decrease, i.e. only by 0.0 per cent, and 0.8 per cent, respectively as compared with the previous year and is mostly in Ahmedabad, East Khandesh, Poona and Ratnagiri Districts. The twice cropped area on the other hand showed an increase of 44 per cent, which was shared by Gujarat and the Deccan. The assessed area remained almost the same as last year; while the unassessed area increased by 13.5 per cent, as compared with the preceding year. This increase is shared by all the Divisions in the Province and was due to "Grow More Food" Campaign. An area of about 160,000 acres of forest land was given out for temporary cultivation, of which 4,000 were in Gujarat, 136,000 in the Deccan and about 19,000 in the Konkan. About

106,000 acres of cultivable waste or "other uncultivated land excluding current fallows," was also utilised for cultivation of this 16,000 acres were in Gujarat, 68,000 in the Deccan, 4,000 in the Karnatak and 18,000 in the Konkan. An area of about 29,000 from "others" was also given for temporary cultivation. The total area under cultivation including current fallows showed an increase of 85,000 acres as compared with the preceding year.

CHAPTER III—CROPPED AND IRRIGATED AREAS.

(Tables III & IV, pages 21-33).

(Table IV-A, pages 34).

6. *Total area under crops and under irrigation.*—The total area under crops showed a decrease of 185,000 acres, or 06 per cent., during the year under report as compared with the preceding year and is partly due to seasonal conditions. The total area under irrigation increased by 68,000 acres or by 6 per cent, due to more irrigation facilities extended under Government Canals.

7- *Food crops—(a) Total area.*—Among the main food crops the total area under rice increased by 58,000 acres or 29 per cent., as compared with the previous year. The increase being shared by Gujarat and the Karnatak. The area under wheat showed substantial increase i.e. by 470,000 acres, or 30.1 per cent., as compared with the preceding year and was shared by Gujarat, Deccan and Karnatak. The increase under rice and wheat is mainly due to favourable season and to "Grow More Food" campaign and favourable prices for foodstuffs. The area under bajri decreased by 356,000 acres, or 7 per cent., as compared with the previous year and the decrease is shared by Gujarat, Deccan and Karnatak due to unfavourable kharif season." The area under jowar (grain) increased by 477,000 acres, or 6.3 per cent., as compared with the previous year and is shared by Gujarat, Deccan and Karnatak. The area under gram similarly increased by 167,000 acres, or 34.2 per cent., as compared with the preceding year and the increase is shared by all the Divisions of the Province.

(6) *Irrigated area.*—The irrigated area under rice, wheat, jowar, maize and sugarcane increased by 14.3 per cent., 15.3 per cent., 9.5 per cent., 28 per cent., and 35 per cent., respectively, while the irrigated area under bajri, barley and cotton decreased by 71 per cent., 36.4 per cent., and 83.3 per cent, respectively. The area under vegetables increased by 7,000 acres as compared with the previous year and is due to extension of irrigation facilities to vegetable growers.

8. *Non-food crops.*—The total area under *cotton* decreased by 1,681,000 acres, or 55.7 per cent., due to the promulgation of the Bombay Growth of Food Crops Act. The area under *tobacco* increased by 40,000 and the increase is mainly shared by Kaira, Belgaum, Ahmedabad and Dharwar Districts and is mainly due to fair prices and abnormal reduction under, cotton. The total area under oil seeds increased by 137,000 acres, or 6 per cent., and was shared by the Deccan and the Karnatak. Among oil seeds the area under groundnut increased by 162,000, or 11.9 per cent., while the area under Sesamum and castor decreased as compared with the preceding year by 25.2 per cent, and by 5.7 per cent, respectively.

9. *Kharif and Rabi Areas.*—The following table compares the areas under kharif and rabi crops during the year under report with those of the preceding two years :—

It will be seen from the above table that the kharif area during the year under report showed a decline below that of the preceding two years, while the area under rabi crops showed increase over the last two years. The total area under cereals and pulses increased by 1,004,000 acres or 48 per cent, over the preceding year and by 1,299,000 acres, or 63 per cent, over the total acreage in 1942-43 and is mainly due to the abnormal decrease in the area under cotton and the departmental propaganda in connection with "Grow More Food" Campaign.

10. *Area irrigated under different sources of irrigation.*—The area irrigated by Government Canals increased by 47,000 acres or 14.8 per cent, as compared with the preceding year. The increase was mainly noticeable in the Deccan where irrigation facilities were extended to cultivators. Irrigation by private canals and wells also increased by 1,000 and 26,000 acres or 1.7 per cent, and 4.5 per cent, respectively, as compared with the preceding year. The increase was shared by all parts of the Province except Konkan. The area irrigated by tank and other sources of irrigation showed a decrease of 2.8 per cent, and 41 per cent, respectively as compared with the preceding year. The total area irrigated under all sources of irrigation showed an increase of 68,000 acres or by 60 per cent, as compared with the preceding year.

The ratio of irrigated area to the net cropped area was 4.2 per cent, during the year under report.

CHAPTER IV—OUTTURN OF CROPS.

(Table V, pages 35-37 and Table Y-A pages 38-40).

11. *Kharif Crops.*—Among main food grain crops the estimated outturn of rice, jowar and bajri ranged between 36 and full normal, 37 and 79 and 33 and 68 per cent, respectively of the normal in the Province. Sssamum yielded between

42 and 83 per cent, of the normal. Tur yielded between 42 and 92 per cent, of the normal. The yield of cotton varied from 42 and 82 per cent, of the normal.

12. *Babi Crops*.—The outturn of wheat ranged from 50 and 87 per cent, of the normal except at Belgaum where it was only 18 per cent, of the normal. The outturn of rabi jowar varied from 39 to 79 per cent, of the normal. The yield of gram was between 50 and 83 per cent, of the normal, while that of tobacco ranged between 52 and 83 per cent, of the normal. Among oil seeds *linseed* returned between 50 and 75 per cent, of the normal except in Ahmedabad where it was only 33 per cent, of the normal. In the case of rape and mustard, the yield varied from 50 and 83 per cent, of the normal. Sugarcane which is a perennial crop returned between 59 per cent, and full normal.

13. *Cotton*.—As regards the actual outturn of cotton as estimated by the number of bales, it may be stated that so far as the area factor in the Bombay Province including Indian States is concerned, there was an abnormal drop to the extent of 2,044 thousand acres, or by 479 per cent, as compared with the preceding year. The total area and outturn was as under :—

CHAPTER V—PRICES.

(Table VI, pages 55-57)

14. The following remarks indicate the major variations in the average prices, prevailing at harvest time, of the principal articles as compared with those of the previous year.

The average price of rice ruled cheaper by about one-fourth of a seer to three-fourth of a seer per rupee, except in the Konkan, where it rose by about one-seventh of a seer per rupee ; while the average price of wheat went down from one-half of a seer to three-fourth of a seer per rupee in all the Divisions of the Province. The average price of jowar was cheaper from one-fifth of a seer to one and one-fifth seers per rupee and of bajri from one-eighth of a seer to one-fourth of a seer per rupee. The average price of *tur dal* ruled cheaper from one-half of a seer to four-fifth of a seer, while that of gram went down from one-fourth of a seer to one and one-half seers per rupee, the price of *nachni* being cheaper from three-fourth of a seer to more than one seer per rupee. Except in the Konkan where it was dearer by one-eighth of a seer the average price of gul ruled cheaper from one-fourth of a seer to one and one-half seer per rupee in the other Divisions of the Province, while that of tobacco was higher from one-fifth of a seer to one-fourth of a seer per rupee.

15. The following table compares the prices of Broach cotton ruling at Bombay during the year under report with those of the previous year and the average of the preceding five years. The price of Jarila cotton at Bombay

was given since 1943 and has been given also this year as prices for Khandesh and Kumta varieties of cotton (for which prices were quoted in previous years) were not available.

It will be seen from the above table that the price of Broach cotton was somewhat higher than that of the previous year and this rise was chiefly due to more demand by Mills on account of the improvement in the quality of this cotton which was grown from the new strains. The price of Jarila cotton showed a slight fall as the demand was comparatively less. The price of Broach cotton during this year as in the previous year showed an abnormal rise over the average price of the preceding five years mainly due to war situation. In the subjoined table the prices of Broach cotton ruling at Bombay have been given for those months for which they were available.

The average price of dry grass rules cheaper from three annas to five annas per Indian maund and that of *joioar kadbi* by two rupees and two annas in the Karnatak, while it was dearer by four annas and about one rupee two annas in Gujarat and the Deccan respectively. The price of rice straw in the Konkan rose by about ten annas per Indian Maund.

CHAPTER VI—AGRICULTURAL STOCK.

(Table VII, pages 8-74).

16. Under instructions from the Government of India a quinquennial census of Livestock and Agricultural machinery and implements was held in January 1945 and the result is given in details in Table VII appended to the Report.

Appendix E summarises the total strength under each main head during the year under report compared with the last quinquennial census in 1939-40.

Variations in total number of cattle and buffaloes.—The total number of cattle and buffaloes in 1945 was 9,277 thousand heads against 9,734 thousand heads in 1940 thus showing a decrease by 47 per cent.

For breeding purposes (bulls and bull-buffaloes).—The total number under this increased by 20 thousand or by 37·7 per cent, as compared with the number in 1940. The increase is shared by Deccan, Karnatak and Konkan and is mainly due to the Departmental propaganda carried out by holding cattle shows.

For milk production (cows and she-buffaloes).—The number shows a decline by 3·7 per cent, or 121 thousand as compared with the figures in 1940 and is mainly due to scarcity of fodder, cattle disease, etc.

Young Stock.—The number under this head in 1945 shows substantial reduction, i.e. by 285 thousand or by 9·7 per cent, as compared with the figures in 1940. The decrease is shared by all the Divisions in the Province and is mainly due to the same reasons which are responsible for the reduction of milch cattle.

Sheep and Goats.—The total number of sheep and goats together decreased by 541 thousand or by 109 per cent, as compared to 1940 census and is mainly due to greater sales owing to high prices, scarcity of grazing and diseases.

Horses and Ponies.—The total number in 1945 decreased by 7 thousand or by 5·9 per cent, as compared with the figures in 1940.

The figures under other heads of livestock are self-explanatory.

As regards the figures of iron implements and machinery in 1945, as compared with the figures in 1940 disclose the following interesting data.

There is general increase under iron ploughs, tractors, sugarcane crushers worked by power, oil engines with pumps for irrigation purposes and electric pumps, while there is general decrease under wooden ploughs and carts which is an indication by itself that the cultivators are gradually taking advantage of modern implements and machinery in preference to the old implements of bygone days.

The Government of Bombay has now made arrangements to take annual cattle census from 1944, accordingly the next census will be held in January 1946.

CHAPTERS VII AND VIII—CONDITION OF AGRICULTURAL POPULATION.

17. As already stated in Chapter I of the Report, the season on the whole was less satisfactory than the preceding year. The *kharif* season was disappointing in the Northern part of the Province while the *rabi* season, though better in crop acreage than the preceding year, yielded reduced crop returns in most areas of the Province.

18. Taking the Province as a whole there was an appreciable increase in the acreage under food crops during the year under report as compared with the previous year. The estimated production of crops has on the whole decreased over that of the last year and though there was substantial increase in the total acreage the yield was poor mainly owing to seasonal conditions. The following tabular statement compares the actual acreage sown and the estimated tonnage of foodgrain crops produced in different Divisions of the Province during the year 1943-44 and 1944-45 :—

19. The above table indicates that though due to vigorous propaganda in connection with the "Grow More Food" campaign and the application of the "Growth of Food Crops" Act the area under food crops increased substantially the estimated outturn did not keep pace with it due to seasonal conditions. Had the season been favourable, as last year; there was every possibility of getting good yields.

20. During the year under report, the economic conditions resulting from the world war continued to influence the prices of agricultural products which maintained their upward trend. Extension of the measures of economic control contributed to the comparative stability of price level and cost of living. The food situation in the Province showed improvement as a result of co-ordinated movement of supplies from surplus to deficit areas, further extension of rationing and compulsory procurement of food grains known as the "Levy Scheme".

21. The following is a statement of prices prevailing at harvest time for agricultural products :—

22. The economic condition of agricultural population was on the whole satisfactory as the agriculturists realised better prices for foodcrops and the concessions under "Grow More Food" campaign. Government waste lands were given on lease on nominal and concessional rates on the condition that cultivators would grow food crops only. The application of the "Growth of Food Crops" Act coupled with the "Grow More Food" campaign had the desired effect in bringing into cultivation culturable waste and forest land. The agriculturists took keen interest in agriculture and they would have been benefitted more but for the counterbalancing factors affecting their income. There were mainly higher prices of working cattle, agricultural labour and manures. Maintenance of cattle in sound condition was a problem in Tiew of the scarcity of fodder. Like last year the condition remained aggravated in view of the rise in the prices of iron implements and machinery required for agricultural purposes.

23 The condition of cattle was generally satisfactory, except in the Northern Division where scarcity of fodder was keenly felt. The prices of working cattle increased abnormally. Epizotics like Haemorrhagic, Septicaemia, rinderpest, foot and mouth diseases, black quarter, dengue were prevalent but they did not assume serious importance as to interfere agricultural operations.

24. There was a large demand for labour for various military, textile and industrial concerns and the wages of agricultural labour continued to remain high as that of the last year.
