INTRODUCTION

This Report gives an account of the development of educational facilities for children belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in India during 1968-69. This report is based mainly on the statistical data supplied by the State Governments and Administrations of Union Territories in a prescribed form entitled 'Form A-1'. It depicts inter-alia a comparative picture with the previous year in addition to the developments that have taken place during the year under report.

2. This publication covers mainly the enrolment of children belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes at different levels of education beginning from pre-primary education up to the highest stage of education with all the possible bifurcation into different standards of education. Sex-wise and State-wise comparison of the progress of education among the children belonging to these communities has also been made. The extent of coverage at different levels of education in respect of these communities has also been worked out where necessary.

3. The population statistics included in this Report relate to 1971 Census Data and no attempt has been made to estimate the population of these communities for the year under report. Further no attempt has been made to draw any inference or insinuation based upon the factual data depicted in the report, although some analysis of the data has been given wherever desirable in order to ~~highlight~~ the progress of education among the children of various age-groups belonging to these communities.

4. The State-wise details of progress made in providing educational facilities to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribe Communities are presented in Appendices 'A' and 'B' respectively.

5. The Ministry of Education & Social Welfare highly appreciates the assistance of all the State Governments and Administrations of Union Territories who supplied the basic statistics for the preparation of this report. Suggestions for making the report more useful in future may please be addressed to the Joint Secretary (Planning) in this Ministry.

S U M M A R Y

Since Independence, there has been a tremendous expansion in the provision of educational facilities in India. Remarkable increase has been noticed in the number of institutions of different types, enrolment therein, number of teachers employed and the educational expenditure incurred thereon. Table I below, which gives the percentage of coverage of the population of different school-going age-groups, indicates at a glance the significant developments that have taken place in the field of education during the post-Independence period:

2. Although all-round expansion of education has been witnessed in the post-Independence era yet it has not spread over uniformly in the country. There still remain certain areas and social communities as well as some groups of population which lag far behind others in the development of education. Special efforts are, therefore, required to be made to accelerate the pace of educational development in such backward areas, social groups of population, like, girls, Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, backward classes and other communities living in hill areas.

The percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes to the total enrolment in the country decreased from 10.2 in 1967-68 to 10.2 in 1968-69. Similarly, the corresponding percentage increase for Scheduled Tribes is shown to have gone down from 3.1 in 1967-68 to 3.9 in 1968-69. Consequently, the extent of coverage also decreased from 74.0 in 1967-68 to 70.5 in 1968-69 in the case of Scheduled Castes and from 59.4 to 56.5 respectively in the case of Scheduled Tribes. The decrease in the percentage and extent of coverage in both cases may be due to greater increase in the population of these communities. However, there is a case for making efforts to improve the percentage enrolment of these communities to total enrolment in the country as well as the coverage of population of these communities.

Table 2 below presents the comparative position of enrolment of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in various types of institutions in India for the years 1967-68 and

The extent of coverage is defined as :

$\frac{\% \text{age enrolment of S/Castes/Scheduled Tribes to total population of students}}{\% \text{age population of Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes to total population}} \times 100$

The details of enrolment of children belonging respectively to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, studying in various educational institutions in different States and Union Territories are given in the statements included in Appendices 'A' and 'B' of the Report.

4. If a fair deal had been given to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, the extent of coverage should have been 100 or in other words, the percentage enrclment of Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes to total enrolment should have been equal to the percentage population of Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes to total population. An index of greater than 100, implies that the educational advance of Scheduled Castes/Tribes is more than that of the total population and thereby shows that there are some other social groups whose condition is even worse than that of the general population. If this index is less than 100 it may be concluded that the Scheduled Castes/Tribes have still some lee-way to make. In such cases, special efforts are needed to be made to improve their enrolment. The smaller the extent of coverage, the greater the need for making such efforts.

5. For analysis of this subject in detail as well as because of the different position obtaining amongst Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes so far as educational facilities are concerned, it has been felt desirable to divide this report into two parts. Part I relates to the educational development of Scheduled Castes and Part II deals with the educational development of Scheduled Tribes.

EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES FOR SCHEDULED CASTES

Population of Scheduled Castes

6. The population of Scheduled Castes recorded at the 1971 Census was about 80.00 million which formed 14.6% of the total population of India. The following Table gives State-wise break-up of the population of this community as well as its percentage to total population.

It will be seen that the largest population of Scheduled Castes (24.7% was found in Punjab followed by Himachal Pradesh (22.2%) and Uttar Pradesh (21.0%). The smallest proportion of Scheduled Cast population (0.1%) was reported by Arunachal Pradesh.

7. The population of Scheduled Castes for the year 1969 is not available, but for the purpose of this Report it has been assumed that the percentage of Scheduled Caste population to the total population of each State as recorded in 1971 Census holds good for 1969 as well.

Enrolment of Scheduled Castes

8. Table 4 below depicts the all-India picture of the total enrolment of Scheduled Castes in various types of institutions during the years 1967-68 and 1968-69:-

It is observed that the total enrolment increased from 83.06 lakhs in 1967-68 to 85.49 lakhs in 1968-69 giving an increased rate of 2.9% during this period. The girls' enrolment included in the total, however, increased from 23.76 lakhs in 1967-68 to 24.56 lakhs in 1968-69. Additional enrolment during the one year period was of the order of 2.43 lakhs and the major increase of 0.91 lakhs in High/Higher Secondary Schools alone was noteworthy.

The overall extent of coverage of Scheduled Caste candidates decreased from 74.0 in 1967-68 to 70.5 in 1968-69. This is mainly due to an abnormal decrease in extent of coverage from 76.0 to 29.5 in 1968-69 in the case of Colleges and Schools for Professional and Other Education. The fall was due to opening of new social education centres in Maharashtra State. The extent of coverage in respect of Primary/Junior Basic Schools, High/Higher Secondary Schools and Universities and Colleges for General Education is shown to have gone up from 89.0, 52.7 and 31.5 in 1967-68 to 90.4, 54.1 and 32.9 in 1968-69 respectively, although in the case of Middle/Senior Basic Schools it remained the same at 63.0 in both the years under report.

State-wise enrolment of Scheduled Castes

10. The State-wise break-up of enrolment of Scheduled Castes as percentage to the total enrolment during the years 1967-68 and 1968-69 is given in Table 6 below :-

The extent of coverage of Scheduled Castes in 1967-68 was more than 100 in three States, viz; Assam, Kerala and Maharashtra and two Union Territories, viz; Dadra and Nagar Haveli and Tripura. In 1968-69 these States and Union Territories (including Gujarat and Manipur) reported extent of coverage as more than 100.

Progress of Educational Facilities

12. A review of the progress of educational facilities available to Scheduled Caste students during the years 1967-68 and 1968-69 indicated an overall improvement in their enrolment. The position varied from State to State and also over various types of institutions. Statements II to IX in the Appendix 'A' indicate State-wise progress of enrolment of Scheduled Castes in various types of educational institutions.

13. A brief comparative review of the progress of enrolment of Scheduled Castes as percentage to the total enrolment and the extent of coverage for the years 1967-68 and 1968-69 in various types of educational institutions is given in the following paragraphs:

(i) Pre-Primary Schools

While the total enrolment in Pre-Primary Schools in the country increased from 2.40 lakhs in 1967-68 to 2.49 lakhs in 1968-69, thus, registering an increase of 3.8% during this period, the enrolment of Scheduled Castes decreased from 14,301 (6.0% of the total) in 1967-68 to 11,146 (4.5% of the total) in 1968-69. As seen from Statement II in Appendix 'A', the maximum increase in the enrolment of Scheduled Castes in pre-primary schools was reported by Assam, where it increased from 38 in 1967-68 to 83 in 1968-69. The State-wise percentage of enrolment and extent of coverage are indicated in Table 8 :-

(ii) Primary Schools

The total enrolment in Primary Schools in the country increased from 390.5 lakhs in 1967-68 to 393.8 lakhs in 1968-69, showing an increase of 0.8% during the year 1968-69. The corresponding enrolment of Scheduled Castes increased from 50.9 lakhs in 1967-68 to 51.8 lakhs in 1968-69, thus, registering an increase of 1.8% during the year 1968-69. The percentage of enrolment of Scheduled Castes to the total enrolment in Primary Schools increased from 13.0 in 1967-68 to 13.2 in 1968-69. Consequently, the extent of coverage also showed an increase from 89.0 in 1967-68 to 90.4 in 1968-69. State-wise position of these percentage is shown in Table 9 below. However, details of enrolment of Scheduled Castes in Primary Schools by States and Union Territories for the years 1967-68 and 1968-69 are given in Statement III of Appendix 'A'.

The total enrolment in Middle/Senior Basic Schools in the country increased from 184.1 lakhs in 1967-68 to 190.6 lakhs in 1968-69, registering an increase of 3.5% in 1968-69.

(iv) High/Higher Secondary Schools

Total enrolment in High/Higher Secondary Schools for the country as a whole increased from 142.5 lakhs in 1967-68 to 150.2 lakhs in 1968-69 registering an increase of 5.4% in the year 1968-69. Enrolment of Scheduled Caste students was 11.0 lakhs in 1967-68 which increased to 11.9 lakhs in 1968-69, showing an increase of 8.2% during 1968-69. Percentage enrolment of Scheduled Caste students to the total enrolment was 7.7% in 1967-68 which increased to 7.9% in 1968-69. Corresponding figures for the extent of coverage were 52.7 and 54.1 in the years 1967-68 and 1968-69 respectively. Percentage enrolment and extent of coverage are shown in Table 11 below :-

(v) schools for Vocational and Technical B

Total Enrolment in Vocational and Technical Schools of the country was 2,30,141 in 1967-68. Of this the number of Scheduled Caste students was 20,785 and formed 9.0 per cent of the total enrolment. In 1968-69, the total enrolment of all communities in these schools decreased to 1,69,737 and so also the enrolment of scheduled caste students which decreased to 15,500 forming 9.1 per cent of the total enrolment. Corresponding extent of coverage was 62.3 in 1968-69. State-wise enrolment percentage and the extent of coverage have been indicated in Table 12:

(vi) Schools for Special Education.

Schools for physically and mentally handicapped children and the reformatories are generally taken under Schools for Special Education. In the year 1967-68, 26,233 students from all communities were enrolled in these institutions of which 2,177 were scheduled caste students. These students formed 8.3 per cent of the total enrolment. In the year 1968-69 total enrolment increased to 26,972 of which 2,487 were Scheduled Caste students. Scheduled Caste students formed 9.2 per cent of the total enrolment. The corresponding extent of coverage for Scheduled Caste enrolment in 1968-69 was 63.0. The State-wise figures of percentage enrolment and extent of coverage are delineated in Table 13 as below :-

(vii) Schools for Other Education*

During 1967-68, 2.74 lakhs Scheduled Caste students were enrolled and they formed 14.0 per cent of the total enrolment of 19.58 lakhs. Total enrolment of all communities in these institutions during 1968-69 was 63.69 lakhs. Of these, Scheduled Caste students were 2.58 lakhs which formed 4.1 per cent of the total enrolment. The extent of coverage for all-India in 1968-69 worked out to 28.1. Figures for percentage enrolment and extent of coverage are indicated in Table 14 given below. Enrolment figures for Scheduled Caste students in Special Education Schools and other Education Schools may be seen from Statement VII of the Appendix 'A'.

(viii) Schools for Vocational, Special and Other Education taken together

Total enrolment of all communities in all the above categories of schools in 1967-68 was 22.14 lakhs of which scheduled caste students were 3.00 lakhs forming 13.6 per cent of the total enrolment. The corresponding extent of coverage was 93.2. In 1968-69 the total enrolment increased to 65.66 lakhs but the enrolment of scheduled caste students decreased to 2.76 lakhs showing 4.2 per cent of the total enrolment. Extent of coverage was recorded as 28.8 in 1968-69.

(ix) Institutions for Higher Education, Universities and Colleges of General Education.

The total number of students enrolled in these institutions increased from 16.36 lakhs in 1967-68 to 18.80 lakhs in 1968-69 i.e. an increase of 14.9 per cent during 1968-69. The enrolment of Scheduled Caste students also increased from 75,160 in 1967-68 to 90,585 in 1968-69 including 9,425 girls. That shows an increase of 20.5 per cent during 1968-69. The percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes was 4.6 per cent in 1967-68.

30.1.68 which slightly increased to 4.8 per cent in 1968-69. The extent of coverage too increased from 31.5 in 1967-68 to 32.9 in 1968-69. The comparative percentage enrolment and extent of coverage for these two years have been indicated below in Table 15. Detailed data on enrolment in Universities and colleges of general education in 1968-69 have been depicted in Statement VIII of Appendix 'A'.

Enrolment of all communities as a whole was 8.20 lakhs in 1967-68 which increased to 8.45 lakhs in 1968-69. The Scheduled Caste students enrolled were 39,433 (including 5,021 girls) in 1967-68 and this enrolment increased to 43,743 (including 6,017 girls) in 1968-69. Enrolment of Scheduled Caste students as percentage to the total enrolment in 1967-68 was 4.8 per cent which slightly increased to 5.2 per cent in 1968-69. The extent of coverage was recorded as 32.9 and 35.6 in the years 1967-68 and 1968-69 respectively. State-wise percentage of enrolment and extent of coverage are shown in Table 16 below

ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES BY STAGES OF EDUCATION

15. So far, the progress in enrolment of Scheduled Caste students by type of institutions only has been discussed. Comparative picture of enrolment and extent of coverage for the years 1967-68 and 1968-69 has been shown in respect of different categories of institutions. However, the correct idea about the progress of enrolment of Scheduled Caste students can be had only from the stage-wise position of enrolment as discussed in the following paragraphs.

Table 20 indicates the enrolment of all communities as well as of Scheduled Caste students alone by stages of education for the year 1968-69. Enrolment of scheduled castes as percentage to the total enrolment for different stages of education has also been indicated.

(iii) High/Higher Secondary Stage

The number of classes which comprises High/Higher Secondary stage also varies from State to State in India. But for the purposes of this report this stage has been taken to comprise of classes IX and above for all the States and Union Territories. Enrolment of Scheduled Caste students at this stage was 4,69,631 of whom 80,460 were girls in 1967-68. Scheduled Caste students formed 8.1 per cent of the total enrolment. Corresponding enrolment for 1968-69 was 4,57,802 of whom 81,308 were girls. The students of Scheduled Caste Community formed 7.4 per cent of the total enrolment at this stage during this year. The extent of coverage of Scheduled Caste students was 55.5 and 50.7 in 1967-68 and 1968-69 respectively. Position of enrolment and extent of coverage of Scheduled Caste students in these classes at High/Higher Secondary stage has been depicted in Table 23. Details of class-wise enrolment for classes IX and above by States may, however, be seen in Statement XII of Appendix 'A'.

(iv) Enrolment by Classes at School Stage

Table 24 Depicts the percentage of Scheduled Caste enrolment to total enrolment in various classes (Pre-primary to higher secondary stage) and extent of coverage for the year 1968-69. The percentage of Scheduled Caste students to all the classes at school stage was 11.0 in 1967-68 which increased slightly to 11.1 percent in 1968-69. The extent of coverage of Scheduled Caste students at school stage was 76.0 in 1968-69:

(v) Vocational, Special and Other Education (School Standard)

Vocational Education includes inter-alia Agriculture, Commerce, Teacher Training, Technical/Industrial and Arts and Crafts Schools etc., Special Education includes institutions for mentally and physically handicapped children and reformatory schools and Other Education relates to institutions of oriental studies, social (Adult) education and other specified education. During the year 1967-68, the enrolment of Scheduled Caste students in Vocational Education was 22,621 forming 7.9 per cent of the total enrolment. Corresponding figures for Special and Other Education were 2,169 and 2,74,379 forming 8.2 and 13.5 per cent respectively of the total enrolment of all communities at these

stages of education. In 1968-69 the Scheduled Caste students enrolled were 16,570 in Vocational Education forming 8.2 per cent of the total enrolment. Scheduled Caste enrolment in schools for Special Education and Other Education was 2,487 and 2,58,484 respectively. The percentage to the total enrolment in this year were 9.2 and 4.0 respectively. Enrolment percentage and the extent of coverage in respect of vocational, special and Other Education (School Standard) have been indicated in detail in Table 25. Details of the enrolment for vocational, special and other type of education (School Standard) are given in Statements XIII and XIV of Appendix A.

(vi) Higher Education (General)

In 1967-68 the enrolment of Scheduled Caste students in general higher education was 94,890 (including 9,575 girls) forming 5.5 per cent of the total enrolment. Scheduled Caste girls formed 2.2 per cent of the total girl students in these classes. In 1968-69 Scheduled Caste enrolment in General Higher Education was 1,12,785 of whom 11,158 were girl students. During this year, Scheduled Caste students formed 5.7 per cent of the total enrolment. Corresponding extent of coverage was 39.6 in 1968-69. Table 26 indicates the enrolment of Scheduled Castes by different stages of general higher education.

(vii) Professional and Other Higher Education:-

Enrolment of Scheduled Castes in 1967-68 was 44,371 of whom 5,188 were girls. In 1968-69 Scheduled Caste enrolment at this stage of education increased to 50,254 (including 6,190 girls). Percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes to total enrolment was 5.1 in 1968-69 and the extent of coverage was 34.9. Stage-wise distribution of Scheduled Castes has been given in Table 28.

It will be seen that the percentage of population of Scheduled Tribes was the highest in Nagaland (88.6%) and lowest in Uttar Pradesh (0.2%) among States. Among Union Territories, the highest percentage of Scheduled Tribes population (92.9%) was reported by L.M.&A. Islands and the least (0.9%) was reported by Goa, Daman and Diu. Among the States - Haryana, Jammu & Kashmir and Punjab had no population of Scheduled Tribes. Similarly, the Union Territory of Chandigarh, Delhi and Pondicherry had no population of Scheduled Tribes in their respective Territories.

It is seen that the total enrolment of children belonging to Scheduled Tribes increased from 31.50 lakhs in 1967-68 to 32.41 lakhs in 1968-69, giving an increase rate of 2.9% during this period. Girls enrolment included in the total, however, increased from 8.85 lakhs (28.1%) in 1967-68 to 9.22 lakhs (28.5%) in 1968-69. The percentage of scheduled Tribes enrolment to total enrolment was 4.1 during 1967-68 which slightly declined to 3.9 percent in 1968-69.

(ii) Primary Schools

Whereas the total enrolment in Primary Schools in the country as a whole increased from 3.91 crores in 1967-68 to 3.94 crores in 1968-69 enrolment of Scheduled Tribe students increased from 20.53 lakhs in 1967-68 to 20.76 lakhs in 1968-69. However, the percentage enrolment of Scheduled Tribes to the total enrolment remained the same at 5.3% in both the years and so also the extent of coverage which remained at 76.3 during this period. State-wise position of the enrolment percentage and extent of coverage of Scheduled Tribes in Primary schools in 1967-68 and 1968-69 is indicated in Table 37 below:

(iii) Middle Schools

Total enrolment in Middle schools in the country as a whole increased from 1.84 crores in 1967-68 to 1.91 crores in 1968-69 showing an increase of 3.8%. The corresponding enrolment of Scheduled Tribes increased from 6.43 lakhs to 6.77 lakhs, thus registering an increase of 5.3% in 1968-69. Consequently, the percentage enrolment of Scheduled Tribes students to the total enrolment of all communities in this type of schools in India registered an increase from 3.5% in 1967-68 to 3.6% in 1968-69. (iv) High/Higher Secondary Schools

While the total number of students belonging to all communities enrolled in High and Higher Secondary Schools increased from 1.43 crores in 1967-68 to 1.50 crores in 1968-69, the corresponding enrolment of scheduled Tribes increased from 2.42 lakhs to 2.77 lakhs during this period. In the case of the former the rate of increase was 4.9%, it was 14.5% in the latter case. Comparative picture of State-wise enrolment for these two years is given in Statement V in appendix 'B'. The coverage of enrolment of scheduled Tribes student as percentage of the total enrolment increased from 1.7% in 1967-68 to 1.8% in 1968-69 and so also the extent of coverage, which increased from 24.6 in 1967-68 to 26.1 in 1968-69. (v) Schools for Vocational and Technical Education

Total enrolment in vocational and technical schools in the country as a whole was 2.30 l.lkhs in 1967-68 of which only 3.2% formed the enrolment of scheduled Tribes. In 1968-69, the corresponding total enrolment of the country as a whole was 1.70 l.lkhs of which 3.6% constituted the enrolment of scheduled Tribes students. The extent of coverage of scheduled Tribes students increased from 46.4 in 1967-68 to 52.2 in 1968-69. State-wise enrolment percentage and extent of coverage have been given in Table 40.

(vi) Schools for Special Education

Total number of students enrolled in schools for special education increased from 26,233 in 1967-68 to 26,972 in 1968-69. Similarly, the enrolment of Scheduled Tribe students increased from 527 in 1967-68 to 802 in 1968-69. Consequently, percentage of scheduled Tribe enrolment increased from 2.0 in 1967-68 to 3.0 in 1968-69 and so also the extent of coverage which increased from 29.0 to 43.5 during the period under report. Total enrolment in schools for other education increased from 19.58 lakhs in 1967-68 to 63.69 lakhs in 1968-69 as against the decrease of Scheduled Tribe enrolment from 1.66 lakhs to 1.65 lakhs during this period. The percentage of Scheduled Tribe students decreased from 8.5 in 1967-68 to 2.6 in 1968-69 and so also the extent of coverage which decreased from 125.2 to 37.7 during this period. (viii) Institutions for Higher Education, Universities and Colleges of General Education

The total enrolment in these institutions increased from 16.36 lakhs in 1967-68 to 18.80 lakhs in 1968-69. Similarly, the enrolment of Scheduled Tribe students increased from 18,561 in 1967-68 to 22,756 in 1968-69. However, the percentage of Scheduled Tribe students belonging to all communities studying in these institutions increased slightly from 1.1 in 1967-68 to 1.2 in 1968-69 and so also the extent of coverage which increased from 15.9 to 17.4 during this period. While the detailed position of the enrolment by States in these Institutions is given in Statement VIII in Appendix 'B', a comparative picture of the enrolment percentages and the extent of coverage is given in Table 43.

(ix) Institutions for Professional, Special and Other Education (Colleges & Schools).

Total enrolment of all communities in these types of institutions increased from 30.35 lakhs in 1967-68 to 74.11 lakhs in 1968-69 as against the decrease of Scheduled Tribe enrolment from 1.82 lakhs in 1967-68 to 1.81 lakhs in 1968-69 registering a decrease of 0.6%. The Scheduled Tribe students formed 2.4% of the total enrolment in the country as a whole in 1968-69 as against 6.0% during the previous year. Corresponding figure of the extent of coverage was 87.0 and 34.8 in 1967-68 and 1968-69 respectively. The percentage of enrolment of Scheduled Tribe students and extent of coverage, State-wise, are indicated in Table 44 below.

(x) Colleges of Professional Education

The number of students studying in Colleges of Professional education in the country increased from 7.26 lakhs in 1967-68 to 7.37 lakhs in 1968-69. The corresponding figure of Scheduled Tribe students was 7,625 in 1967-68 and 8,732 in 1968-69. The Scheduled Tribe students formed 1.1% of the total enrolment in 1967-68 and it slightly increased to 1.2% in 1968-69. Corresponding extent of coverage of Scheduled Tribes in the country as a whole was 15.9 in 1967-68 and 17.4 in 1968-69. The details of the enrolment of Scheduled Tribes by type of institution as percentage to the total and the extent of coverage are given in Table 45 below.

As already stated, the number of classes constituting the Primary stage varies from stage to stage. But for the sake of uniformity, Classes I-V have been taken to form Primary stage in all States/Union Territories for the purpose of this report. Total enrolment of Scheduled Tribes at the Primary Stage in the country as a whole increased slightly from 24.90 lakhs in 1967-68 to 25.25 lakhs in 1968-69. Correspondingly, the girls' enrolment of this community increased from 6.98 lakhs to 7.24 lakhs. However, percentage enrolment of Scheduled Tribes to the total enrolment at this stage remained the same at 4.6 in both the years and so also the extent of coverage which remained at 66.7 during this period. State-wise enrolment at Primary stage in respect of each class is given in Statement X in Appendix 'B'. However, the enrolment of Primary Stage of Scheduled Tribe students and extent of coverage are indicated State-wise in Table 48.

(ii) Middle Stage

Here also in order to maintain uniformity, Classes VI-VIII have been taken to constitute the middle stage in all the States and Union Territories of the Country in respect of the State-wise variation in this regard. Scheduled Tribe students enrolled at this stage were of the order 3.32 lakhs in 1967-68. Of this, 0.78 lakh were girls. The corresponding figures of 1968-69 were 3.67 lakh and 0.85 lakh respectively. Percentage enrolment of Scheduled Tribes to the total enrolment increased from 2.8 in 1967-68 to 2.9 in 1968-69. Corresponding figure of extent of coverage was 40.5 in 1967-68 and 42.0 in 1968-69. For class-wise enrolment a reference may be made to Statement XI in Appendix 'B'. State-wise enrolment and its percentage to total enrolment as well as extent of coverage are given in Table 49.

(iii) High/Higher Secondary Stage

For the purposes of this Report, the high/higher secondary stage of general school education has been taken to consist of Classes IX and above in all the States in respect of the varied system of school classes. The total number of Scheduled Tribe students studying at this stage was 1.21 lakhs, of whom 22,698 were girls in 1967-68. It increased to 1.37 lakhs (including 28,348 girls) in 1968-69. Similarly, percentage of Scheduled Tribe enrolment to the total enrolment at this stage increased from 2.1 in 1967-68 to 2.2 in 1968-69. Corresponding figures of extent of coverage was 30.4 in 1967-68 and 31.9 in 1968-69. Class-wise enrolment has been furnished in Statement XII in Appendix 'B'. Table 50 gives State-wise enrolment, percentage enrolment and extent of coverage in respect of High/Higher Secondary Classes.

Although enrolment of Scheduled Tribe students in general school education (classes pre-primary to higher secondary) increased from 29.50 lakhs in 1967-68 to 30.36 lakhs in 1968-69, yet the percentage enrolment and extent of coverage remained the same at 4.1 and 59.4 respectively.

(v) Vocational, Special and Other Stages of School Standards:

Scheduled Tribe students enrolled in Vocational/Professional schools decreased from 7,842 in 1967-68 to 6,622 (including 1,599 girls) in 1968-69. However, percentage of Scheduled Tribe enrolment to the total enrolment increased from 2.8 in 1967-68 to 3.3 in 1968-69. Corresponding extent of coverage was 40.6 in 1967-68 and 47.3 in 1968-69. State-wise break-up of enrolment in various stages of Vocational education is given in Statement XIII in Appendix 'B'. As against Vocational/Professional Schools, Scheduled Tribe enrolment in special education schools increased from 527 in 1967-68 to 802 (including 117 girls) in 1968-69. It formed 2.0 per cent of total enrolment in 1967-68 and 3.0 per cent in 1968-69. Corresponding figure of extent of coverage was 29.0 in 1967-68 and 43.5 in 1968-69. However, the number of Scheduled Tribe students studying in other education schools decreased from 1,66,277 in 1967-68 to 1,55,413 in 1968-69.

Consequently, percentage of Scheduled Tribe students enrolled to the total enrolment decreased from 8.2 in 1967-68 to 2.6 in 1968-69 and so also the extent of coverage which decreased from 118.8 to/special and other stages of school education is given in Statement XIV in Appendix 'B'. (vi) Higher Education (General):

Scheduled Tribe students enrolled in general higher education increased from 17,597 (including 3,085 girls) in 1967-68 to 21,808 (including 3,832 girls) in 1968-69. It formed 1.0 per cent of the total enrolment. The corresponding percentage of Scheduled Tribe girls was 0.7 in 1967-68. However, in 1968-69 the percentage of Scheduled Tribe enrolment to the total enrolment increased to 1.1 and so also the percentage of girls which increased to 0.8.
