P_R_E_F_A_C_E

Output of various examinations at different levels constitutes an important factor in the planning process in any country specially in the wake of new approaches to the economics of education and manpower planning. In India also an imperative need of obtaining the latest data on examination results was felt for quite some time. Recently a special collection of data of examination results at the Secondary and Higher Secondary levels was taken up as a special project and examination results for the four years 1970-71 to 1973-74 were collected. These examination results relate to the Boards of Secondary Education and other authorities in India which conduct Secondary level and Higher Secondary level examinations in the States.

It has not been possible for the time being to compare this data with the finalised enrolment data which would become available for these years in due course of time. Nevertheless it is hoped that this compilation will be of use to all those interested in research on various educational and manpower aspects.

The Ministry of Education & Social Welfare takes this opportunity to thank the Secretaries of Boards of Secondary Education of various States who supplied this data and without whose cooperation this publication would not have been possible.

I N T R O D U C T O R Y

Examination results at the secondary level form the basis for planning of a number of educational programmes as well as employment and man-power studies. Recently a greater importance is attached to this level of education in view of the new developments in the light of the 10+2+3 scheme of education. The examination results of Boards of Secondary Education that have been included in this publication relate to the following Boards:-

Further the examination results also include examination results of this level in respect of various universities, as shown in the Tables.

(ii)

The examination results contained in this publication give detailed information in respect of the number appeared and number passed and pass percentage of various examinations like High School, Higher Secondary and Higher Secondary Part I examinations. A comparison of information compiled for the four years 1971 to 1974 shows that as compared to 1970-71 annual the position has substantially changed in the case of High School examinations in respect of the number of students appeared whereas in the case of number passed it has not changed materially. In case of supplementary examinations for these years, at the High School examination the position emerged to be quite different because the number appeared and number passed have shown an almost doubling of the respective figures, though the percentage of passed has improved slightly as compared to the earlier years. In respect of Higher Secondary examination (annual) the position emerged to be comparatively poor because the number appeared is shown to have increased substantially whereas the number of those having passed this examination is shown to have become lesser and the pass percentage is also shown to have decreased from 68.4% in 1970-71 to 50.4% in 1973-74. In the case of supplementary examinations, in the course of the same period, the number appeared in the Higher Secondary examinations is shown to have increased almost three times whereas those passed have only almost doubled and thus the percentage has gone down from 50.3% to 41.9% during the corresponding period. In the case of examination results of some Boards like Board of Sec. Education, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh Board of School Education, Punjab Board of Secondary Education and Central Board of Secondary Education, Delhi that conduct the Higher Secondary Part I examination, the situation seems to have not materially altered and the percentage of passes is shown to have increased from 65.3 in 1970-71 to 68.0 in 1973-74 for the annual examinations and it has decreased from 38.6 in 1970-71 to 28.2% in 1973-74 in the case of supplementary examinations.

If we take individually each of these examinations for each of these four years the pass percentage varies very much in respect of various Boards as the position obtains.

Let us take the case of High School examinations conducted during these four years. The position is summed up below:-

HIGH SCHOOL EXAMINATIONS :

(i) (a) - 1970-71 (Annual) (Vide Table I on page 1):

The pass percentage of various Boards given in this Table No. I shows an interesting variation-with 32.5% in the case of Jammu and Kashmir Board of Sec. Education at the lowest end and 88.5% in the case of Council for Indian School Certificate Examination, New Delhi,

at the highest. Other Boards like (i) Board of Secondary Education, Andhra Pradesh, (ii) Bihar School Examination Board, Patna (iii) Board of Secondary Education Haryana, (iv) Himachal Pradesh Board of School Education, (v) Maharashtra State Board, Poona (vi) Punjab Board of Secondary Education and (vii) Board of Secondary Education, Tamil Nadu, have shown a pass percentage of more than 50% in the annual High School examination during the year. The sex-wise distribution of number appeared and number passed depicts an interesting phenomenon since the number of girls appeared is less than one-third and the number of girls passed is more than one third of that of the number of boys, thus showing a greater percentage of girls having passed this examination (52.6% for girls as against 47.7% for boys).

(i) (b) 1970-71 (Supplementary) (Vide Table II on page 2):

The pass percentage of various Boards shown in Table II also shows an interesting variation between different Boards with 18.7% in case of Board of Secondary Education, Kerala at the lowest end and 73.0% for Bihar School Examination Board, Patna, at the highest. Other Boards like Board of Secondary Education, Assam, Board of Secondary Education, Orissa, Board of Secondary Education, Rajasthan and the Board of High Schools and Intermediate Education, U.P., have shown a pass percentage of more than 50% in this supplementary High School examination during the year. The sex-wise distribution of number appeared and number passed also shows that whereas the number of boys passed is about 1/3 of those appeared the pass percentage of girls is much less and only about 28.8% of girls passed in this examination as shown in Table II.

(ii) (a) 1971-72 (Annual) (Vide Table VII on page 6):

These results for High School annual examinations for 1971-72 are shown in Table No. VII on page 6. The pass percentage in this case also varies quite significantly from 27.8% in the case of West Bengal Board of Secondary Education at the lowest end and 90.4% in the case of Council for Indian School Certificate Examination, New Delhi, at the highest. The other Boards like Board of Secondary Education, Andhra Pradesh, Bihar School Examination Board, Patna, Board of Secondary Education, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh Board of School Education, Punjab Board of School Education, Board of Secondary Education, Tamil Nadu and Central Board of Secondary Education, Delhi, have all shown a pass percentage of more than 50% in the annual High School examination. The sex-wise distribution of number appeared and number passed shows an equally interesting phenomenon since equally good results are shown in respect of both the boys and the girls and the percentage of girls passed is slightly more than 50% whereas that for the boys is only 47.7%. In this way it has kept up a trend of more percentage for girls passing the High School annual examination as was shown for the previous year in (i) (a) above.

(iii) (b) 1971-72 (Supplementary) (Vide Table VIII on page 7):

The pass percentage of various Boards is shown in Table VIII and it depicts an equally interesting variation between different Boards as in the case of the previous year as it varied between 18.4% in the case of Board of Secondary Education Kerala at the lowest end and 57.4% in the case of two Boards, viz. Board of Secondary Education, Assam and Board of High School and Intermediate Education, U.P., at the highest. The other Board that showed a percentage higher than 50 was the West Bengal Board of Secondary Education only which reported 53.9%. The sex-wise distribution of number appeared and number passed depicts an equally interesting phenomenon since the number of boys passed shows a better percentage than that of girls, as compared to that in the case of the annual examinations where the reverse was true, as had happened in the previous year.

(iii) (a) 1972-73 (Annual) (Vide Table XIII on page 11):

The pass percentage of various Boards in 1972-73 annual high school examinations is shown in Table XIII on page 11. This Table also shows an equally interesting variation as in the case of previous similar tables with 27.2% in the case of Bihar School Examination Board, Patna at the lowest end and 82.1% in the case of Council for Indian School Certificate Examination, New Delhi, at the highest. The other Boards like Board of Secondary Education, Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat Secondary Education Board, Gandhi Nagar, Himachal Pradesh Board of School Education, Punjab Board of School Education, Board of Secondary Education, Tamil Nadu and Central Board of Secondary Education, Delhi have shown a pass percentage of more than 50 in this annual high school Examination during 1972-73. The sex-wise distribution of the number appeared and number passed has shown a decline in the case of boys whose percentage comes to little less than 42% and has touched almost 49% in the case of girls. Thus here the percentage of boys passing this examination has gone comparatively much below the level of the previous two years as compared to that of girls.

(iii) (b) 1972-73 (Supplementary) (Vide Table XIV on page 12):

The pass percentage in the case of various Boards shows a wide variation with 20.4% in the case of Board of Secondary Education, Tamil Nadu at the lowest end and with 54.1% in the case of Board of Secondary Education, Assam at the highest. The only other Board that crossed the 50% mark was the Board of High School and Intermediate Education, U.P., with 50.7%. Thus all the Boards showed a poor percentage of passes in the supplementary examinations at the high school level in 1972-73. The sex-wise distribution also shows an interesting phenomenon because the percentage of boys passed was about 31% and that in the case of girls it worked to about 33%-almost one-third in both cases.

(iv) (a) 1973-74 (Annual)

(Vide Table XIX on page 16):

The pass percentage for the annual examination for 1973-74 is depicted in Table No. XIX and the variation in-between the Boards is conspicuous; 25.9% in the case of Bihar School Examination Board, Patna, at the lowest end and 86.7% in the case of Council for Indian School Certificate Examination, New Delhi at the highest. The other Boards that showed a percentage of more than 50 included Gujarat Secondary Education Board (60.9%), Board of Secondary Education, Haryana, (73.1%), Himachal Pradesh Board of School Education (56.9%), Maharashtra State Board, Poona (51.7%), Board of Secondary Education, Tamil Nadu (51.9%), Central Board of Secondary Education, Delhi (62.2%) and also in the case of the results of annual High School Examinations conducted by various universities from which the data was received (67.9%). The Sex-wise distribution of the number appeared and number passed depicts equally interesting phenomenon with about 42% boys passing as against about 51% girls passing in this examination.

(iv) (b) 1973-74 (Supplementary)

(Vide Table XX on page 17):

The pass percentage in the case of various Boards for this examination is shown in Table No. XX. The variation in-between these various Boards has acquired a new dimension because the lowest has touched an all-time low in the case of these 4 years at 9.4% in the case of Board of Secondary Education, Andhra Pradesh where as it was 51.9% in the case of the newly set up Meghalaya Board of School Education, Tura, with 74.8% at the highest end. The percentage in the case of Meghalaya Board is more significant in view of the fact that in the annual examination the percentage was almost half of it. Further, the other Boards that showed more than 50% passed included the Board of Secondary Education, Assam, Bihar School Examination Board, Patna, Board of Secondary Education, Manipur and Board of High School and Intermediate Education, U.P. The sex-wise distribution has also shown a similar variation as in the previous year with about 34% boys passing as against 38% girls, thus showing a better percentage in the case of girls.

HIGHER SECONDARY EXAMINATIONS :

(i) (a) 1970-71 (Annual)

(Vide Table III on page 3):

The pass percentage in the case of various Boards in respect of Higher Secondary Examination for the year 1970-71 (Annual) is shown in Table No. III and an interesting variation is discernible in-between the Boards with the Board of Secondary Education, Assam showing the pass percentage as 40.6% at the lowest end and the Board of Secondary Education, Madhya Pradesh with 79.6% at the highest. A pass percentage of less than 50%

was also shown by Jammu & Kashmir Board of School Education. All the other Boards had shown pass percentages of more than 50. The sex-wise distribution of number appeared and number passed shows a comparatively good trend with about 67% boys and about 73% girls passing the examination. Thus the pass percentage in the case of girls was higher than that in the case of boys.

(ii) (b) 1970-71 (Supplementary) (Vide Table IV on page 4):

The details of examination results relating to Higher Secondary (supplementary) examination for 1970-71 are given in Table No. IV that does not show a very much marked variation in percentage except that in the case of Maharashtra State Board, Poona, the lowest pass percentage of 29.2 is shown while Bihar School Examination Board, Patna showed the highest pass percentage of 67.9%. The other Boards that had a pass percentage of more than 50% included the Board of Secondary Education, Assam (51.5%), Board of Secondary Education Orissa (67.3%), Board of Secondary Education, Rajasthan (55.0%), Central Board of Secondary Education, Delhi (53.7%) and in the case of various universities conducting the Higher Secondary level examination : it was 52.5%. The sex-wise distribution of number appeared and number passed shows an almost equal percentage of about 50% both in the case of the boys and the girls.

(iii) (a) 1971-72 (Annual) (Vide Table IX on page 8):

The results of Higher Secondary Annual Examination for the year 1971-72 are depicted in Table No. IX that shows the lowest percentage of passes in the case of students appeared in the Higher Secondary Examination from various universities at 17.6%. Among the Boards, however, the lowest position was that of J & K Board of School Education at 37.4% and this also did not correlate favourably with the previous year's lowest of 40.9%. The highest position was that of Council for Indian School Certificate Examination, New Delhi with 90.5% and it definitely showed a marked improvement over the previous year's 76.5% (of the same Council). The other Boards that showed more than 50% pass percentage included the Board of Secondary Education Haryana, Himachal Pradesh Board of School Education, Maharashtra State Board, Poona, Board of Secondary Education, Orissa, Punjab Board of School Education and Central Board of Secondary Education, Delhi. The sex-wise distribution of number appeared and number passed shows almost similar percentage in case of boys at about 50% as against the total of 51.2%. But, in the case of girls the percentage worked out to a little higher-at 55.3%.

(ii) (b) 1971-72 (Supplementary) (Vide Table X on page 9):

The results of supplementary Higher Secondary Examination for the year 1971-72 are depicted in Table NO.X and show that the lowest position is occupied by Maharashtra State Board, Poona with 32% as against 72.3% of the Board of Secondary Education, Orissa-at the highest point. The other Boards that showed more than 50% pass percentage included the three Boards of Secondary Education, Haryana, Rajasthan and West Bengal. The sex-wise distribution of number appeared and number passed in these examinations shows that the pass percentage in the case of girls is much better at 55.1% against about 47% in the case of boys.

(iii) (a) 1972-73 (Annual) (Vide Table XV on page 13):

The results of Higher Secondary (Annual) Examinations for 1972-73 are shown in Table XV and the variation in-between the Boards seems to be most marked with 11.4% in the case of Bihar School Examination Board, Patna and 89.3% in the case of the Council for Indian School Certificate Examination, New Delhi. The other Boards that showed more than 50% pass percentage included Himachal Pradesh Board of School Education, Maharashtra State Board, Poona, Punjab Board of School Education, Board of Secondary Education, Rajasthan and the Central Board of Secondary Education, Delhi. The variation in respect of sex-wise distribution of number appeared and number passed shows that while 42.5% of the girls passed this examination, the pass percentage in the case of boys was almost the same or a little less as in the case of overall pass percentage. Thus there is not much variation noticeable among the two sexes in the case of this Annual Higher Secondary Examination in 1972-73.

(iii) (b) 1972-73 (Supplementary) (Vide Table XVI on page 14):

The Supplementary Examination results for Higher Secondary Examination for the year 1972-73 appear in Table XVI which shows that 24.1% passed in the case of Board of Secondary Education, Madhya Pradesh at the lowest end, 66.2% passed in the case of the Board of Secondary Education, Assam, at the highest. The other Boards that show a percentage of more than 50% include Board of Secondary, Orissa (62.5%), Board of Secondary Education, Rajasthan (62.8%), Central Board of Secondary Education, Delhi (53.3%) and the universities that conducted this examination where it was 56.4%. The sex-wise distribution of number appeared and number passed depicts an interesting phenomenon since the percentage of girls passing this examination works out to 37.9% whereas that for the boys comes to 38.6%, thus showing almost the same percentage as in the case of the aggregate number passed.

(iv) (a) 1973-74 (Annual) (Vide Table XXI on page 18):

The Annual Examination results for Higher Secondary 1973-74 are shown in Table No XXI and the variation in pass percentage is highlighted by 34.6% in the case of Board of Secondary Education, Madhya Pradesh, at the lowest end and 90% in the case of the Council for Indian School Certificate Examination, New Delhi at the highest. The other Boards that showed a percentage of more than 50 included the Board of Secondary Education, Assam (62.2%), Maharashtra State Board, Poona (61.4%), Punjab Board of School Education (63.4%) Board of Secondary Education Rajasthan (61.5%), West Bengal Board of Secondary Education (55.3%) and Central Board of Secondary Education, Delhi (61.4%). The sex-wise distribution of number appeared and number passed shows a small variation in 50.9% of girls passing as against 50.2% boys passing in the aggregate.

(iv) (b) 1973-74 (Supplementary) (Vide Table XXII on page 19):

The results for Supplementary Higher Secondary Examination 1973-74 are shown in Table No. XXII and the Variation between the various organisations conducting this examination shows that while 16.4% was the pass percentage in the case of the students passed from universities for this examination, among the Boards the lowest percentage was 32.7% in the case of J & K Board of School Education at the one end and 76.0% in the case of Board of Secondary Education, Orissa at the highest point. The other Boards that showed more than 50% included the Board of Secondary Education, Assam (54.4%), Meghalaya Board of School Education, Tura (50%), Board of Secondary Education Manipur (70.1%) and Board of Secondary Education, Rajasthan (71.5%). The sex-wise distribution of the number appeared and number passed showed almost similar percentage as that of the aggregate number -with girls showing a percentage of 40.5 and the boys showing a percentage of 42.4. Thus there was not much of variation among them.

HIGHER SECONDARY PART I EXAMINATION

In the case of Examination results in respect of Higher Secondary Part I Examinations conducted during 1970-71 to 1973-74 that appears in Tables Nos. V, VI, XI, XII, XIII, XVIII, XXIII and XXIV, in respect of a few Boards like that of Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab and the Central Board of Secondary Education, Delhi, and thus covered only a small region and a small number of students who are taking this examination. The resultant percentages in respect of both the annual and supplementary examinations have shown that whereas about 60% students pass in the annual examination, the pass percentage in the case of supplementary examinations varied between 28.2% in 1973-74 to 39.0% in the

case of 1971-72. Among these Boards the highest pass percentage over these years had been 77.0% in the case of Haryana in 1973-74 annual examination while the lowest also was shown by the same Board in a year earlier in (1972-73), in the annual examination. One exception for 1971-72 examination was that the Board of Secondary Education, Assam also conducted a similar examination.

In the overall analysis for the examinations conducted by these Boards it has been seen that whereas the annual examinations are ... conducted with a better pass percentage in almost all the Boards, the supplementary examinations do not reflect such higher percentage. The planning process for education requires us to raise the standard of education for promoting a better educational system that would automatically lead us to a better pass percentage at various levels of education. Wastages in education are more resulting from the lower pass percentage at the hands of various Boards of education and this needs an immediate remedy so that this problem may not continue to recur
