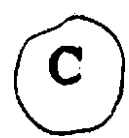

Season and Crop Report of Gujarat State for the year 1976-77.

Introduction.

The season and crop report is an annual publication of the Directorate of Agriculture, Gujarat State, Ahmedabad. This is the seventeenth report brought out in the series after formation of the Gujarat State. This report deals with agricultural statistics of the Gujarat State. It gives in detail information regarding seasonal conditions, rainfall, landutilisation, area irrigated, cropwise and sourcewise and area and outturn of different crops. Information on agricultural wages and farm (harvest) prices alongwith, live stock situation of the state during the year under report is also covered in this report.

Summary tables contain two years data at a glance for the state as a whole, while district wise data for the year 1976-77 are given in the statistical tables. This report is prepared on the basis of standard forms prescribed by the Directorate of Economics and Statistics, Government of India New Delhi.

Season.

The onset of monsoon during the agricultural year 1976-77 can be said to be little early than usual. During the first week of June 1976, adequate rainfall was received in most of the areas of the State except entire Kutch district, entire Jamnagar district (except Dhrol and Kalawad talukas and some other pockets) Ranavav and Kutiyana talukas of Junagadh district, Sami, Harij and Patau talukas of Mehsana district, Tharad, wao and Palanpur talukas of Banaskantha district, Khedbrama and Vijaynagar talukas of Sabarkantha district and Santrampur and Dohad talukas of Panchmahals district. Sowing of Kharif crops in most of the areas, where there was adequate rainfall for sowing was started in second week of June. During the second, third and fourth week of June, there was lull and dry spell continued in the most of the areas except Panchmahals, Bulsar, Dangs, and Part of Sabarkantha, Surat, Broach, Ahmedabad, Baroda and Bhavnagar districts. This dry spell further continued in the first week of July also in most of the areas except South Gujarat and Central Gujarat areas resulting in affecting the crop condition adversely. From north Gujarat areas, reports were received that crops have started withering. During this entire period the situation in the districts of Jamnagar, Kutch, Parts of Banaskantha and parts of Mehsana continued to be grave.

Fortunately, from the second week of July and there after, there were wide spread rains in all over the state including the areas which did not receive rainfall adequate for sowing earlier, and sowing could be started. In areas where standing crops needed moisture badly rainfall helped crops in recovering. Crops started growing vigorously where crops were standing. During the last week of July and first week of August, there was also wide spread heavy rainfall in the following six districts viz: Kheda, Baroda, Broach, Surat, Bulsar and Surendranagar causing floods in all the districts except Surat and Surendranagar districts, resulting in loss of agricultural crops. All the Kharif crops more or less got affected in these districts. During the second week of August except Kutch, Jamnagar, and Bhavnagar districts in whole Gujarat region wet spell continued while in last week of August, monsoon again became active and there was heavy rain in most of the districts of Baroda region. In the districts of Saurashtra and Kutch, there was rainfall at the time when crops needed, it most. Due to this rainfall, crops in south and central Gujarat districts especially bajra, cotton, sesamum and to some extent paddy crops got affected, while this rainfall in the last week of August and first week of September, improved crop prospects considerably in the districts of Saurashtra and Kutch region.

The State continued to receive rainfall upto third week of September. There after, there was withdrawing of monsoon in the state. During the year under report in the month of November during the period from 20th November to 24th November unusually unseasonal rainfall varying from 10 to 125 m.ms. was received in all over the State. This unseasonal rainfall affected crop prospects of cotton crop and resulted in deteriorating of quality of paddy in the State. Agricultural year 1976-77 especially for all the kharifs crops except, groundnut crop can be said to be unfavourable. In the case of groundnut crop, on the whole, the year can be said to be quite good.

Harvesting and threshing of kharif crops was started little late than usual due to rain in last week of August. It continued upto end of November.

Preparation of land and sowing of rabi crops was started in the second fortnight of October and continued upto the end of December. Condition of rabi crops was reported satisfactory.

Standing crops got damaged due to frost and untimely rainfall in Banaskantha, Kaira, Jamnagar and Rajkot districts in the month of January 1977.

Harvesting and threshing of rabi crops started in the last week of March and continued upto the end of May.

No serious incidence of pests and diseases was reported in the State during the year under report except Heliothis, Bollworms, and aphids in cotton.

Rainfall.

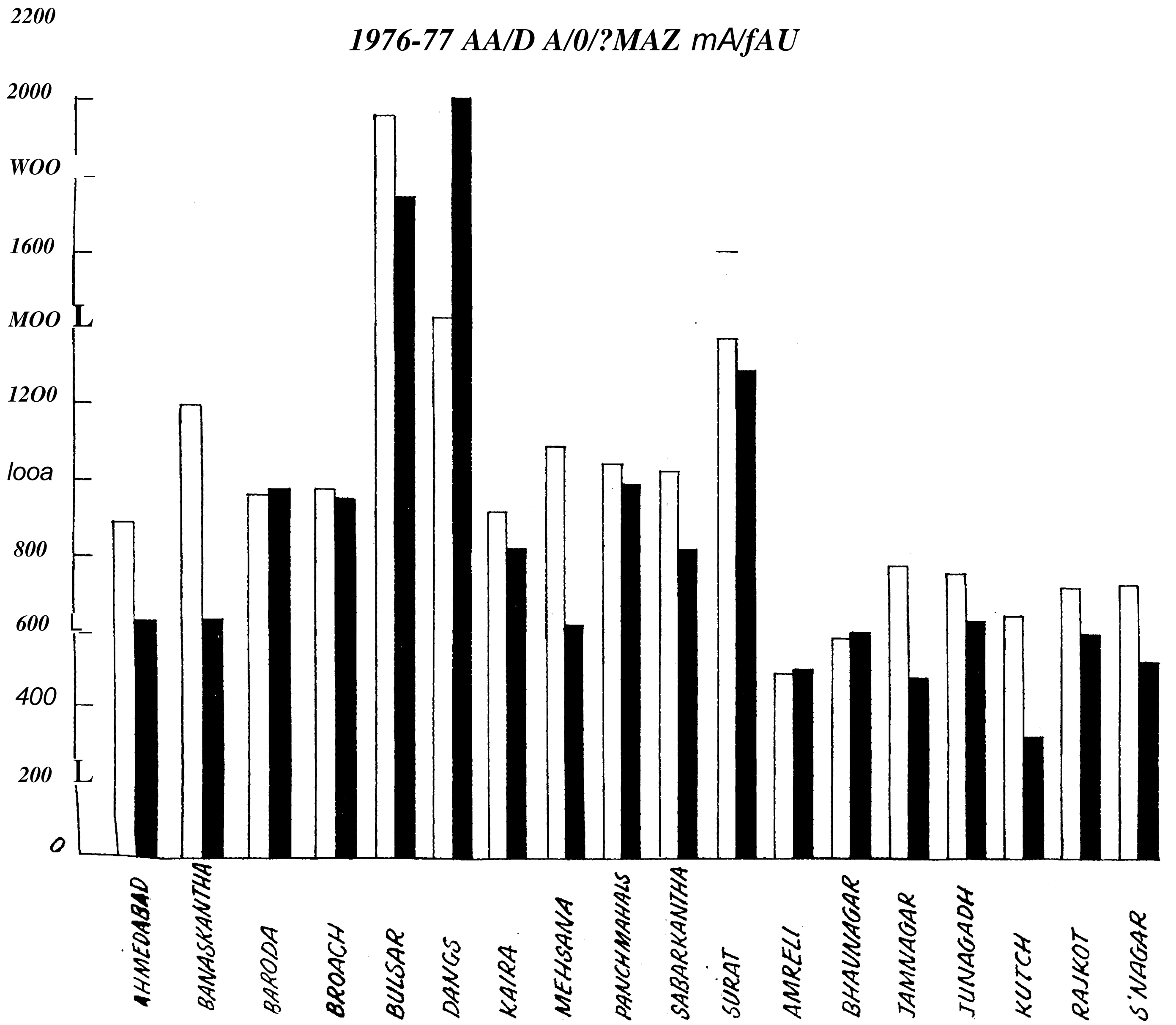

Land Utilization.—

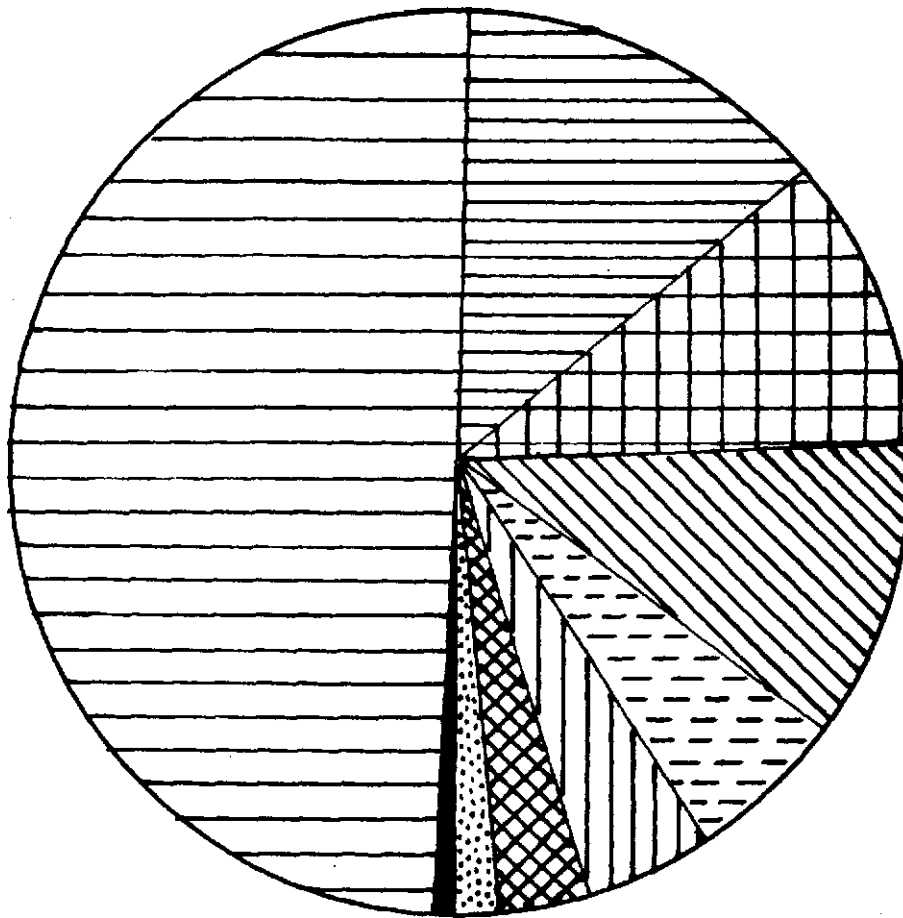
The total geographical area of Gujarat State according to Surveyor General of India during the year under report is 19598400 hectares, while total reporting area for land utilization purpose is 18809900 hectares. The area under nine standard heads of land use classification along with percentage of total reporting area for land utilisation have been shown below.

Forest.

Area under forests includes all lands classed as forest under and legal enactment dealing with forest or administrated as forest, whether state owned or private and whether v/ooded or maintained as potential forest land. The area under crops raised in the forest and grazing land or areas open for grazing land within the forests have been included under forest areas.

The total area under forest in Gujarat State during the year under itpoit is 1958900 hectares. Thus, forest accounts for 10.41% of the total repicrting area in the state, v/hile in previous year, the total area under J#st was 1889200 hectares it accounted for 10.04% of the total reporting :ea in the State.

Kutch and Panchamahals districts account for 17.50 and 11.65 percent 'the total reporting area under forest in the State while Junagadh, Dangs, anr.skantha Broach, Surat, Bulsar and Sabarkantha districts, account for .94% 8.67% 7.44% 7.39%, 7.24% 6.39% and 5.97% respectively of le total area under forest v/hile each of the reamining districts accounts for :ss than 5% of the total area in the State under forest.

Jarren and Unculturable land.

This class of land includes all barren and unculutable land like moun-
ains, deserts etc. and lands which cannot be brought under cultivation
mles3 at an exorbitant cost has been classed as unculturable. Such lands
an be isolated blacks or v/ithin cultivated holdings.

Area under this category of land is 2494500 hectares Thus, this class
If land accounts for 13.26% of the total reporting area, while in previous
year, area under barren and unculturable land was 2567200 hectares, it
accounted for 13.64% of the total reporting area.

As high as 37.57% of the total reporting area of Kutch district fill
under barren and cultuxable land wliile this class of land utilisation accounts
for 12.81%, 10.89% 10.68%, 9.96%, 8.90%, and 7.64% in Surendra-
nagar, Jamnagar, Bhavnagar, Rajkot, Ahmedabad and Surat districts res-
pectively. In rest of the districts, area under this cargory is not sizable.

3. Land put to non agricultura! wse.

This class of land includes all lands occapiied by buildings, roads, and
railways or under water ie. rivers and cann.al; and land utilised for other
than asricultural purpose. Area under this category of land during the year
under report is 1055500 ha. This works out to 5.61% of the total report-
ing aria in the state, while in previouise year, the area under this class of
land was 1063509 hectares and it accounted for 5.65% of the total re-
reporiag area.

4. Ca iurahle waste.

This class of land includes laiidr, available for cultivation wr-ether not
taken up for cultivation or taken up for culiivatJon once but not cultivated
during current year and last five years or more in succession for one reason

or the other. Such land can be either fallow or covered with shrubs and Jungles which are not put to any use. It may be assessed and may be in isolated blocks or within cultivated holdings, lands once cultivated but not cultivated for five years in succession are included in this category at the end of the five years. An area of 2004600 ha. i.e. 10.66% of the total reporting area falls under this category, while in previous year, area under this head was 2037600 ha. i.e. 10.67% of the total reporting area.

5. Permanent pasture and other grazing land.

This class of land includes all grazing lands whether they are permanent pasture and meadows or not. Village common grazing land is included under this land. Area under this category, during the year under report is 851703 ha. which works out to 4.53% of the total reporting area. In previous year, the area under this class of land was 853100 ha. it accounted for 4.53% of the total reporting area.

6. Miscellaneous crops and grooves not included in net area sown :

This class of land includes all cultivable land which is not included in net area sown" but is put to some agricultural use. Land under casuarina trees, thatching grass bamboo, bushes and other grooves etc. which are not included under "orchards" are classed under this category, area under this category of land is only 4200 ha. It accounts for hardly 0.02% of the total reporting area of the State.

7. Current fallow.

This class of land represents cropped area which is kept fallow during the current year. Land used for raising seedlings but is not cropped during the year under report is treated as current fallow. Area under this category of land during this year under report is 543000 ha. which works out to 2.89% of the total reporting area of the State.

8. Other fallows :

(Fallow land other than current fallow.)

This class of land includes all lands which are taken up for cultivation but are temporarily out of cultivation for a period of not less than one year and not more than five years. The reasons for keeping such lands fallow and may be one or more of these following: (1) Poverty of cultivator, (2) Inadequate supply of water (3) Malarial climate (4) Unremunerative nature of farming.

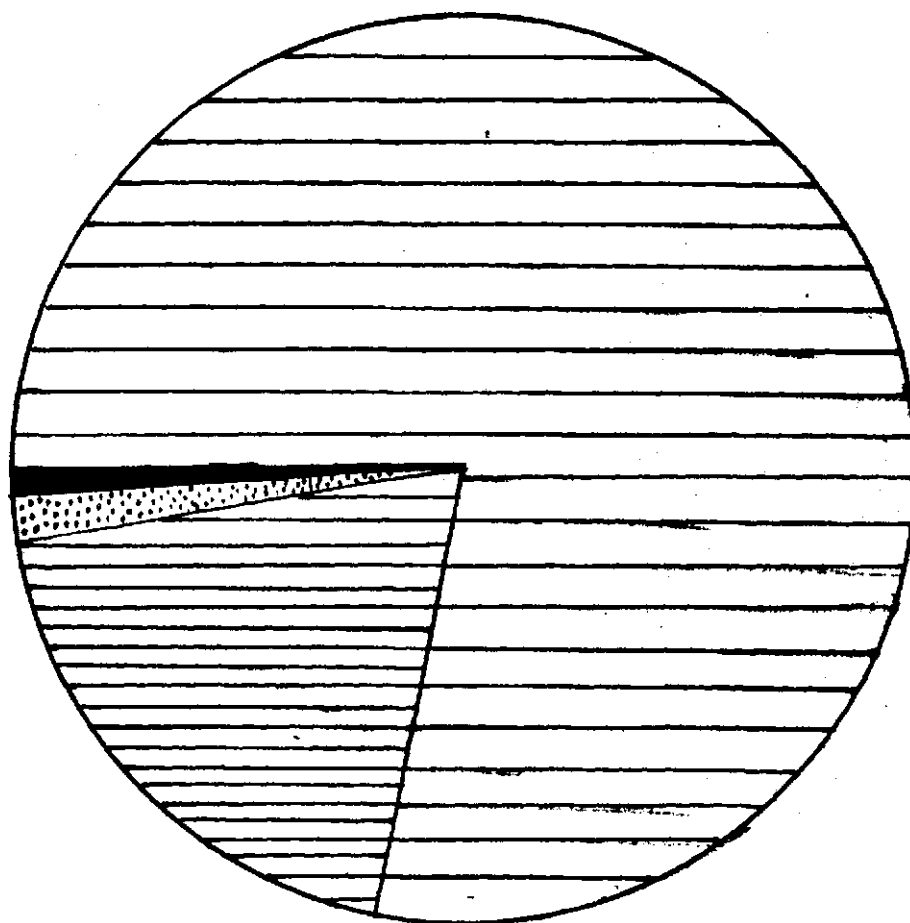
Area under this category of land is 373600 ha. which works out to 1.99% of the total reporting area of the State.

Net Area sown.

This class of land represents area sown with crops and orchards counting area sown more than once in the same year only once. Such type of land during the year under report is 9523900 ha (excluding the net sown area of Dangs dist) which works out to 50.63% of the total reporting area of the State.

In Mehsana, Kaira, AmreH and Gandhinagar districts net area sown constitutes more than 70% of the total reporting area while in Kutch and Dangs districts, net area sown is hardly of the order of 14.5% and 29.4% respectively of the total reporting area. In remaining districts, the net area sown varies from 50% to 70% of the reporting area.

Area sown more than once in the State is only 8.71 % of the net area sown during the year under report.

Area irrigated by different Sources.

Net area irrigated by different sources during the year under report is 1567100 ha. which worksout to 16.4% of net area sown in the Slate. Net gross sown area and net and gross irrigated area with percentage irrigated area of net and gross sown area in Gujarat State are as under :

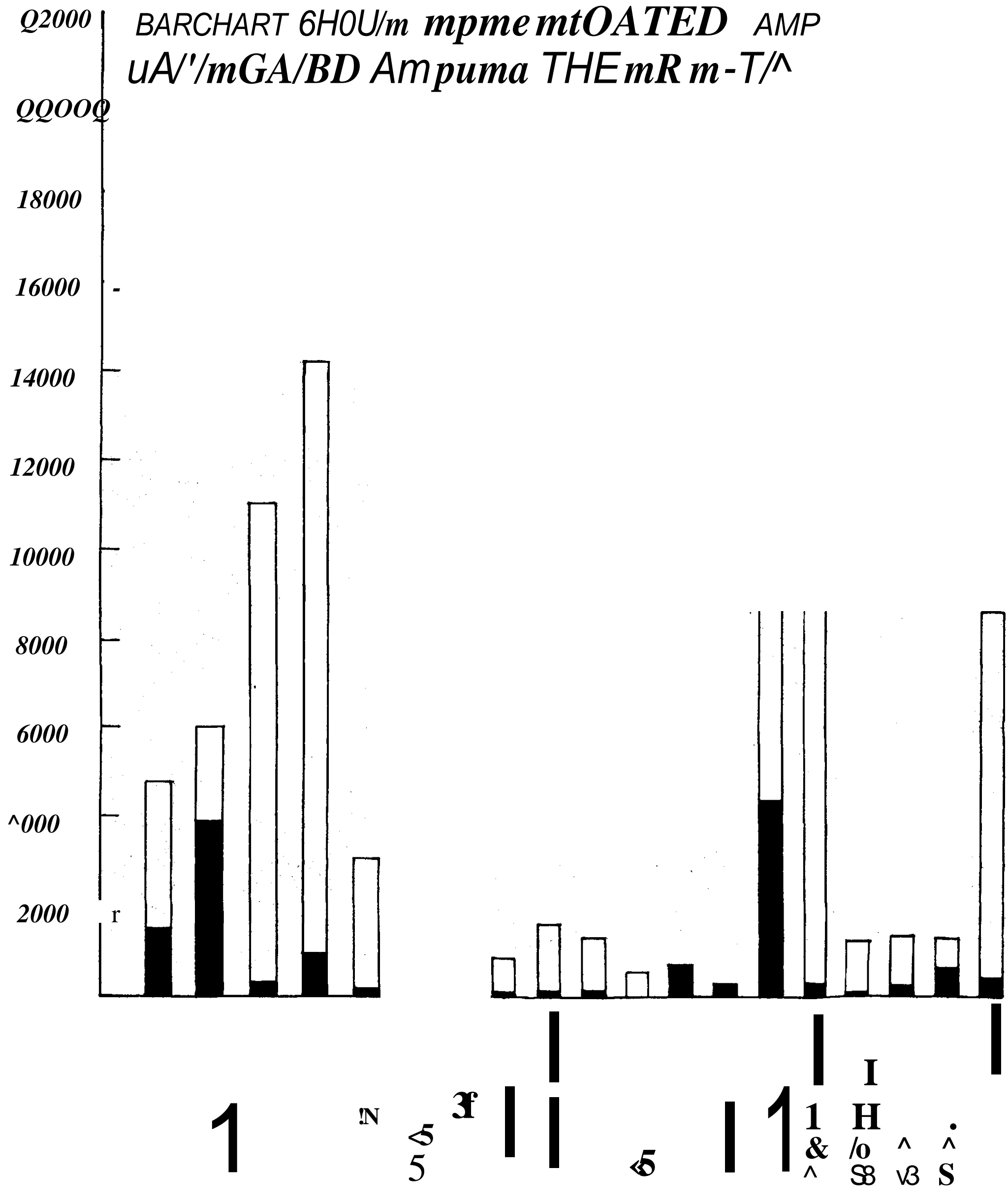

It can be seen from the above table that in 43.5% of the talukas, gross irrigated area is hardly 9.9% of the total cropped area, while in 26.6% of the talukas, gross irrigated area ranges from 10.0 to 19.9% of the total cropped area. In 13.1%, 7.2%, 5.4%, 1.6% and 2.1% of the talukas, gross irrigated area ranges from 20.0 to 29.9%, 30.0% to 39.9%, 40.9% to 49.9%, 50.0 to 59.9% and 60.0 to 69.9% of the total cropped area respectively. In 0.5 of the talukas gross irrigated area ranges from 80.0 to 89.9% of the gross cropped area.

It can be seen from the above table that well is the largest single source of irrigation in Gujarat State. In as many as 14 districts out of 19 districts and in as many as 124 talukas out of 184 talukas, well irrigation accounts for more than 75% of the total irrigated area, while canal as a source of irrigation ranks second. There are 96 talukas out of 184 talukas in 17 districts of the State in which facility of canal irrigation exists. Out of these 96 talukas is as many as 75 talukas, canal irrigation accounts for less than 50% of the total irrigated areas while in 12 talukas irrigated area by canal ranges from 50.0 to 74.9% and in the remaining 9 talukas, irrigated area by canal ranges from 75.0 to 100.0% of the total irrigated areas.



Crop wise area irrigated.

During the year under report an area of 1774100 (17.1%) of the total cropped area in the State received irrigation while in the previous year total area that received irrigation under 1709100 ha(16.3%) of the total cropped area. Thus there has been an increase in area by 65000 ha. in irrigated area over the previous year. Crop wise total area, area irrigated and irrigated area as percentage is shown in the following table.

Area under deffernt crops.

Total area under food and non food crops during the year under report is 5068500 ha. and 5335600 ha. respectively against 5590400 ha., under food crops and 4959000 ha. under non food crops during the previous year.

Information in respect of crop wise area and area as percentage of gross cropped area during the year 1975-76 and 1976-77 is shown in the following table. Barchart showing cropwise area is shown in fig. No. 5.

Jowar, Bajri, cotton and groundnut crops jointly account for 61.9% of the total cropped area during the year under report as against 63.7% of the total cropped area in the State during the previous year. These four principal crops are found to have been grown in almost all the districts of the State.

The graphs showing fluctuation in these area under crops is shown in fig. No. 6.

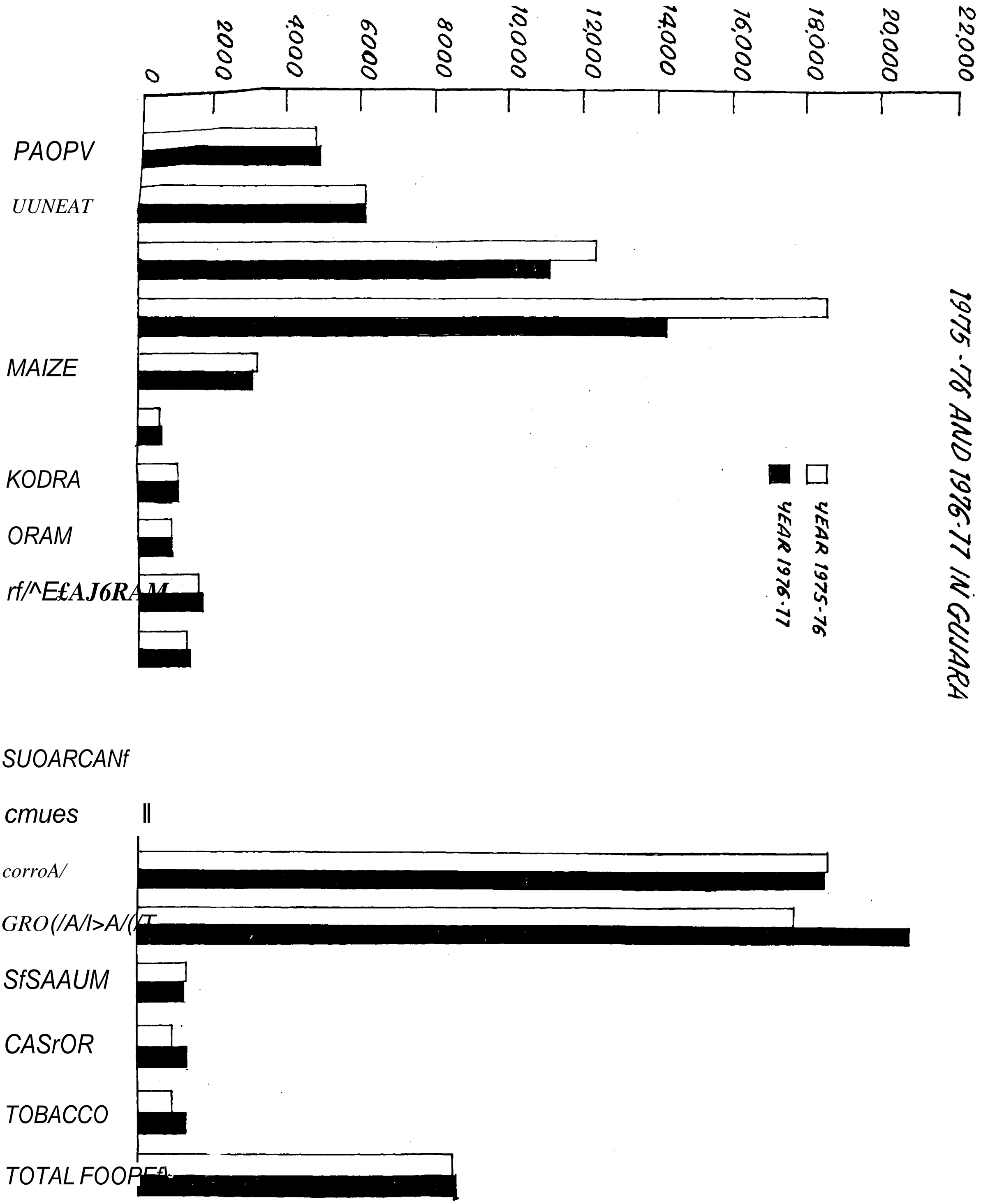

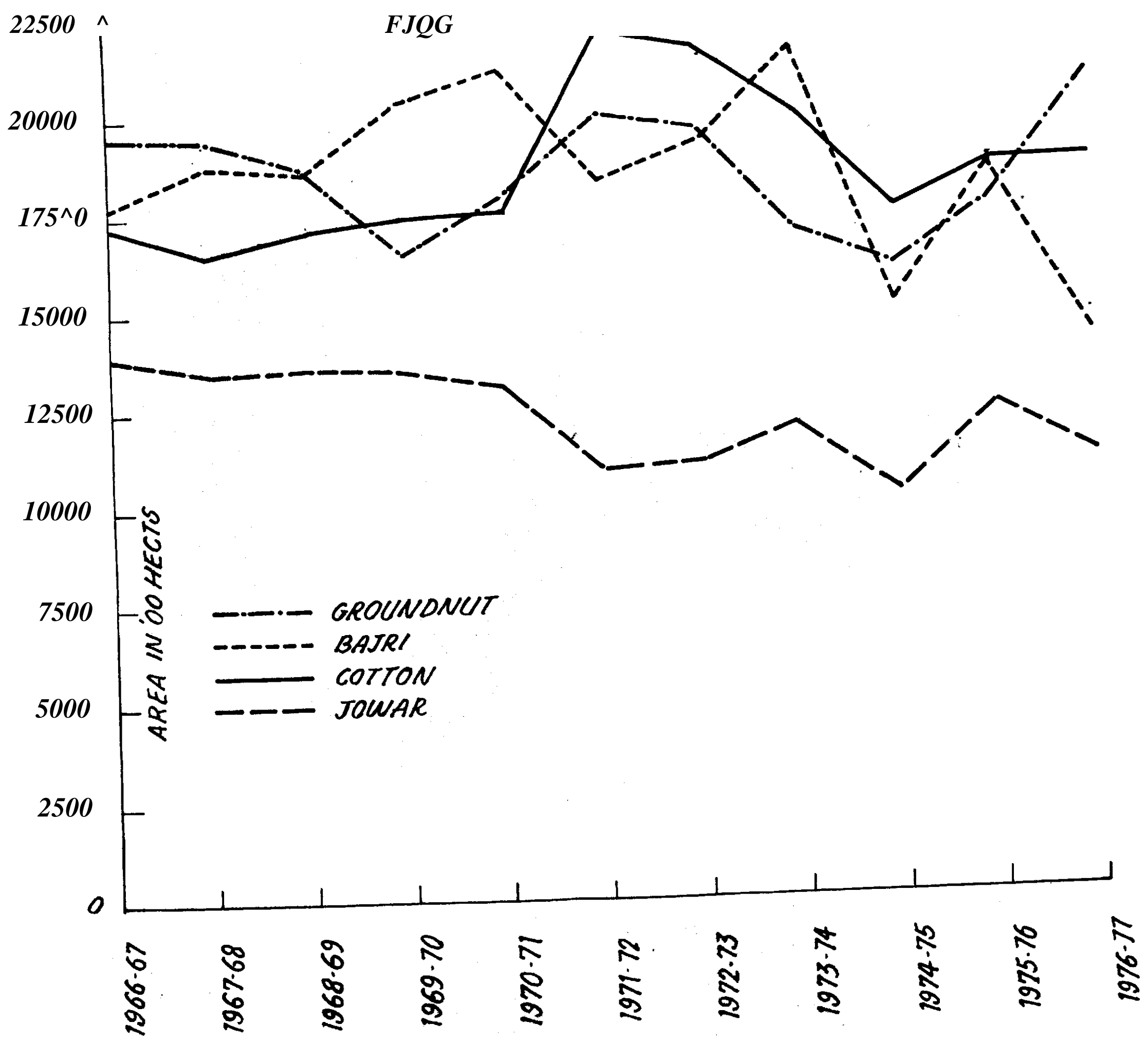
