The present publication relates to the year 1977-78.

I take this opportunity to express my thanks for the supply of the required data and other help received from the office of the Director of Public Instruction, Government of West Bengal for bringing out this publication.

It is hoped that this publication will found to be useful to Planners, Administrators and Researchers in different Organisations.

6. The total population as well as population of different age-groups of the State for the years 1971 and 1978 are based on the population estimates available from the office of the Registrar General of India whereas the district-wise population estimates for the age-groups 6-11, 11-14 and 14-17 for the year 1977-78

(as on 1-4-1977) have been worked out by using the following formulae:

We assume that

$$\frac{P_{6-11}}{P} = \frac{P_{6-11}^i}{P^i} = K, \quad i = 1, 2, 3, 4, \dots$$

$$\therefore P_{6-11}^i = KP^i,$$

Where K is estimated from the formula,

P_{6-11} = 6-11 years age-group population of the State.

P = Total Population of the State.

P_{6-11}^i = 6-11 years age-group population of the ith district.

P^i = Total population of the ith district.

7. For getting sex-wise break-up of the population in various age-groups first the girls population is estimated by the above formula by replacing total population by the girls population. Boys population can be obtained by subtracting estimated girls population from the total estimated population.

8. The estimated population in the age-group 6-11 years was 69.41 lakhs (34.97 lakhs boys and 34.44 lakhs girls) in 1977-78 whereas for the 11-14 year and 14-17 years age-group, the corresponding were estimated to be 38.30 lakhs (19.41 lakhs boys and 18.89 lakhs girls) and 35.31 lakhs (18.19 lakhs boys and 17.12 lakhs girls) respectively.

9. Among the districts this population varied from 6.74 lakhs in 24-Parganas to 0.62 lakhs in Darjeeling. The School going population in the age-group 6-17 years was 143.02 lakhs (72.57 lakhs boys and 70.45 lakhs girls) forming 27.8% of the total population in 1977-78. District-wise estimated population figures and its sex-wise break-up for different age-groups are given in Statement No.(2).

III - LITERACY

10. In 1971 the effective literacy rate viz. total number of literates per one hundred of population excluding 0-4 age-group was 38.9 for the State as a whole. The literacy rate for males was 49.6 whereas for females it was quite low i.e. only 26.6 at State level. Among the districts the highest literacy was in Calcutta 65.5 followed by Howrah (47.1) and Hooghly (45.6). Malda reported the lowest literacy rate (21.0). District-wise details of literacy can be seen from Statement No.(3).

IV. GENERAL VIEW

(a) INSTITUTIONS

11. There were 48870 recognised institutions of all types of education in 1970-71 in the State which increased to 53498 in 1977-78. The increase worked out to 9.5% during the period under review. In 1977-78, Midnapore had the highest number of institutions (8617) followed by 24-Parganas (8097) and Burdwan (4726). The lowest number of institutions (1163) was in Darjeeling. District-wise position of institutions for the years 1970-71 and 1977-78 is given in Statement No.(4).

(b) ENROLMENT

12. The total enrolment in all types of institutions was 70.48 lakhs in 1970-71 which increased to 80.14 lakhs by 1977-78. The average annual increase of enrolment works out to 2.0% during the period under consideration. Among the districts the percentage share was the highest 16.1 in 24-Parganas and the lowest in Darjeeling(2.1).

13. The increase in enrolment was observed in all the districts except Howrah.

14. The sex-ratio of enrolment viz. number of girls enrolled for every 100 boys was 56 in 1970-71 which increased to 59 in 1977-78.

15. The total enrolment in all educational institutions as a percentage to the population decreased from 15.9% in 1970-71 to 15.6% in 1977-78 for the State as a whole. Among the districts it varied from 12.0% in case of Jalpaiguri to 18.5% in case of Darjeeling during 1977-78. District-wise particulars of enrolment are given in Statement No. (5).

(c) TEACHERS

16. Total number of teachers in all types of educational institutions in the State increased from 224369 in 1970-71 to 248987 in 1977-78 showing an annual increase rate of 1.57% during the period. Number of teachers increased in all the districts except Calcutta, Howrah and 24-Parganas.

17. In 1977-78 out of total number of teachers in the State, 240542 were employed in schools thus forming 96.6% of the total strength of teachers in all types of institutions. Among the school teachers only 55.7% were trained. Among the districts the percentage of trained teachers varied from 72.7% in Murshidabad to 36.4% in 24-Parganas. District-wise particulars of trained and untrained teachers have been given in Statement No. (6).

(a) EXPENDITURE

18. The total expenditure incurred on all types of institutions in the State increased from Rs.78.94 crores in 1970-71 to Rs.162.62 crores in 1977-78 showing an average annual increase of 15.1%. In 1977-78, the percentage share of expenditure was the highest in case of Calcutta (45.7%) and the lowest in case of Purulia (19.1%).

19. The expenditure on education per head of institution was Rs.16153 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.30396 in 1977-78. Among the districts, the educational expenditure per head of the institution varied from Rs.109201 in Calcutta to Rs.10547 in Purulia in 1977-78.

20. The educational expenditure per head of population was Rs.17.8 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.31.6 in 1977-78. The per-capita expenditure among the districts varied from Rs.65.8 in case of Calcutta to Rs.17.4 in Purulia in 1977-78. The per capita expenditure increased in all the districts in 1977-78 as compared to that of 1970-71. District-wise educational expenditure, expenditure per institution and per capita expenditure can be seen from Statement No.(7).

(e) EXTENT OF COVERAGE OF SCHEDULED CASTES AND SCHEDULED TRIBES

21. The total enrolment of Scheduled Caste students in the State was 1081338 (721809 boys and 359529 girls) forming 13.5% of the enrolment at State level. The enrolment percentage for Scheduled Caste boys was 14.4% and for girls 12.0%. Among the districts the enrolment percentage for Scheduled Castes varied from the highest of 43.9% in Cooch Behar to 7.3% in Murshidabad.

22. Percentage of Scheduled Castes population to total population in the State was 19.9% in 1977-78. The extent of coverage of Scheduled Castes population was estimated to be 67.8 in all types of educational institutions at State level in 1977-78. Among the districts the extent of coverage varied from 134.2 in Calcutta to 42.0 in Burdwan. District-wise particulars of Scheduled Castes enrolment, percentages and extent of coverage are given in Statement No.(8).

23. Total enrolment of Scheduled Tribes community in educational institutions of the State was 243603 in 1977-78. This comprised of 174474 boys and 69129 girls. In terms of percentage this was 3.04% (3.47% boys and 2.31% girls). Percentage of Scheduled Tribes enrolment to the total enrolment among the districts varied from 15.40% in Purulia to 0.09% in Calcutta. District-wise particulars of enrolment, enrolment percentages and their extent of coverage are given in Statement No.(9).

V. PRE PRIMARY EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS

24. The total No. of Pre-Primary Schools in West Bengal slightly decreased from 183 in 1970-71 to 181 in 1977-78. This was due to upgradation of some schools in the State. The Highest number of Pre-primary schools was 43 in 24 Parganas and the lowest was 1 in Cooch Behar District in 1977-78.

(b) ENROLMENT

25. Total enrolment in all the Pre-primary schools increased from 11029 in 1970-71 to 13181 in 1977-78. However the enrolment of children in Pre-Primary classes which was reported to be 15366 (8327 boys and 7039 girls) in 1970-71 increased to 19633 (11061 boys and 8572 girls) by 1977-78. Among the districts the highest enrolment was 2017 in Midnapore and the lowest was 46 in Cooch Behar.

(c) TEACHERS

26. Teachers in Pre-Primary schools increased from 456 in 1970-71 to 493 in 1977-78. The highest number of Teachers was 83 in 24-Parganas and the lowest was 2 in Cooch Behar.

(d) EXPENDITURE

27. Total expenditure incurred on Pre-primary schools was Rs.10.83 lakhs in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.18.61 lakhs in 1977-78 showing an average annual growth of 10.25% during the period.

(e) S.C. AND S.T. ENROLMENT

28. The number of S.C./S.T. children studying in Pre-Primary schools has increased from 868 in 1970-71 to 1180 in 1977-78. In 1977-78 the enrolment forms 918, S.C. children and 262 S.T. children. Statement 10 gives district-wise details of Pre-Primary schools, enrolment, teachers, expenditure and S.C./S.T. children.

VI. - PRIMARY EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS

29. Total number of primary schools increased from 35788 in 1970-71 to 41603 in 1977-78 showing an increase of 16.2% during the period under review.

30. The average area served by a primary school was 2.5 sq.kms. of State level. Condition slightly improved during the period as on an average a primary school was available for every 2.1 Sq.Kms.

31. Population served by a primary school was 1238 in 1970-71 whereas in 1977-78 on an average a primary school served 1237 persons.

(b) TEACHERS

32. Number of teachers in primary schools increased from 121097 in 1970-71 to 150447 (123619 males and 26828 females) in 1977-78 showing an annual increase of 3.5% during the period under review. In 1977-78, teachers employed in different districts varied from the highest of 21296 in 24-Parganas to 3639 in Darjeeling. District-wise details are given in Statement No. (11).

(c) ENROLMENT

33. Enrolment in classes I-V was 47.93 lakhs (29.60 lakhs boys and 18.33 lakh girls) in 1970-71 which is reported to have increased to 55.97 lakhs comprising 34.29 lakh boys and 21.68 lakh girls by 1977-78 at the State level. This shows an annual increase of 2.4% during the period. The increase for boys comes out to be 2.3% and for girls 2.6%.

34. The enrolment ratio in classes I-V to the population of age-group 6-11 gives an index of facilities created at the primary stage of education. For the West Bengal State as a whole this ratio increased from 76.6 to 80.6 during the period 1970-71 to 1977-78. The corresponding enrolment ratio for boys increased from 92.7 to 98.1 and for girls from 59.8 to 62.9 during the period under consideration. Taking both boys and girls together these enrolment ratios among the districts varied from the highest of 103.8 in Midnapore to 57.6 in Calcutta in 1977-78. In 8 districts the enrolment ratios were more than that of the State level.

(1) SCHEDULED CASTES & SCHEDULED TRIBES ENROLMENT

35. Of the total enrolment, 8.35 lakhs belonged to Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes communities in 1970-71 in classes I-V of this Scheduled Caste & Scheduled Tribe boys were 5.97 lakhs forming 20.2% of the total enrolment of boys. Scheduled Caste & Scheduled Tribe girls

formed 13.0% of total girl students in classes I-V. In 1977-78 Scheduled Castes enrolment formed 15.0% (15.8% boys and 13.6% girls). Taking boys and girls together the enrolment percentage for Scheduled Castes varied among districts from 44.6 in Cooch Behar to 8.9 in Midnapore. In classes I-V Scheduled Tribe students formed 3.37% (3.87% boys and 2.58% girls). Among the districts there was a large variation of Scheduled Tribes enrolment percentage which varied from 16.63% in Purulia to 0.11% in Calcutta in 1977-78. The percentage of Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes population was 19.9% and 5.7% respectively in 1977-78. Extent of coverage of Scheduled Caste & Scheduled Tribe students separately is estimated to be 75.4% and 59.1% respectively in 1977-78. District-wise details of enrolment of Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes in Primary classes are given in Statement No. (13).

The co-efficient of equality or extent of coverage is defined as:-

$$I = \frac{\text{Percentage of Scheduled Castes \& Scheduled Tribes enrolment to total enrolment}}{\text{Percentage of Scheduled Castes \& Scheduled Tribes population to total population}} \times 100$$

(e) EXPENDITURE

36. The expenditure on all primary schools of the State increased from 23.96 crores in 1970-71 to 57.43 crores in 1977-78 showing an average annual increase of 19.9% during the period under review. The expenditure is reported to have increased in all the districts. Expenditure incurred on primary schools as percentage to total educational expenditure was 30.3% in 1970-71 which increased to 35.3% in 1977-78 for the State as a whole. In 1977-78, among the districts the highest percentage was in case of West Dinajpur (60.7%) and the lowest in Calcutta (6.7%).

37. The average expenditure for a primary school was Rs.6.69 thousand in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.13.80 thousand in 1977-78 at State level.

38. The expenditure on primary schools as per head of population in the State is worked out to be Rs.5.4 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.11.2 in 1977-78. Among the districts it varied from Rs.20.5 in Midnapore to Rs.4.4 in Calcutta in 1977-78.

39. The average cost per student in primary schools was Rs.55.6 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.113.2 in 1977-78. The cost per student varied among the districts from Rs.163.2 in Midnapore to Rs.69.4 in Calcutta in 1977-78.

40. In 1970-71 one teacher was available for every 36 students in primary schools. It decreased to 34 students showing an improvement in teacher pupil-ratio. Statement No. (14) give district-wise details of expenditure on primary schools, expenditure per head of population, cost per student and teacher pupil-ratio in primary schools. Table (3) below gives expenditure per head of population, percentage share of expenditure on primary schools, cost per student and teacher-pupil ratio in primary schools.

VII - MIDDLE SCHOOL EDUCATION
INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS

41. Total number of middle schools in the State was 2959 in 1970-71 which increased to 3207 in 1977-78. Among the districts the number of middle schools was the highest 729 in 24 Parganas followed by 625 in Midnapore and the lowest in Darjeeling 34 in 1977-78. The average area served by a middle school was 29.7 s.q.kms. in 1970-71 for the State as a whole whereas in 1977-78 a middle school was available for an area of 27.4 sq. kms. in the State.

42. During 1970-71, on an average a middle school was available for every population of 14975 whereas in 1977-78 a middle school was available for a population of 16043 persons.

43. The total number of teachers employed in middle schools was 13725 in 1970-71 which increased to 15122 in 1977-78 at the average annual increase of 1.5% during the period under review. District-wise details of institutions and teachers are given in Statement No.15.

(b) ENROLMENT

44. Total enrolment in middle schools was 3.84 lakhs in 1970-71 which increased to 5.06 lakhs by the year 1977-78 at State level. At the same time enrolment in middle classes for the State as a whole was 11.19 lakhs (7.29 lakhs boys and 3.90 lakh girls) in 1970-71 and by the year 1977-78 the enrolment in these classes had gone up to 12.87 lakhs (8.15 lakhs boys and 4.72 lakh girls) showing an average annual increase of 2.1% during the period. Among the districts the highest enrolment was 262.7 thousands in 24 Parganas followed by 196.5 thousands in Midnapore and the lowest in case of Darjeeling 19.2 thousands in 1977-78.

45. The enrolment ratio at the middle stage which is defined as the percentage of enrolment in classes VI-VIII to the total population in age-group of 11-14 years gives an index of facilities created at the middle stage education. For the State as a whole the enrolment ratio was 34.3% (42.7% for boys and 25.1% for girls) in 1970-71. In 1977-78 the enrolment ratio slightly decreased to 33.6% (42.0% for boys and 25.0% for girls). Among the districts the enrolment ratio was the highest in case of Iladiv 43.1% followed by Midnapore 41.3% and the lowest in Jalpaiguri and in 1977-78. District-wise details of enrolment in middle education classes are given in Statement No.(16). Table(4) below gives district-wise position of enrolment in 1977-78 as percentage of enrolment in 1970-71.

(c) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES AND SCHEDULED TRIBES

46. In 1970-71 total enrolment of scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe students in classes VI-VIII was 1,15,241 (92,392 boys and 22849 girls) constituting 10.3% of the total enrolment in these classes at State level. In 1977-78 the enrolment of Scheduled Castes in classes VI-VIII was 67503 (48808 boys and 18695 girls) forming 5.2% of total enrolment. Boys and girls separately formed 6.0% and 4.0% of their total respective enrolments. Of the total enrolment Scheduled Tribes students formed 1.40% (1.63% boys and 1.01% girls).

47. The extent of coverage of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe students in classes VI-VIII is worked out to be 40.2% in 1970-71.

48. The extent of coverage works out to be 26.1% for Scheduled Castes and 24.6% for Scheduled Tribes in 1977-78. District-wise details of enrolment for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes are given in Statement No.17.

(d) EXPENDITURE

₹crores

49. Total expenditure on middle schools for the State as a whole was ₹.3.31 in 1970-71 which increased to ₹.8.51 crores after 7 years in 1977-78 showing an average annual increase of 22.4% in expenditure during the period under consideration. Among the districts expenditure incurred on middle schools varied from the highest of ₹.2.21 crores in 24 Parganas followed by ₹.1.27 crores in Midnapore and the lowest of ₹.1.04 lakhs in 1977-78. (Anglo Indian)

50. Expenditure incurred on middle schools as per head of population was ₹.0.7 in 1970-71 which increased to ₹.1.7 in 1977-78 at State level. In 1977-78 among the districts the expenditure per head of population varied from ₹.2.9 the highest in Hooghly to ₹.0.4 the lowest in Calcutta.

51. Total expenditure made on middle schools for the State as a whole formed 4.5% of the total educational expenditure in 1970-71. This percentage increased to 5.2% by 1977-78. The percentage expenditure for middle schools varied from the highest of 9.2% in Cochin Bhar followed by 8.6% in 24 Parganas and the lowest was 9.5% in Calcutta during 1977-78.

52. Cost per student in middle schools was ₹.86.2 in 1970-71 for the State as a whole which increased to ₹.283.1 in 1977-78. Among the districts it varied from the highest of ₹.430.2 in Bankura followed by ₹.298.4 in Hooghly to the lowest of ₹.46.4 in Nadia in 1977-78. In 10 districts cost per student in middle schools works out to more than the State average.

53. For the State as a whole the teacher-pupil ratio in middle schools was 28 in 1970-71 which increased to 33 in 1977-78. Among the districts in 1977-78, it varied from 52 in Nadia followed by to the lowest of 16 in Statement No. (18) indicates the district-wise details of 44 in Midnapore expenditure on middle schools, Bankura, expenditure per head of population, cost per student and teacher pupil ratio. Table (5) below indicates percentage of educational expenditure to the total expenditure, expenditure per head of population, cost per student and teacher pupil ratio for the districts separately.

VIII. HIGH/HIGHER SECONDARY SCHOOLS

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS

54. There were 4199 high/higher secondary schools in the State in 1970-71 which slightly decreased to 3921 in 1977-78 showing an average annual decrease of 1.0% during the period under consideration. In 1977-78, the highest number of such institutions was in 24 Parganas 833 followed by Midnapore 569 and the lowest 58 in Darjeeling. Decrease is due to the upgradation of High/Hr. Secondary Schools.

55. In 1970-71 the average area served by a high higher secondary school was 20.9 sq.kms. Whereas in 1977-78 as for every 22.4 sq. kms. one such institution was available. In 1977-78 the average area served by a high/higher secondary school varied from 0.3 sq.kms followed by 6.8 sq.kms. in Howrah to the lowest of 53.0 sq.kms. in Darjeeling.

56. Average population served by a high/higher secondary school in the State was 10553 in 1970-71. In 1977-78 whereas for every population of 13122 one such institution was available. In the year 1977-78 average population served by a high/higher secondary school varied from 24006 in Malda to 10158 in Birbhum district.

57. Total number of teachers employed in high/higher secondary schools in the State was 63955 in 1970-71 which decreased to 55786 in 1977-78 showing an average annual decrease of 1.6% during the period. Statement No.(19) shows district-wise number of high/higher secondary schools, teachers employed, area and population served by high/higher secondary schools.

(b) ENROLMENT

58. Enrolment in high/higher secondary schools was 15.6 lakhs in 1977-78 against 17.8 lakhs in 1970-71. Enrolment in classes IX-XII in the State decreased from 5.5 lakhs (3.18 lakhs boys and 1.7 lakh girls) in 1970-71 to 5.1 lakhs (3.5 lakh boys and 1.6 lakh girls) in 1977-78 at an average annual decrease of 1.04% during the period. Corresponding annual decrease among the boys was 1.12% and for girls was 0.84%. In 1977-78 enrolment varied from 105122 the highest in 24 Parganas followed by 78657 in Midnapore to 8533 the lowest in Darjeeling.

59. At the State level enrolment ratio at the high/higher secondary classes (i.e. enrolment in classes IX-XII as percentage to the population of corresponding period in the age-group 14-17 years) decreased from 19.3% to 14.6% during the period of 7 years. In case of boys it decreased from 25.0% to 19.4% and for girls from 12.4% to 9.4%

during the period under consideration. The enrolment ratio decreased in all the districts except Murshidabad during the period under review. In 1977-78 the ratio varied from 21.2% highest in Calcutta to 7.0% in Jalpaiguri and Malda. District-wise details of enrolment are given in Statement No. (20). Table (6) below gives enrolment in 1977-78 as percentage to that of 1970-71 and percentage of girls enrolment.

(c) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES AND SCHEDULED TRIBES

60. In 1970-71, of the total students 5.2% were of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe community. In 1977-78 24.0% enrolment was of Scheduled Caste and 5.34% was of Scheduled Tribe community in classes IX-XII at State level. Scheduled Caste boys accounted for 26.0% of the total boys enrolment whereas Scheduled Caste girls accounted for 19.6% of the total girls enrolment in the State in classes IX-XII during 1977-78. Among the Scheduled Tribes the percentage enrolment was 6.03% and 3.84% respectively when compared to the total boys and girl enrolment. Among the districts the percentage of Scheduled Castes enrolment varied from 99.0% in Calcutta followed by W.Dingj Pur 69.4% to the lowest in Murshidabad 0.3% during 1977-78.

61. In 1970-71 the population of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes taken together was 24.2% and the extent of coverage or co-efficient of equality was estimated to be 24.2% in classes IX-XI. In 1977-78 the extent of coverage works out to be 120.6% for Scheduled Castes and 93.7% for Scheduled Tribes separately in high/higher secondary classes. District-wise details of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes enrolment are given in Statement No.(21).

(d) EXPENDITURE

62. Total expenditure on high/higher Secondary schools in the State was ₹.25.5 crores in 1970-71 which rose to ₹.59.6 crores in 1977-78. Average annual increase of expenditure works out to be 19.0% during the period of 7 years. Among the districts the expenditure incurred on high/higher secondary schools varied from ₹.11.0 crores the highest in 24 Pargnas to ₹.99.3 lakhs the lowest in Jalpaiguri district in 1977-78.

63. Expenditure on high/higher secondary schools as per head of population was ₹.5.8 in 1970-71 which rose to ₹.11.6 in 1977-78 for the State as a whole. In 1977-78 among the districts it varied from ₹.16.0 the highest in Darjeeling to ₹.4.9 the lowest in Jalpaiguri. In 6 districts the expenditure on high/higher secondary schools was more than the State average. (per head population)

64. Per capita expenditure in high/higher secondary schools was ₹.143.5 in 1970-71 which increase to ₹.406.6 in 1977-78. In 1977-78 among the districts cost per student varied from ₹.207.0 in Darjeeling followed by ₹.509.6 in Purlia to the lowest of ₹.221.7 in Howrah. In 7 districts per capita expenditure in these schools was more than the State average. Teacher pupil ration was 28 in 1970-71 for the State as a whole which decreased to 26 in 1977-78. In 1977-78 teacher pupil ratio was the highest in Howrah 53 and the lowest 17 in Murshidabad. Statement No.(22) gives district-wise details of expenditure on high/higher

secondary schools as percentage of total expenditure, expenditure per head of population, cost per student and teacher pupil ratio.

III - PROFESSIONAL, VOCATIONAL, SPECIAL AND OTHER (SCHOOL) EDUCATION

65. Total number of institutions of professional, vocational, special and other (school) education was 5073 in 1970-71 which decreased to 3918 in 1977-78 showing an average annual decrease of 3.3% during the period. Total enrolment of these institutions was 192286 (151995 boys and 40291 girls) which decreased to 143087 (96913 boys and 46174 girls) in 1977-78 showing an average annual decrease of 3.7% during the period under review.

66. Out of the total enrolment in 1970-71, the enrolment of Scheduled Castes and scheduled Tribes was 54611 (46093 boys and 8518 girls). In 1977-78 there were 27112 Scheduled Caste students and 7,658 Scheduled Tribe students.

67. Total number of teachers employed in these institutions decreased from 8506 in 1970-71 to 7129 (5256 men and 1873 women) in 1977-78 showing an average annual decrease of 2.3%.

68. The expenditure incurred on all type of institutions of professional, vocational, special and other (school) education was ₹.124.00 lakhs in 1970-71 which increased to ₹.176.41 lakhs in 1977-78. Statement No.(23) gives district-wise particulars of the number of institutions, enrolment, teachers and expenditure for institutions of professional, vocational, special and other (school) education.

X - HIGHER EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS

69. Total number of all types of institutions of higher education was 532 in 1970-71 which increased to 608 in 1977-78 showing an average annual increase of 3.6%. Out of the total number of higher institutions in the State there were 15 universities, 24 institutions of education, 8 engineering, technological and architectural colleges; 4 law colleges and 19 medical colleges. The number of arts, science and commerce colleges was 243 and the number of institutions for other education was 5.

70. Total number of teachers employed in all institutions of higher education increased from 16630 in 1970-71 to 20010 in 1977-78 showing an average annual increase of 2.9%. District-wise details of institutions and teachers are given in Statement No.(24).

(b) ENROLMENT

71. Total enrolment in all types of higher education courses was 381463 in 1970-71 which increased to 401940 in 1977-78. Of the total enrolment in 1977-78, 16997 were studying in universities, 280028 in arts, science and commerce colleges, 4,272 in institutions of education 3149 in engineering colleges, 2,210 in law colleges, 6755 in medical colleges and 711 in institution of other education. There was an annual increase of 0.8% in the enrolment during the period under consideration. District-wise details are given in Statement No.(25). Statement No.(26) also gives district-wise details of enrolment in general higher education and professional higher education by type of education for the year 1977-78. Total enrolment in general higher education was 398520 (282233 boys and 116287 girls) and in professional higher education, it was observed to be 54542 (41037 boys and 13505 girls) during 1977-78.

(c) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES AND SCHEDULED TRIBES

72. In 1970-71 the enrolment of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe communities jointly was 27751 (24580 boys and 3171 girls) forming 7.3% of total enrolment in classes of higher education. In 1977-78 the corresponding enrolment of Scheduled Castes was 24128 (19483 boys and 4645 girls). On the other hand 1544 (1158 boys and 386 girls) of Scheduled Tribes were enrolled in 1977-78. Percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes was 6.0% and 0.4% respectively in classes of higher education in 1977-78. District-wise details of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes enrolment have been given in Statement No.(27).

(d) EXPENDITURE

72. Total expenditure on all types of institutions of higher education was 24.80 crores in 1970-71 which increased to 35.57.69 crores in 1977-78 at an average annual increase of 19.0% during the period under consideration. Total expenditure on institutions of higher education in 1977-78 formed 35.5% of total educational expenditure of the State. Of the total expenditure on higher education 30.47 crores 52.8% was on universities, 3.23.56 crores 40.8% on affiliated institutions (degree level) the substantial part viz. 70.3% was incurred on arts, science and commerce colleges in 1977-78. Statement No.(28) gives district-wise details of expenditure made on institutions of higher education.

and 2.21 crores (3.8%) on boards of Secondary and Hr. Secondary Education of the total expenditure on affiliated institutions.
