INTRODUCTION

The Ministry of Education & Culture collects and publishes the educational statistics at State level on annual basis. However, keeping inview the wide disparities within a State, educational data is collected and published on quinquennially separately for each State. This volume is the twenty-third in the series of the Educational Statistics - District-wise for the years 1970-71 - 1976-77.

2. For making inter district comparisons, important educational indicators such as enrolment ratio, co-efficient of equality for scheduled caste & scheduled tribe teacher pupil ratio, cost per student and population served by an institution etc. have been worked out at district level. These indices show wide range of variation among the districts and are of great use for formulating educational development plans at district level.

II - AREA AND POPULATION

3. Tamil Nadu consists of 15 districts. The number of districts in the State remained the same during the period 1971 to 1977. The total area of the State, being 1.30 lakh sq. kms., remained unchanged during the period under review. Among the districts the area varies from as high as 15,673 sq. kms. in Coimbatore to as low as 128 sq. kms. in Madras.

4. The total population of the State is estimated to be 452.05 lakhs (229.19 lakhs males and 222.86 lakhs females in 1977. Among the districts the highest population was in Coimbatore (47.48 lakhs) and the lowest in Nilgiris (5.42 lakhs). In 1971, the total population of the State was 411.99 lakhs (208.28 lakhs males and 203.71 lakhs females). The average annual growth of the population works out to be 1.62% during the period 1971 to 1977.

5. The density of population for the State as a whole was 317 per sq. kms. in 1971 which is estimated to have increased to 348 by 1977. In 1977, the highest density of population was in Madras 21,169 followed by Kanya Kumari 797, Thanjavur 433 and Chengalpattu 403. The most thinly populated districts were Dharmapuri 191, Nilgiris 213 and Ramanathapuram 250. Table (1) gives the district-wise percentage share of area and percentage share of population for the year 1977.

7. For getting sex-wise break-up of the population in various age-groups first the girls population is estimated by the above formula by replacing total population by the girls population. Boys population can be obtained by subtracting estimated girls population from the total estimated population.

8. The estimated population in the age-group 6-11 years was 57.13 lakhs (29.37 lakh males and 27.76 lakh females) in 1976-77 whereas for the 11-14 years and 14-17 years age-group, the corresponding figures were estimated to be 32.68 lakhs (16.55 lakh males and 16.13 lakh females) 29.92 lakh (15.11 lakh males and 14.81 lakh females) respectively.

9. Among the districts population in the age-group 14-17 varied from 3.17 lakhs in Coimbatore to 0.35 lakhs in Nilgiris. The school going population in the age-group 6-17 years was 119.75 lakhs (61.04 lakh males and 58.71 lakh females) forming 26.49% of the total population in 1976-77. Districtwise estimated population figures and sexwise breakup for different age-groups are given in Statement No.(2).

III - LITERACY

10. In 1971 the effective literacy rate viz. total number of literates per one hundred of population excluding 0-4 age-group was 30.6 for the State as a whole. The literacy rate for males was 44.5 whereas for females it was quite less i.e. 16.4 at State level. Among the districts the highest literacy was in Madras 56.9 followed by Kanya Kumari 52.0 and Nilgiris 38.8, Dharmapuri reported the lowest literacy rate i.e. 16.2. Districtwise details of literacy can be seen in Statement No.(3).

IV - GENERAL VIEW

(a) INSTITUTIONS

11. There were 35,371 recognised institutions of all types of education in 1970-71 which increased to 36,694 in 1976-77. The increase works out to be 3.7% during the period under review. In 1976-77, North Arcot 3,577 had the maximum number of institutions followed by Coimbatore 3,479 and Ramanathpuram 3,405. Nilgiris had the lowest number of institutions i.e. 508. Districtwise position of institutions for the years 1970-71 and 1976-77 may be seen in Statement No.(4).

(b) ENROLMENT

12. The total enrolment in all types of institutions was 72.23 lakhs in 1970-71 which increased to 84.12 lakhs by 1976-77. The average annual increase of enrolment works out to be 2.7% during the period under consideration. The percentage share was the maximum in Madurai 9.9% followed by Coimbatore 9.8% and North Arcot 8.7%. Nilgiri had the lowest percentage share i.e. 1.4%.

13. The increase in enrolment was observed in all the districts.

14. The sex-ratio of enrolment viz. number of girls enrolled for every 100 boys was 40 in 1970-71 which increased to 41 in 1976-77.

15. The total enrolment in all educational institutions as percentage to the population increased from 11.5% in 1970-71 to 18.6% in 1976-77 for the State as a whole. Among the districts it varied from 15.17% in case of Trichirapalli to 24.5% in case of Kanya Kumari during 1976-77. Districtwise particulars of enrolment are given in Statement No.(5).

(c) TEACHERS

16. Total number of teachers in all types of educational institutions in the State increased from 2,44,765 in 1970-71 to 2,72,748 showing an average annual increase 1.9% during the period. Number of teachers increased in all the districts except Madras.

17. In 1976-77 out of total number of teachers in the State, 2,51,844 was employed in schools thus forming 92.3% of the total strength of teachers in all types of institutions. Among the teachers only 99.6% were trained. The percentage of trained teachers among the women teachers was 97.3% for 1976-77. Districtwise particulars of trained and untrained teachers have been given in Statement No.(7).

(d) EXPENDITURE

18. The total expenditure incurred in all types of institutions in the State increased from Rs.84.55 crores in 1970-71 to Rs.182.88 crores in 1976-77 showing an average annual increase 19.4%. In 1976-77, the percentage share of expenditure was the highest in case of Madras 15.2% followed by Madurai 10.0% and the lowest was in the case of Nilgiris 1.4%.

19. The expenditure on education per head of institution was 23,905 in 1970-71 which increased to 49,834 in 1976-77. Among the districts, the educational expenditure per head of the institution varied from Rs.2,96,511 in Madras to the lowest Rs.25,306 in Pudukothai.

20. The educational expenditure per head of population was Rs.20.0 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.40.5 in 1976-77. The per-capita expenditure among the districts varied from Rs.102.8 in case of Madras to Rs.25.7 in Dharmapuri in 1976-77. The per capita expenditure increased in all the districts in 1976-77 as compared to that of 1970-71. Districtwise educational expenditure, expenditure per institution and per capita expenditure can be seen from Statement No.(6).

(c) EXTENT OF COVERAGE OF SCHEDULED CASTES & SCHEDULED TRIBES

21. The total enrolment of scheduled caste students in the State was 14,14,354 (8,49,310 boys and 5,65,044 girls) forming 16.8% of the enrolment at State level. The enrolment percentage for scheduled caste boys was 17.2% and for girls 16.2%. Among the districts the enrolment percentage for scheduled castes varied from the highest of 26.4% in Chengalpattu to 10.0% in Kanya Kumari.

22. Percentage of scheduled castes population to total population in the State was 19.8% in 1970-71. The extent of coverage of scheduled castes population was estimated to be 0.9 in all types of educational institutions at State level in 1976-77. Among the districts the extent of coverage varied from 2.6 in Kanya Kumari to 0.6 in Chengalpattu. Districtwise particulars of scheduled castes enrolment percentages and extent of coverage are given in Statement No.(8).

23. The total enrolment of scheduled tribes community in the State was 30,577 (17,950 boys and 12,627 girls) in 1976-77. Percentage of scheduled tribes enrolment to total enrolment was 0.4 at State level. Among the districts it varied from 2.8 in Nilgiris to the lowest i.e. 0.0 in Madurai, Ramanathpuram, Tirunelveli of Kanya Kumari. Districtwise details are given in Statement No.(9).

V - PRE-PRIMARY EDUCATION

24. The number of pre-primary schools in the State decreased from 40 in 1970-71 to 33 in 1976-77. There was no pre-primary school in Pudukkottai, Dharmapuri and North Arcot in 1970-71 and 1976-77. Total enrolment in pre-primary school increased from 4,170 in 1970-71 to 5,443 in 1976-77. The enrolment in pre-primary schools including Nursery classes was 5,197 in 1970-71 which increased to 13,110 in 1976-77. Districtwise details may be seen in Statement No.(10).

VI - PRIMARY EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS

25. Total number of primary schools increased from 26,076 in 1970-71 to 27,306 in 1976-77 showing an increase of 4.7% during the period under review.

26. The average area served by a primary school was 4.8 sq. kms. of State level in 1976-77 as compared to 5.0 sq. kms. in 1970-71.

27. Population served by a primary school was 1,580 in 1970-71 whereas in 1976-77 on an average a primary school served 1,655 persons.

(b) TEACHERS

28. Number of teachers in primary schools increased from 1,01,740 in 1970-71 to 1,01,033 (69,983 males and 41,050 females) in 1976-77 showing an annual increase of 1.5% during the period under review. In 1976-77, teachers employed in different districts varied from the highest of 11,930 in Coimbatore to 1,507 in Nilgiris. Districtwise details are given in Statement No.(11).

(c) ENROLMENT

29. Enrolment in classes I-V was 50.59 lakhs (28.83 lakh boys and 21.76 lakh girls) in 1970-71 which is reported to have increased to 57.52 lakhs comprising 32.02 lakh boys and 25.50 lakh girls by 1976-77 at the State level. This shows an annual increase of 2.3% during the period. The average annual increase for boys comes out to be 1.9% and for girls 2.9%.

30. The enrolment ratio in classes I-V to the population of age-group 6-11 gives an index of facilities created at the primary stage of education. For the State as a whole this ratio increased from 96.2 to 100.7 during the period 1970-71 to 1976-77. The corresponding enrolment ratio for boys decreased from 109.8 to 100.8 and for girls from it increased 82.7 to 91.9 during the period under consideration. Taking both boys and girls together these enrolment ratios among the districts varied from the highest of 121.8 in Kanya Kumari to 80.6 in Trichirapalli in 1976-77. In 6 districts the enrolment ratios were more than that of the State level. Districtwise details of enrolment are given in Statement No.(12). Enrolment figures in 1976-77 as percentage of 1970-71 for the districts are given in Table (2) on the next page.

(a) SCHEDULED CASTES & SCHEDULED TRIBES ENROLMENT

31. Of the total enrolment, 9.16 lakhs (5.48 lakhs boys and 3.68 lakh girls) belonging to scheduled caste & scheduled tribe communities in 1970-71 in classes I-V. Scheduled caste and scheduled tribe girls formed 18.1% of total girl students in classes I-V. In 1976-77 scheduled castes enrolment formed 18.1% (18.5% boys and 17.6% girls). Taking boys and girls together the enrolment percentage for scheduled castes varied among districts from 29.3 in Chengalpattu to 9.9 in Kanya Kumari. In classes I-V scheduled tribes formed 0.4% (0.4% boys and 0.4% girls). Among the districts it varied from 3.2 in Nilgiris to 0.6 in Madurai, Ramanathpuram, Tirunelveli and Kanya Kumari. The percentage of scheduled castes & scheduled tribes population was 16.18% and 0.4% respectively in 1976-77. Extent of coverage of scheduled castes & scheduled tribe students separately is estimated to be 101.9% and 62.6% respectively in 1976-77. Districtwise details of enrolment of scheduled castes & scheduled tribes in primary classes are given in Statement No.(13).

The coefficient of equality or extent of coverage is defined as:-

(e) EXPENDITURE

32. The expenditure on all primary schools of the State increased from Rs.25.10 crores in 1970-71 to Rs.46.94 crores in 1976-77 showing an average annual increase of 47.8% during the period under review. The expenditure is reported to have increased in all the districts. Expenditure incurred on primary schools as percentage to total educational expenditure was 29.7% in 1970-71 which slightly decreased to 25.7% in 1976-77 for the State as a whole. In 1976-77, among the districts the highest percentage was in case of Dharmapuri 51.4% and the lowest in Madras 3.0%.

33. The average expenditure for a primary school was 9.63 thousand in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.17.19 thousand in 1976-77 at State level.

34. The expenditure on primary schools as per head of population in the State is worked out to be Rs.6.1 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.10.4 in 1976-77. Among the districts it varied from Rs.16.8 in Nilgiris to Rs.3.1 in Madras in 1976-77.

35. The average cost per student in primary schools was Rs.72.5 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.117.7 in 1976-77. The cost per student varied among the districts from Rs.172.9 in Nilgiris to 57.4 in Madras.

36. In 1970-71 one teacher was available for every 34 students in primary schools whereas it increased to 36 students. Statement No.(14) gives districtwise details of expenditure on primary schools, expenditure per head of population, cost per student and teacher pupil ratio in primary schools. Table (3) below gives expenditure per head of population, percentage share of expenditure on primary schools, cost per student and teacher pupil ratio in primary schools.

VII - MIDDLE SCHOOL EXAMINATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS

37. Total number of middle schools in the State was 5,894 in 1970-71 which decreased to 5,730 in 1976-77. Among the districts the number of middle schools was the highest (657) in Tirunelveli followed by 596 in Madurai and the lowest in Nilgiris (70) in 1976-77. The average area served by a middle school was 22.1 sq. kms. in 1970-71 for the State as a whole whereas in 1976-77 a middle school was available for an area 22.7 sq.km. in the State.

38. During 1970-71, on an average a middle school was available for every population of 6,990. The situation improved in 1976-77 as a middle school was available for a population of 7389 persons. Among the districts it varied from 14,529 in Salem to the lowest in Tirunelveli i.e. 5265.

39. The total number of teachers employed in middle schools was 64,882 in 1970-71 which increased to 67,846 in 1976-77 at the average annual increase of 0.8% during the period under review. District-wise details of institutions and teachers are given in Statement No.(15).

(b) ENROLMENT

40. Total enrolment in middle schools was 20.79 lakhs in 1970-71 which increased to 23.25 lakhs by the year 1976-77 at State level. At the same time enrolment in middle classes for the State as a whole was 12.45 lakhs (8.05 lakhs boys and 4.40 lakhs girls) in 1970-71 and by the year 1976-77 the enrolment in these classes had gone up to 15.49 lakhs (9.74 lakhs boys and 5.74 lakhs girls) showing an average annual increase of 4.1% during the period. Among the districts the highest enrolment was 150.8 thousands in Madurai followed by 148.6 thousands in Coimbatore and the lowest in case of Nilgiris (25.4 thousands).

41. The enrolment ratio at the middle stage which is defined as the percentage of enrolment classes VI-VIII to the total population in age-group of 11-14 years gives an index of facilities rendered at the middle stage education. For the State as a whole the enrolment ratio was 45.7% (50.6% for boys and 32.6% for girls) in 1970-71. In 1976-77, the enrolment ratio increased to 47.4 (58.9% for boys and 38.8% for girls). Among the districts the enrolment ratio was the highest in case of Madurai (71.5%) followed by Kanya Kumari 68.1%

and the lowest in Dharamapuri 29.4% in 1976-77. District-wise details of enrolment in middle education classes are given in Statement No.(15). Table (4) below gives district-wise position of enrolment in 1976-77 as percentage of enrolment in 1970-71.

(c) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES & SCHEDULED TRIBES

42. In 1970-71 total enrolment of Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes students in classes VI-VIII was 173948 (119293 boys & 54655 girls) constituting 14.0% of the total enrolment in these classes at State level. In 1976-77 the enrolment of Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribe students increased to 228144 (152365 boys & 75779 girls) forming 14.7% of the total enrolment. Boys & girls separately formed 15.6% and 13.2% respectively of the total enrolment. Scheduled Tribe students formed 0.2% (0.2% boys and 0.3% girls).

43. The extent of coverage of Scheduled Caste & Scheduled Tribe students in classes VI-VIII is worked out to be 75.6% in 1970-71.

44. The extent of coverage works out to be 82.8% for Scheduled Castes and 26.3% for Scheduled Tribe students in 1976-77. District-wise details of enrolment for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes are given in Statement No.17.

(d) EXPENDITURE

45. Total expenditure on middle schools for the State as a whole was Rs.15.47 crores in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.31.64 crores after six years in 1976-77 showing an average annual increase of 17.4% in expenditure during the period under consideration. The total expenditure incurred on these schools doubled in case of 10 districts and tripled in 1 districts during the period. Among the districts expenditure incurred on middle schools varied from the highest of Rs.3.98 crores in Madurai followed by Rs.3.80 crores in Madras to the lowest 0.54 crores in Pudukkottai.

46. Expenditure incurred on middle schools as per head of population was Rs.3.8 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.7.0 in 1976-77 at state level. In 1976-77 among the districts the expenditure per head of population varied from Rs.14.0 the highest in Madras to Rs.3.7 the lowest in Salem.

47. Total expenditure made on middle schools for the State as a whole formed 18.3% of the total educational expenditure in 1970-71. This percentage decreased to 17.3% by 1976-77. The percentage expenditure for middle schools varied from the highest of 24.1% in Tirunelveli to the lowest of 12.0% in Salem in 1976-77.

48. Cost per student in middle schools was Rs.174.4 in 1970-71 for the State as a whole which increased to Rs.136.1 in 1976-77. Among the districts it varied from the highest of Rs.214.3 in Madurai followed by Rs.161.1 in South Arcot to the lowest of Rs.113.8 in Thanjavur in 1976-77. In 8 districts cost per student in middle schools works out to more than the State average.

49. For the State as a whole the teacher-pupil ratio in middle schools was 32 in 1970-71 which increased to 34 in 1976-77 showing a significant improvement. Among the districts in 1976-77, it varied from 38 in Madras followed by 37 in South Arcot to the lowest of 28 in Kanya Kumari. Statement No. (18) indicates the district-wise x details of expenditure on middle schools, expenditure per head of population, cost per student and teacher pupil ratio. Table (5) below indicates percentage of educational expenditure to the total expenditure, expenditure per head of population, cost per student and teacher pupil ratio for the districts separately.

VIII - HIGH/HIGHER SECONDARY SCHOOL

50. There were 2,634 high/higher secondary schools in the State in 1970-71 which increased to 3,020 in 1976-77 showing an average increase of 2.44% during the period under consideration. In 1976-77, the highest number of such institutions was in Coimbatore 296 followed by North Arcot 282.

51. In 1970-71 the avdraye are served by a high/higher secondary school was 49.4 sq.kms. Conditions improved by 1976-77 as for every 43.1 sq. kms. one such institution was available. In 1970-77 the average area served by a high/higher secondary school varied from 0.6 sq.kms. in Madras to the lowest of 84.6 sq.kms. in Dharmapuri.

52. Average population served by a high/higher secondary school in the State was 15,641 in 1970-71. In 1976-77 slightly increased educational facilities were available for every population of 14,469 one such institution was available. In the year 1976-77 average population served by a high/higher secondary school varied from 7747 in Nilgiris to 17,413 in Thanjavur district.

53. Total number of teechers employed in high/higher secondary schools in the State was 61,040 in 1970-71 which increased to 76,438 in 1976-77 showing an average annual increase of 3.9% during the period. Statement No.(19) shows district-wise number of high/higher secondary schools, teachers employed, area and population served by high/higher secondary schools.

(b) ENROLMENT

54. Enrolment in high/higher secondary schools was 17.99 lakhs in 1976-77 against 14.37 lakhs in 1970-71. Enrolment in classes IX-XI in the State increased from 6.75 lakhs (4.58 lakhs boys and 2.17 lakh girls) in 1970-71 to 8.02 lakhs (5.34 lakh boys and 2.68 lakhs girls) in 1976-77 at an average annual increase f of 3.1% during the period. Corresponding annual increase among the boys was 2.8% and for girls was 3.9%. It may be seen that enrolment in these classes increased in all the districts. In 1976-77 enrolment varied from 89,188 the highest in Madras followed by 78,044 in Coimbatore to 11,731 the lowest in Pudukottai.

55. At the State level enrolment ratio at the high/higher secondary classes (i.e. enrolment in classes IX-XI as percentage to the population of corresponding period in the age-group 14-17 years) decreased from 27.1% to 26.8% during the period of six years. In case of boys it decreased from 36.8% to 35.3% and for girls it increased from 17.4% to 18.1% during the period under considderation. The enrolment ratio increased in 4 districts during the period under review.

In 1976-77 the ratio varied from 15.2% in Dharmapuri to 49.7 in Madras. In District-wise details of enrolment are given in Statement No. (20). Table (6) below gives enrolment in 1976-77 as percentage to that of 1970-71 and percentage of girls enrolment.

(c) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES & SCHEDULED TRIBES

56. In 1970-71, of the total students 10.3% were of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe community. In 1976-77, 14.7% enrolment was of Scheduled Castes and 0.3% was of Scheduled Tribes community in classes IX-XI at State level. Scheduled Caste boys accounted for 15.7% of the total boys enrolment whereas Scheduled Caste girls accounted for 12.8% of the total girls enrolment in the State in classes IX-XI during 1976-77. Among the Scheduled Tribes the percentage enrolment was 0.3% and 0.4% respectively when compared to the total boys and girls enrolment. Among the districts the percentage of Scheduled Castes enrolment varied from 25.3% in North Arcot followed by Chengal pattu 20.1% to the lowest in Coimbatore 8.5% during 1976-77.

57. In 1970-71 the population of Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes taken together was 10.3% and the extent of coverage or co-efficient of equality was estimated to be 55.7% in classes IX-XI. In 1976-77 the extent of coverage works out to be 82.8% for Scheduled Castes and 39.5% for Scheduled Tribes separately in high/higher secondary classes. District-wise details of Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes enrolment are given in Statement No.(21).

(d) EXPENDITURE

58. Total expenditure on high/higher secondary schools in the State was Rs.22.71 crores in 1970-71 which rose to Rs.56.80 crores in 1976-77. Average annual increase of expenditure works out to be 25.0% during the period of six years. Among the districts the expenditure incurred on high/higher secondary schools varied from Rs.8.81 crores the highest in Tirunelveli to the lowest in Pudukkottai 91.25 lakhs in 1976-77.

59. Expenditure on high/higher secondary schools as per head of population was Rs.5.5 in 1970-71 which rose to Rs.12.6 in 1976-77 for the State as a whole. In 1976-77 among the districts it varied from Rs.25.7 the highest in Madras to Rs.7.2 the lowest in Dharmapuri. In 4 districts the expenditure on high/higher secondary schools was more than the State average.

60. Per capita expenditure in high/higher secondary schools was Rs.158.0 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.315.8 in 1976-77. In 1976-77 among the districts cost per student varied from 770.6 in Tirunelveli followed by Rs.349.0 in Pudukkottai to the lowest of Rs.243.7 in Kanya Kumari. In 3 districts per capita expenditure in these schools was more than the State average. Teacher pupil ratio was 23 in 1970-71 for the State as a whole which increased to 24 in 1976-77. In 1976-77 teacher pupil ratio was the highest in Madras 34 the lowest in Pudukkottai 7.

Statement No. 22 gives district-wise details of expenditure on high/higher secondary schools. Table (7) below gives district-wise particulars of expenditure on high/higher secondary schools as percentage of total expenditure, expenditure per head of population, cost per student and teacher pupil ratio.

IX - PROFESSIONAL, VOCATIONAL, SPECIAL & OTHER (SCHOOL) EDUCATION

61. Total number of institutions of professional, vocational, special and other (School) education was 229 which decreased to 206 in 1976-77. In 1976-77 three districts had only a few institutions of this type. Total enrolment of these institutions was 26,054 (21,922 male & 4132 females) in 1970-71 which increased to 31229 (26152 male & 5077 females in 1976-77 showing an average annual increase of 3.37% during the period under review.

62. Out of the total enrolment in 1970-71, the enrolment of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes was 4651 (4234 boys & 417 girls). In 1976-77 there were 5923 Scheduled Castes and 232 Scheduled Tribes students.

63. Total number of teachers employed in these institutions decreased from 2250 in 1970 to 2198 in 1976-77.

64. The expenditure incurred on all type of institutions of Professional, Vocational, Special & Other (School) Education was 3.09 crores in 1970-71 which increased to 3.24 crores in 1976-77. Statement No. (23) gives districtwise particulars of the number of institutions, enrolment, teachers and expenditure for institutions of professional, vocational, special and other(school) education.

HIGHER EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS

65. Total number of all types of institutions of higher education was 498 in 1970-71 which increased to 658 in 1976-77 showing an average annual increase of 5.4%. Out of the total number of higher institutions in the State there were 8 universities, 2 agricultural college, 24 institutions of education, 13 engineering, technological and architectural colleges, 2 law colleges and 14 medical colleges. The number of arts, science & commerce colleges was 183. All the districts in the State had at least one college.

66. Total number of teachers employed in all institutions of higher education increased from 14719 in 1970-71 to 17109 in 1976-77 showing an average increase of 1.38%. District-wise details are given in Statement No. (24).

67. Enrolment - Total enrolment in all type of higher education courses was 2,25,705 in 1970-71 which increased to 4,99,656 in 1976-77 of the total enrolment in 1976-77, 11,125 were studying in Universities, 2,03,380 in Arts, Science & Commerce colleges, 1330 agriculture and forestry colleges, 2783 in institutions of education, 9916 in Engg. Colleges, 3258 in Law colleges, 11,002 in Medicine, 3638 in other institutions. There was an annual increase of 20% in the enrolment during the period under considerations details are given in Statement No. (25).

Statement No. (26) gives district-wise details of enrolment in general higher education & professional higher education by type of education for the year 1976-77. Total enrolment in general higher education was 211531 (147706 boys & 63825 girls) and in professional higher education it was 52827 (43292 boys & 9535 girls) during the year 1976-77.

(c) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES & SCHEDULED TRIBES

67. In 1970-71 the enrolment of Scheduled Caste & Scheduled Tribe communities jointly was 14,703 (12,315 boys & 2368 girls) forming 4.3% of total enrolment in classes of higher education. In 1976-77 corresponding enrolment for Scheduled Castes was 21379 (16506 boys & 4873 girls) and for Scheduled Tribes it was 234 (158 boys & 76 girls)

Percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes was 8.1% & 0.1% respectively. District-wise details may be seen in Statement (27).

(d) EXPENDITURE

Total expenditure on all types of institutions of higher education was 19.30 ~~crores~~ in 1970-71 which increased to 99.48 crores in 1976-77 at an average annual increase of 69.2% during the period under consideration. Total expenditure on institutions of higher education in 1976-77 formed 54.4% of total expenditure on the state of the total expenditure on higher education Rs.5.99 crores was on Universities, Rs.38.24 crores on affiliated institutions and Rs.50.50 crores on boards of secondary education. Details may be seen in Table No. (28).
