#### ABSTRACTS

#### (a) SYSTEM OF SCHOOL EDUCATION (DIFFERENT STAGES)

The primary stage consists of Classes i-v, i.e. of 5 years duration in 20 States/UT's. States/UT's where the primary stage consists of classes other than I-V are Assam, Gujarat, Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra, Meghalaya, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Goa, Lakshadweep, Mizoram and Mahe & Yanam region of Pondicherry. Of these, in Gujarat the primary stage consists of classes I-VII with no middle stage; In Meghalaya, it consists of classes A,B,I,II and III; in others the primary stage consists of classes I-IV.

Middle stage consists of classes VI-VIII in as many as 20 States/UT's. The exceptions are Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Gujarat, Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra, Meghalaya. Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Goa, Daman & Diu, Lakshadweep, Mizoram and Mahe region of Pondicherry. Among the exceptions, there is no middle stage in Gujarat in Meghalaya middle stage comprises of classes IV - VI, in others it consists of classes V/VI-VII.

Secondary stage consists of Classes IX-X in 20 states/UT's viz. Bihar, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, J & K, M.P., Manipur, Nagaland, Orissa, Punjab, Rajasthan, Sikkim, Tamil Nadu, Tripura, U.P., West Bengal, A & N Islands, Arunachal Pradesh, Chandigarh, Delhi and Pondicherry. In all other States/UT's except Meghalaya. Secondary stage consists of classes VIII-X. Senior Secondary (10+2)/Intermediate stage consists of classes XI-XII in all the States/UT's. In some of the States, there is independent secondary education system while in others this is the part of College education namely Assam, Bihar, Karnataka, Manipur, Orissa, U.P., & Pondicherry.

Statewise details for different stages of school education may be seen at pages 1-5.

#### (b) AGE RESTRICTION FOR ADMISSION:

Minimum age for admission to Class I of the Primary stage is generally 5+or 6+years. In 18 States/UT's the minimum age for admission to Class I is 5+years and in 12 states it is 6+years whereas in the rest of the 2 States/UT's, there is no age restriction.

Details for all the States/UT's are given at pages 6.

#### (c) MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION:

Regional language or the mother tongue is the medium of instruction at the primary stage in most of the States/UT's. Facilities for studying in a medium other than Regional lanaguage vary considerably. State-wise details may be seen at pages 7-11.

#### (d) TEACHING OF HINDI & ENGLISH

Apart from Hindi Speaking States, teaching of Hindi is compulsory in most of the non-Hindi speaking states/UT's also. Classes in which teaching of Hindi are compulsory or optional for different States are given on pages 12-14.

Teaching of English is compulsory in all the States/UT's although the class from which teaching of English is compulsory differs from State to State. However, in general it is compulsory in classes VI to X in most states/UTs. State-wise details may be seen at pages 15-16.

#### (e) PUBLIC EXAMINATIONS:

In all the States/UTs public examination are conducted at the end of class X and class XII by State Boards of Secondary/Higher Secondary Education. The minimum age for secondary examination varies from 14+ to 16+ years.

It has been reported to be 14+ years from Andhra Pradesh, Kerala, Uttar Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Lakshdweep and Mahe, Yanam and Karaikal region of Pondicherry and 16+ years from Assam, Jammu & Kashmir, West Bengal and Nagaland. There are no age restrictions for appearing in the Boards Examination in Bihar, Gujarat, Punjab, Rajasthan, Sikkim, Tripura, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Goa, Arunachal Pradesh, Daman & Diu and Mizoram. In some of the States. the first public examination is also conducted at the middle stage of school education. These examinations are conducted generally by the District Boards of School Education. State-wise details may be seen at pages 17-24.

#### (f) NUMBER OF WORKING DAYS

Number of working days at different stages of school education is more than 200 in all the States/UTs except Jammu & Kashmir, Chandigarh wherein the number is less than 200. State-wise details may be seen at pages 25-26.

#### (g) ACADEMIC TERMS:

The academic year generally starts in the month of April, May or June and ends in the months of March or April or May. The exceptions are Bihar, Manipur, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Rajasthan, Sikkim and West Bengal. In most of the states, long vacation periods are in summer although in some of the hilly states they are in winter. State-wise details may be seen at pages 27-32.

#### (h) COMPULSORY EDUCATION

#### (i) FREE EDUCATION

Education is free up to the middle stage in Government and Government aided schools (Classes VI/VIII) in all the States/UTs except those of M.P., Meghalaya, Punjab, Chandigarh, Delhi and Mizoram. In several States education is free even up to Class X or higher in Government and Government aided schools viz. Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Biahr, Gujarat, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir, Karnataka, Kerala, Nagaland, Sikkim, Tamil Nadu, Tripura and West Bengal, A & N Islands, Arunachal Pradesh, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Goa, Daman & Diu, Lakshadweep and Pondicherry. Even of those States where it is not free for all boys students, it is free in case of girls in some of the states. State-wise details may be seen at pages 35-38.

#### (j) TUITION FEES CHARGED PER ANNUM:

All those States where education is not free in Classes IX and above, the annual fee varies considerably from the highest of Rs. 250/- in case of Gujarat to the lowest of Rs. 48/- in case of Assam, Madhya Pradesh, Meghalaya. In some of the States lower fees are charged from girls. State-wise details may be seen at pages 39-49.
