SELECTED INFORMATION ON SCHOOL EDUCATION IN INDIA 1992-93

INTRODUCTION

The Kothari Commission (1964-66) and the National Policy on Education adopted in 1968 had inter-alia recommended introduction of a uniform structure of education in the country. The system generally known as 10+2+3 consist of 10 years of general education at the school stage, followed by 2 years of higher secondary education and 3 years of university education to the first degree. The structure of education is as follows:-

- Primary Stage	- Grades I - V
- Middle Stage	- Grades VI - VIII
- Secondary Stage	- Grades IX & X
- Higher Secondary i.e. + 2 stage	- Grades XI & XII

2. This publication provides information on selected items of school education in India. These items are discussed briefly in the paragraphs that follow.

I STAGES OF SCHOOL EDUCATION IN INDIA

1. The Primary Stage consists of Classes I-V, i.e., of 5 years duration in 19 States/UT's. and Karaikal & Yanam regions of Pondicherry. States/UT's where the primary stage consists of classes other than I-V are: Assam, Goa, Gujarat, Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra, Mizoram, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Daman and Diu, Lakshadweep, and Mahe & Yanam regions of Pondicherry. Of these, in Gujarat the primary stage consists of classes I-VII with no middle stage; in Nagaland, it consists of classes Pre-Primary to IV; and in others the primary stage consists of classes I-IV.

2. Middle Stage consists of Classes VI-VIII in as many as 17 States/UT's. and Karaikal region of Pondicherry. The exceptions are : Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Goa, Gujarat, Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Orissa, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Daman & Diu, Lakshadweep, and Mahe & Yanam regions of Pondicherry. Among the exceptions, there is no middle stage in Gujarat, in others the stage consists of classes V/VI-VII.

3. Secondary Stage consists of Classes IX-X in 18 States/UT's., viz., Arunachal Pradesh, Bihar, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, J & K., M.P., Manipur, Nagaland, Punjab, Rajasthan, Sikkim, Tamil Nadu, Tripura, U.P., West Bengal, A. & N. Islands, Chandernagore, Jharkhand and Karaikal region of Pondicherry. However,

Hr. Secondary/Sr. Secondary Stage consists of classes XI-XII (10+2 Pattern) in all the States/UTs although in several states/UTs it forms part of University/Collegiate stage.

4. State/UT-wise details for different stages of school education have been given in Statement - I.

II AGE RESTRICTION FOR ADMISSION :-

Minimum age for admission to Class I of the Primary stage is generally 5+ or 6+ years. In 18 States/UT's, the minimum age for admission to Class I is 5+ years and in 13 States/UTs. it is 6+ years. There is no age restriction in case of Manipur.

Details for all the States/UT's are given in Statement-II.

III MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION :

Regional language or the mother tongue is the medium of instruction at the primary stage in most of the States/UT's. Facilities for study in a medium other than regional language vary considerably. State-wise details may be seen in Statement-III.

IV TEACHING OF HINDI :

Apart from Hindi speaking States, teaching of Hindi is also compulsory in most of the non-Hindi speaking States/UT's. Classes in which teaching of Hindi is compulsory or optional for different States are indicated in Statement - IV.

V TEACHING OF ENGLISH

Teaching of English is compulsory in all the States/UT's although the class from which teaching of English is compulsory differ from State to State. However, in general it is compulsory in Classes VI to X in most States/UT's. State-wise details are given in Statement - V.

VI PUBLIC EXAMINATIONS:

In all the States/UT's public examinations are conducted at the end of class X and class XII by State Boards of Secondary/Higher Secondary Education. The minimum age for Secondary School examination varies from 14+ to 16+ years.

It has been observed that while the minimum age is reported to be 14+ years in Andhra Pradesh, Kerala, Maharashtra, Punjab, Tamil Nadu, Lakshdweep and Mahe, Yanam and Karaikal regions of Pondicherry; it is 16+ years in Jammu & Kashmir and

Madhya Pradesh. There are no age restrictions for appearing in the Boards Examination in Arunachal Pradesh, Bihar, Goa, Gujarat, Mizoram, Nagaland, Rajasthan, Sikkim, Tripura, Uttar Pradesh, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Chandigarh, and Daman & Diu. In some of the States/UTs., the first public examination is also conducted at the middle stage of school education. These examinations are conducted generally by the District Boards of School Education. State-wise details are given in Statement - VI.

VII NUMBER OF WORKING DAYS :

Number of working days at different stages of school education are more than 200 in all the States/UTs. except Mizoram, and at High/Higher Secondary stages in Jammu & Kashmir where the number is less than 200. State-wise details may be seen in Statement -VII.

VIII ACADEMIC TERMS:

Normally, the academic year begins from the month of April, or May or June and ends in the month of March or April or May of the following year. The exceptions are: Bihar, Manipur, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Rajasthan, Sikkim and West Bengal. In most of the states, long vacation periods are in summer while in some of the hilly states these are in winter. State-wise position is given in Statement - VIII.

IX COMPULSORY EDUCATION

The position of compulsory education in the States/UTs is indicated below :

X FREE EDUCATION:

Education is free up to the middle stage in Government and Government aided schools (Classes VI/VIII) in all the States/UTs, except those of Meghalaya, Punjab and Delhi. In several States, education is free even up to Class X or above in Government Schools. These are : Arunachal Pradesh, Andhra

Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Goa, Gujarat, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir, Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Mizoram, Sikkim, Tamil Nadu, Tripura, Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal, A. & N. Islands, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Daman & Diu, Lakshadweep, and Pondicherry. Even in those States where it is not free for all boys students, it is free in case of girls. State-wise details are given in Statement X.

XI TUITION FEES CHARGED PER ANNUM :

All those States where education is not free in classes IX and above, the annual fee varies considerably from the highest of Rs. 250/- in case of Gujarat to the lowest of Rs. 48/- in case of Assam, Meghalaya. In some of the States lower fees are charged from girls. Details of tuition fee charged per annum have been provided in Statement XI.
