SELECTED INFORMATION ON SCHOOL EDUCATION IN INDIA -1995-96

Introduction

This publication provides information on selected items of school education for States/UTs of the country. These selected items include stages of school education, age for admission to class I, medium of instructions, public examinations, teaching of Hindi and English, number of working days in a year, academic sessions and vacation periods, fee structure, compulsory education etc. The information for this publication has been collected from State Governments and UT Administrations. Whenever an information for a year is not received from a State/UT, the latest available information is repeated. This year the information from Delhi and Gujarat (Secondary level and above) has not been received. Therefore, the previous information has been repeated.

2. Kothari Commission 1964-66 and the National Policy on Education adopted in 1968 had, inter alia, recommended introduction of uniform structure of education in the country. The National Policy on Education 1986 as modified envisages a common educational structure. The 10+2 school structure has now been accepted in all parts of the country which has further been bifurcated in majority of the States/UTs as 5+3+2+2 as under (with minor variations here and there below Matriculation):

Primary stage	-	Grades I-V
Upper Pry. stage	-	Grades VI-VIII
Secondary stage	-	Grades IX-X
Hr. Secondary stage	-	Grades XI-XII

3. The items included in this publication are discussed briefly in the following paragraphs:

I. Stages of School Education in India

(a) The primary stage consists of classes I-V i.e. of five years duration in 20 States/UTs namely; Andhra Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Bihar, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir, Madhya Pradesh, Manipur, Orissa, Punjab, Rajasthan, Sikkim, Tamil Nadu, Tripura, Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal, A&N Islands, Chandigarh, Delhi and Karaikal and Yanam region of Pondicherry. The primary stage consists of classes I-IV in Assam, Goa, Gujarat, Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Lakshadweep and Mahe region of Pondicherry. In Nagaland, the primary stage consists of Pre-Primary, A,B, I-IV classes.

(b) The middle stage of education comprises classes VI-VIII in as many as 18 States/UTs viz Arunachal Pradesh, Bihar, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir, Madhya Pradesh, Manipur, Punjab, Rajasthan, Sikkim, Tamil Nadu, Tripura, Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal, A&N Islands, Chandigarh, Delhi and Karaikal region of Pondicherry. Classes V-VII are available in 11 States/UTs namely: Assam, Goa, Gujarat, Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Dadra and Nagar Haveli, Daman and Diu, Lakshadweep and Mahe region of Pondicherry and classes VI-VII are available in Andhra Pradesh, Orissa and Yanam region of Pondicherry. Nagaland has upper primary stage of four years duration in classes V-VIII.

(c) Secondary stage consists of classes IX-X in 19 States/UTs viz Arunachal Pradesh, Bihar, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir, Madhya Pradesh, Manipur, Nagaland, Punjab, Rajasthan, Sikkim, Tamil Nadu, Tripura, Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal, A&N Islands, Chandigarh, Delhi and Karaikal region of Pondicherry. High School stage comprises classes VIII-X in 13 States/UTs viz Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Goa, Gujarat, Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Orissa, D&N Haveli, Daman & Diu, Lakshadweep and Mahe & Yanam regions of Pondicherry. However, Higher Secondary stage of school education comprising classes XI-XII (10+2 pattern) is available in all the States/UTs though in some States/UTs these classes are attached to Universities/colleges.

State/UT-wise details for different stages of school education are given in Statement 1.

II. **Age restrictions for education:**

Minimum age for admission to class I of the primary school stage is generally 5+ or 6+ years. In 20 States/UTs, the minimum age for admission to class I is 5+ years and in 10 States/UTs the minimum age for admission is 6+ years. There is no age restriction in case of Mizoram. In Gujarat State is 5+ is voluntarily and 6+ compulsorily. Details of all the States/UTs are given in Statement II.

III. **Medium of Instructions:**

Mother tongue or the Regional language is the medium of instruction at primary stage of education in most of the States/UTs. Facilities for studying in a medium other than Regional language vary considerably. Statewise details may be seen in Statement III.

IV. **Teaching of Hindi:**

Apart from Hindi speaking States, teaching of Hindi is compulsory in most of the non-Hindi speaking States/UTs, though the class from which the teaching of Hindi is compulsory differ from State to State. Teaching of Hindi is not compulsory in the States of Mizoram, Tamil Nadu, Tripura, West Bengal and Karaikal region of Pondicherry. Classes in which teaching of Hindi is compulsory or optional for different States are indicated in Statement IV.

V. **Teaching of English:**

Teaching of English is compulsory in all the States/UTs (except Karnataka) though the class from which teaching of English is compulsory differs from state to state. However, in general it is compulsory in classes VI-X in most of the States/UTs. In Karnataka, English can be opted as one of the three languages from 5th standard. Statewise details may be seen in statement V.

VI. **Public Examinations:**

In all the States/UTs public examinations are conducted at the end of X and XII classes by State Boards of Secondary and Higher Secondary education. The minimum age for secondary school examination varies from 14+ to 16+ years in Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Jammu and Kashmir, Kerala, Maharashtra, Manipur, Orissa, Punjab, Tamil Nadu, A&N Islands and Pondicherry. Other States/UTs either do not have age restrictions or the age restrictions has not been indicated by such States. The minimum age for Higher Secondary school examination varies from 16+ to 18+ years in Bihar, J&K, Maharashtra,

Punjab, Tamil Nadu, A&N Islands and Pondicherry. In other States/UTs, either there is no age restriction prescribed or if it is there, it has not been indicated. In some of the States/UTs, the first public examination is also conducted at the middle stage of school education. Statewise details are given in Statement VI.

VII. Number of working days

The number of the working days of school education are generally more than 200 days in all the States/UTs. Statewise detail may be seen in Statement VII.

VIII. Academic terms

Normally the academic year begins from the month of April or May or June and ends in the month of March or April or May of the following year. In most of the States long vacation period are in summer while in some of the hilly States these are in winters. Statewise position is given in Statement VIII.

IX. Compulsory education

Compulsory education has been enforced in five States and Union Territories at the primary stage of education while in eight States/UTs there is a compulsory education covering the entire elementary stage of education. As many as 18 States/UTs have not introduced any compulsion upto the year 1995-96. The State/UT-wise details are given in Statement IX.

X. Free education

Education is free up to the Higher Secondary stage in Government schools in Arunachal Pradesh, Goa, J&K, Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Sikkim, Tripura, Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal, A&N Islands, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Lakshadweep and Pondicherry. Education is free up to High School classes (I-X) in Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Himachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Orissa, Tamil Nadu and Daman & Diu. In several States/UTs, education is free up to classes VIII i.e. Haryana, Manipur, Punjab, Rajasthan, Chandigarh and Delhi and in two States education is free upto VII class namely Gujarat and Maharashtra. In addition, education for girls is free upto XII class in Assam, Bihar, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Maharashtra, Orissa, Rajasthan, Chandigarh, Daman and Diu. Statewise details are given in Statement X.

XI. Tuition fees charged per child per annum in Government Schools

All those States/UTs where education is not free in classes IX and above, the annual fee varies considerably from the highest of Rs. 240/- for class XI and Rs. 360/- for class XII in case of Daman & Diu, to the lowest of Rs. 48/- in case of Assam. Details of tuition fees charged per annum have been provided in Statement XI.
