INTRODUCTORY.

In consequence of the separation of Burma from India with effect from 1st April 1937, the trade of Bombay with Burma has been included in the foreign trade tables and excluded from the coasting trade tables.

A separate table showing the figures of trade between Bombay and Burma in the more important commodities during each of the five years 1935-36 to 1939-40 has been inserted as an Appendix B.
