## AUTHOR'S NOTE

The mere announcement of a scheme of arbitration courts of a very modest and thoroughly constitutional description led an Anti-Indian print of Allahabad to employ adjectives such as "Sinister," and "Subversive" and phrases such as "in the true spirit of Bolshevism, and decrees of the mob."
