PREFACE.

These two volumes represent the second series of the sixth edition of the statutory Rules and Orders applying exclusively to the State of Bombay. This second series contains the statutory Rules and Orders under Central and other enactments. Volume I contains Rules and Orders under Central Acts up to 1925 and under other enactments; Volume II contains Rules and Orders under Central Acts from 1926 to 1952. By other enactments are meant Acts of Parliament of the United Kingdom which have been still kept in force. The Rules and Orders under such other enactments have been printed in the beginning of the first volume, and the Rules and Orders under Central Acts are printed thereafter. This arrangement follows the system adopted in the last edition.

- 2. This second series is not divided into two parts like the first series of statutory Rules and Orders under the Bombay enactments. Instead of including in the second part only lists of Rules and Orders, in this series are embodied in extenso all the Rules and Orders issued under the Central Acts and other enactments, excluding generally such Rules and Orders as are of a temporary nature or of restricted application or of a purely local significance or of little general importance. Rules made by this Government under Central Acts whereunder powers have been subsequently vested in the Central Government, as for example, the Bombay Port Haj Committee Rules, 1933, have been excluded from this series.
- 3. The two volumes of this second series are also issued in the loose-leaf style already adopted in the Bombay Code and in the first series, namely, the Bombay Rules and Orders under Bombay enactments. The paging of both the volumes is continuous, and sufficient provision is made in the binders for including therein replacement pages and Rules and Orders which may be made under Acts to be enacted hereafter, and which will be issued as additional pages in continuation. Replacement pages will also be issued from time to time embodying changes which may be made in the Rules and Orders included in these two volumes.

- The enactments under which these Rules and Orders are arranged follow the same Order as the Volumes of the unrepealed Central Acts. Rules and Orders are grouped in chronological order under the respective section of the enactment to which they are referable. At the head is printed in bold type the reference to the principal notifications under which the Rules or Orders are issued, and then follows a list in chronological order of all amending notifications. The text of the Rules or Orders which follows thereafter embodies all the amendments made by such notifications. This scheme has been followed except in cases where it was not possible to incorporate an amendment in the principal notification; in such cases the amending notification is itself printed in full at its chronological place under the respective section. Rules and Orders which are not made by the Government of Bombay but which have been included in these volumes are printed as appendices under the relevant enactments.
- 5. The text is printed as modified up to the end of December 1952, and adaptations have also been carried out to bring it in accord with the Constitution of India. These adaptations were carried out by notifications recently issued and the notifications have been printed as an Appendix to Volume II with a view to avoiding repeated references to them at the several material places in the text.
- 6. The text as printed represents the view of its final form taken by the Legal Department as at present advised. Communications regarding suggestions in this behalf may be addressed to the Secretary to the Government of Bombay, Legal Department.
