**SUPPLEMENT TO THE "A" VOLUME OF THE
TANJORE DISTRICT GAZETTEER.**

Chapter I, Physical description.—The Tanjore district is now made up of eleven taluks, the new taluks of Papanasam and Arantangi having been formed on 15th November 1910.

Chapter II, Political History, page 52.—None of the queens of the late Raja of Tanjore (Sivaji) is now alive.

Chapter VII, Means of Communication—Railways, page 142.—A railway line from Nidamangalam to Mannargudi (9 miles in length) has been constructed at a cost of about Rs. 5,56,000 excluding the cost of land acquired for the purpose. It was opened on 15th February 1915.

2. Lands have been acquired for the extension of the railway line from Tirutturaippundi to Vedaranniyam, a distance of nearly 30 miles.

Chapter IX, Public Health—Medical Institutions, page 158.—The Alexandra Maternity Hospital was newly opened in 1911 as an annexe to the Raja Mirasidar Hospital.

Chapter X, Education, page 164.—The St. Peter's College at Tanjore has been converted into a High School in the year 1908. The Sanskrit High School at Tiruvadi has now been made a College and higher education is imparted to students to enable them to compete for Siromani, Vidhwan, etc. titles. English education is also imparted.

Chapter XI, Land Revenue Administration, page 194.—Of the two new taluks, the taluk of Papanasam is in charge of the Civilian Divisional Officer, Kumbakonam, and Arantangi in charge of the Deputy Collector, Pattukkottai division.

Chapter XIII, Administration of Justice, page 204.—Five village bench courts were opened in the year 1906, in Tanjore, Kumbakonam, Mayavaram, Negapatam and Mannargudi.

2. Third class special magistrates for the trial of nuisance cases have been newly appointed in Milattur, Tirukkattupalli, Kuttalam, Ammapatnam, Adirampatnam and Orattanad wherein the Towns Nuisance Act has been introduced. The special magistrates at Papanasam and Valangiman have been replaced by a Stationary Sub-Magistrate and a Deputy Tahsildar respectively. Two bench courts with third class powers to try offences under the Towns Nuisance Act and certain petty offences under the Indian Penal Code have been newly opened in Vallam and Pattukkottai. The Deputy Tahsildar's office at Arantangi was abolished when the taluk was newly formed in 1910 and a

Sheristadar-Magistrate takes the place of the taluk head accountant. The Deputy Tahsildar's office at Vallam was abolished and a new one at Valangiman was created at the same time.

3. The Additional Head Quarters Deputy Collector who was Personal Assistant to the Collector has now been replaced by a Head Quarters Sub-Collector and Joint Magistrate who has been given the powers of Additional District Magistrate.

4. The sub-jail at Vallam was abolished and two sub-jails—one at Papanasam and the other at Valangiman—have been opened in 1910.

Chapter XIV, Local Self Government, page 210.—The Tiruvalur Union was converted into a Municipality with effect from 1st October 1913. Four more unions have been formed, one in Kuttalam under the Mayavaram taluk board, one in Tirukkattuppalli under the Tanjore taluk board, one in Ammapet under the Kumbakonam Taluk Board and the last in Kuthanallur under the Maunargudi taluk board.

The right of electing the Chairman and Vice-Chairman has again been conferred on the Municipal Council, Tanjore, in the year 1913. The post of Secretary has now been abolished.

The Negapatam Municipality has now effected a permanent improvement in the water supply of the town by pumping water by means of engines from a filter bed in the river Vettar in Odacheri limits, constructed at a cost of Rs. 77,500.

Chapter XV, Gazetteer of Papanasam taluk.—The taluk of Papanasam was newly formed in 1910, by taking some of the villages from Kumbakonam and some from the Tanjore taluk. It lies south-west of Kumbakonam taluk which it resembles and possesses large landowners. The chief agricultural products are plantains and betel leaves which are largely exported. The chief industry is weaving which is carried on in Ayyampet. This taluk is like Kumbakonam, a great Brahminical centre. Papanasam is traversed by the South Indian Railway main line. Metalled roads are the exception in this taluk, the only one being that connecting Papanasam with Saliamangalam. Alangudi, Amaravati, Rajagiri, and Valangiman of Kumbakonam taluk and Ayyampet of Tanjore taluk are now included in this taluk.

Arantangi taluk.—This was also newly constituted in 1910. It forms nearly a half of the old Pattukkottai taluk. It is the southernmost part of the district. It bears the characteristics of Pattukkottai taluk. Arantangi is the terminus of the District Board Railway in the south. There is hardly any industry worth the name in this taluk. It contains numerous tanks irrigating small ayaouts. Avadayarkoyil, a village eight miles south-west of Arantangi, is an important place in this taluk. It contains an ancient and famous shrine.

Tanjore taluk.—A new electric printing press and a steam power press have been opened in Tanjore. A big chattram under the name of “The Tanjore Raja’s Chattram” has recently been opened by the Chattram Department for the accommodation of Indian travellers.

A big water reservoir has been newly constructed to aid the supply of water to the south and south-east portions of the Municipality at a cost of Rs. 78,500.
