## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Of the 167½ miles from Harnāi to Fort Sandeman the first 113½ miles to Murgha Kibzai are partially metalled and bridged. Beyond that the road is unmetalled but fit for wheeled traffic though rough. Harnāi and Tōrkhān lie in the Shāhriq tahsil of the Sibi district; Rēzgai, Smālan and Sanjāwi in the Sanjāwi tahsil of the Lōralai district; Lōralai Lāhōr, Mara Tangi and Zara in the Bōri tahsil of the Lōralai district; and Murgha, Zarōzai, Lakaband, Bābar and Kapip in the Fort Sandeman tahsil of the Zhōb district.

Water-supply is good and sufficient at all places. There are bāzārs at Harnāi, Smālan and Lōralai and shops at other places except Rēzgai, and Kapip. Ordinary native provisions are obtainable at the shops, and fowls and eggs and milk at places where there are dāk bungalows. Previous notice should be given for supplies in larger quantities and for places where there are no shops to the tahsildārs concerned. Contracts for camel carriage exist between Harnāi, Duki, Lōralai and Fort Sandeman and there is a contract for

## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The total distance from Pishin to Rakhni is 226½ m., and thence to Dera Ghazi Khan by Fort Munro 9 m., Girdo 8 m., Rākhi Gorge 6 m., Rākhi Mūnh 6 m., Sakhi Sarwar 11 m., Tōni 8 m., Gadāi 10 m., and Dera Ghazi Khan 11 m. The road is partially metalled, drained and bridged.

The water-supply at all places is good and abundant from streams, springs or kārēzes ; limited well water at Mēkhtar rest house, drinkable but bad. Well water at Raṭkan, and good and plentiful well water at Rakhni.

Pishin, Khānōzai and Malazai are in the Pishin tahsil of the Quetta—Pishin district; Spēra Ragha in the Shāhriq tahsil of the Sibi district; Chinjan to Sra Dhāka in the Bōri tahsil, Kingri in the Mūsakhel tahsil, and Raṭkan and Rakhni in the Bārkhān tahsil of the Lōrālai district. ## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Road, partly metalled and bridged, but impassable in winter owing to snow especially near Ziārat. The highest pass (8,600') on any cart road in Balūchistān crossed at Ziārat Tsari (c. 4 m. from Ziārat). Between-Kowās and Smālan it was traversed on their way to Persia in 1614 by Richard Steel and John Crowther, English merchants, who mention Dureus or gates of mountains (apparently Dhre Tangi), Coasta or Kowās and Abdūn or Hamadūn. Ruins of three villages known collectively as Seh Kōta and separately as Kāravān, Rāni and Dōm Killas are seen in Wani valley, 4 miles from Chautēr. Gandak and Sarāntangi lie in Quetta tahsil; Kach, Kahān and Ziārat in Shāhriḡ (Sibi district); Chautēr and Smālan in Sanjāwi (Lōralai district). Khansamas are stationed at Kach, Kahān and Ziārat from May to September. Water good and abundant at all places, but at Kach laxative, and Gandak, scanty. Atā, grain, fuel and native provisions are procurable from shops at Kahān, Ziārat and Chautēr (May to September), Smālan (½ dozen permanent shops) and Kach (1 permanent shop), fodder, eggs, fowls and milk obtainable at Ziārat (May to September); for other places previous notice to tahsildars concerned. During season conveyance run between Kach railway station and Ziārat; baggage camels can be reserved on application to thānedār, Ziārat.

## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The total distance is 134 miles, of which 21 miles are partially bridged and metalled; beyond Duki it is a bridle-path fit for pack animals only.

The water-supply is good and abundant at all places except Zaran and Kohlū where it is brackish. Good water can be obtained at Kohlū from a spring about 1½ miles from the tahsil. Ordinary native provisions can be had at Sanjāwi, Duki, Kohlū and Bārkhān, but previous notice should be given for larger supplies at these and other stages. Sanjāwi and Baghāo lie in the Sanjāwi tahsil, Duki, Mānki and Gumbaz in the Duki tahsil; Zaran and Kohlū in the Kohlū tahsil, and Bārkhān, Ishāni and Rakhni in the Bārkhān tahsil of the Lōralai district.

## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The total distance of this bridle-path is 95 miles; Kapip lies in the Fort Sandeman tahsil of the Zhōb district and the stages beyond in the Mūsakhēl tahsil of the Lōrālai district. Water good and plentiful at all places. Previous notice should be given for supplies to the tahsil'ars through the P. A. concerned.

## XXIV.—TRAVELLERS' BUNGALOWS :

There are three kinds of travellers' bungalows in the district— (i) dak bungalows, (ii) rest-houses and (iii) Political, Civil and Military Works Inspection bungalows.

Officials drawing Rs. 100 per mensem and over, N. C. O's and private gentlemen are entitled to accommodation in a dak bungalow on payment of one rupee a head for every 24 hours, with half and one-fourth fees for short stays not exceeding 6 and 2 hours respectively; in a rest-house the charge is eight annas with half fees for less than 5 hours. Officials in superior service drawing less than Rs. 100 per mensem and European soldiers are entitled to shelter in a special room set apart in the compound on payment of one anna a head for every 24 hours, with reduced fees for lesser periods as above. Servants are housed in out-houses; sepoy, police, etc., in the adjoining shelters or *burdāshthānas* free of charge. One anna and six pies a day are charged for every horse tethered in the compound of a dak bungalow and rest-house respectively. Eight annas a day is charged for each tent pitched in the compound by a person not using the dak bungalow; four annas is charged for each wheeled vehicle, palanquin or tent, and one anna for each horse, package, box, etc., remaining more than 24 hours in the compound before or after the arrival of the owner. In dak bungalows the khansama supplies food at the prescribed rates (soldiers at half rates) and also cooks provisions furnished by travellers on payment of eight annas a day per head. In rest-houses travellers must make their own arrangements for supplies and cooking, but where possible, the man in charge provides wood, etc., on payment. None but Government officers, travelling on duty, can stay in a dak bungalow for more than 48 hours, if other officers require accommodation, unless specially permitted by the officer in charge.

These bungalows are specially reserved for departmental officers on tour. The gazetted officers of the department owning the bungalow have prior claims to accommodation in order

of seniority ; subject to this rule the officer in charge of a bungalow may lend it, without payment, to any gazetted officer of any other department travelling on duty, and may also permit others to occupy it, when available, for a period not exceeding seven days.
