## Foreword

The conversion, two years ago, of the catalog of scores in the Library of Congress from an alphabetical "subject" catalog to a classed catalog made necessary a systematic expansion of the M schedule to provide access to the material formerly afforded by subject headings. The primary purpose of this publication is to meet that need.

The classed catalog is at present composed of four files:

1. The composer-editor file.
2. The title file.
3. The classified file or classed catalog proper.
4. The alphabetical subject index file.

It is only with the last two that this publication is concerned.

The newly added class numbers are enclosed in parentheses ("curves") to indicate that they are not to be used in classifying material for location on the shelves, but for added entries in the classed catalog. Both open and blocked numbers are used for added entries determined by medium, form, subject matters, national aspect, the various combinations of voices or instruments or both.

For example: a song relating to the War of 1812 and published before 1820, classed in M1634 (a single song from the War of 1812), would be given an added entry in M1.A1 (printed or manuscript music in the U. S. before 1820); a piano potpourri of Negro songs would be classed in M39 (potpourris, medleys, fantasies, etc., on a given theme for piano), with added entry in M1670 (Negro spirituals, accompanied or unaccompanied); an excerpt from a musical comedy with original

scoring is classed in M1505 (excerpts from operas, etc., with original orchestral accompaniment), with added entry in (M1505.8--excerpts from musical comedies, singspiele, zarzuelas, etc., with original orchestral accompaniment)

Under M12 will be found a comprehensive scheme covering the various forms of instrumental music, such as sonatas, variations, suites, etc. This scheme is designed to serve as a standard pattern, to be followed, with the necessary modifications, in assigning decimal subdivisions for added entries under the different instrumental media.

For example: a collection of original and arranged waltzes for organ, classed in M6 (collections of organ compositions, originals or originals and arrangements), can be given an added entry in (M6.63--collections of dances in triple time, originals or originals and arrangements, for organ); a collection of original piano sonatas by two composers would be classed in M21 (collections of piano compositions, originals, by two or more composers), with an added entry in (M21.1--collections of piano sonatas, originals, by two or more composers). Where the classification schedule already provides some of the subdivisions needed, these have been supplemented by numbers in "curves" which follow the pattern under M12 as closely as circumstances permit.

In the case of orchestral, band or chamber music arranged for a different medium, form takes precedence over medium.

For example: a suite for string orchestra, arranged for two pianos, will be classed in M215 (arrangements, either collections or separates, for two performers at two pianos) and given an added entry in (M215.2--arrangements of

suites, either collections or separates, for two performers at two pianos); a march for band, arranged for clarinet and piano, classed in M252 (arrangement of a separate work for clarinet and piano), will have an added entry in (M252.5--arrangement of a march, separate work, for clarinet and piano).

Advantage has been taken of the opportunity to include in this supplement the class numbers added to the M section of the official music classification schedule and the modifications of terminology adopted since the revision of 1917.

As an aid in both subject cataloging and reference work, a general index to instrumental and vocal music has been added, covering media, forms, conventional types, traditional titles and subjects, etc.

(This index was prepared before the typographic style of the main section had been determined; hence the use of square brackets instead of "curves" to indicate numbers for added entry only)

In this scheme concertos are differentiated as to (1) scores, i.e. complete scores for solo and orchestral instruments, (2) cadenzas for solo instruments and (3) solo(s)-with-piano scores, i.e. scores in which the solo parts are unchanged and the orchestral accompaniment is arranged (reduced) for piano. The term "piano" is used for any keyboard instrument.

For cadenzas, use the classification number for the corresponding score, subdivided by .5. Cutter them first by name of composer of concerto, then by name of composer of cadenza.

A two-piano concerto arranged for three pianos in such a manner that the third piano part is a reduction of the orchestral accompaniment and the other two are unchanged solo parts, is classified in M1011. If, however, concertos are arranged so that solo parts are changed, such arrangements are classified with arrangements for the new medium. Thus, a concerto grosso arranged for piano, four hands, is classed in M210, and a concerto for two pianos arranged for two pianos (i.e. the orchestral accompaniment incorporated in the former solo parts) is classified in M215.

When a concerto for one solo instrument is arranged for a new solo instrument, the orchestral accompaniment being unchanged, except for transposition, it is classified with concertos for the new medium. Thus, a violoncello concerto in which the solo part has been adapted for viola is classified in M1014-1015.
