Fees realised under the Petroleum and Explosives Acts which are administered by the Provincial Governments on behalf of the Central Government used to be credited to Provincial Revenues direct, but on the advice of the Auditor General it was decided that as they constituted a part of the central revenues with effect from 1st April 1938 both the receipts and payments should pass through the central accounts and that an amount equivalent to the fees realised should be paid to the Provincial Governments as charges for administering the Acts. The supplementary demand is required for covering these payments for which no provision was made in the original budget.
