- Part II-B .. Statistical Tables relating to Economic Classification and Household and Age.

In addition, there will be another part of the Report to deal with the administrative aspects of the Census Operations.

Census Handbooks for each of the 13 districts of the State have also been compiled. The printing and publication of such Handbooks is the responsibility of the State Government. A limited number of sets have been cyclostyled and distributed at the cost of the Government of India, but judging from numerous requisitions and enquiries relating to these Handbooks from Government Departments, various public institutions and private bodies, it is of utmost importance that their printing and publication should be undertaken by the State Government so that the Handbooks may be available for sale to the public as in other States.
