- 2. The Economic Tables prepared for the 1951 Census are based on the "Indian usus Economic Classification Scheme" for the 1951 Census. The "Indian Consus Economic Classification Scheme" as given in the General Introduction of Part II-B applies to this part (Part II-C) also so far as the rural and urban breakul of the population is concerned.
- 3. This part does not contain Table B-II—Secondary Means of Livelihood, because Table B-II was not prepared for the rural and urban population separately as in the cases of Tables B-I and B-III.
