FOREWORD.

Volume III of the Report embodies the replies to the questionnaire issued by the Bihar Labour Enquiry Committee. It has been divided in the following three parts.—

Part A.—Replies by the officials.

Part B.—Replies by the employers and their Associations.

Part C.—Replies by the employees and their organisations.

Part B has been further sub-divided into four books, Book 1 dealing with replies by metallurgical concerns, Book 2 dealing with replies by engineering concerns, Book 3 dealing with replies from mines and quarries (Coal, Mica, Ores and other Quarries), and Book 4 dealing with replies by sugar, cement, textile, shellac and other miscellaneous industries.

In order to save space only the numbers of the questions have been put before the replies, the questionnaire being printed in the beginning for ready reference.

Considering the fact that some of the replies to question no. 132 of the General Questionnaire were submitted to the Committee as confidential documents, it was thought advisable not to print all of them. A voluminous appendix to reply to question no. 17 of the General Questionnaire by the Tata Iron and Steel Company, Limited, also has not been printed in order to save space and time. In part A of this volume are also embodied the notes and memoranda submitted by some of the official witnesses as a result of further queries by the Committee either at the time of oral evidence or independently.
