SUMMARY OF RECOMMENDATIONS

THIS SUMMARY brings together the principal recommendations contained in the final report on the Five Year Plan, which was approved by Parliament in December, 1952. The recommendations have been set out chapter by chapter, and against each recommendation the paragraph number and the number of the page on which it appears in the report have been indicated. For convenience of reference each recommendation carries its own index number. A short subject index has been provided at the end of the Summary.

A word of caution may also be added. While the Summary will assist in drawing attention to individual recommendations in the Plan, as a general rule, it is desirable to ascertain the implications of any recommendation by referring to the final report itself.
