We are glad to report that the UGC has sanctioned financial assistance for the Sixth Plan Period under the Area Studies Programme re. East European Economies. We also gratefully acknowledge the recurring assistance from 1981-82 sanctioned by the Government of Maharashtra to meet part of the expenses of data processing and library.

Under the UGC's Programme of Teachers Fellowships in the Centre of Advanced Study in Economics, we awarded 3 Teacher Fellowships for M.Phil. and 3 more fellowships for Ph.D. to the Teachers who had completed earlier under the Fellowship Programme M.Phil. in Economics. Besides, the Institute awarded two Junior Research Fellowships, to work on the M.Phil. Programme in Economics.

Five Research Fellows who were awarded the fellowship in previous years continued to work on their Ph.D. thesis during 1982-83. Four National Scholarships were awarded to the M.A. Economics students at our Centre this year. Besides, the 2 National Scholarships awarded last year were continued during 1982-83.

There were 48 students for M.A. Economics and 11 students for M.Phil. in Economics, at the Centre for Post-graduate Teaching in Economics of the University of Poona located at this Institute. The Institute continued its efforts to help the post-graduate students to improve their reading and writing ability in English. Nine M.A. students attended the weekly classes for Remedial English. In the programme of Teaching of B.A. Economics as a special subject and Mathematical and Statistical Prerequisites and Commerce as subsidiary subjects, there were 7 students in the F.Y.B.A., 8 students in the S.Y.B.A. and 9 in the T.Y.B.A. in 1982-83.

The Post-graduate Department of Economics of the University of Poona located in the Institute accepted, at the University's directive, the responsibility of implementing instructions to the students enrolled at N. Wadia College for M.A. Economics.

Among those who completed the M.Phil. training programme in previous years, five were awarded the M.Phil. degree in Economics of the University of Poona during the year under report.

Most of the members of the research and teaching staff were engaged in teaching courses to the B.A., M.A. and M.Phil. students in Economics. Besides, some of the teachers visited the post-graduate centres of the University of Poona, located in the mofussil colleges to give lectures to the post-graduate students.

Under the Kunda Datar Memorial Grant, Professor Lalit K. Deshpande, University of Bombay, delivered 4 lectures on (1) Segmented Labour Markets : Theory and Evidence; (2) Segmentation in Bombay : Evidence (a) Wage and Income, (b) Pre-entry Factors, and (c) Post-entry Factors, (3) Demand for and supply of Labour in Bombay, and (4) Policy Implications, on 17, 18, 19 and 20th January 1983, respectively.
