N.B. The total estimated expenditure shown here for 1965-66 is Rs 550 crores. This figure is not unanimously accepted. An alternative estimate is Rs 570-600 crores, the increase being one mainly to the increases granted in teachers' salaries during the current year (1965-66) account of the rise in prices. The Planning Commission has, however, estimated that the total educational expenditure in 1965-66 is likely to be Rs 660 crores. This is definitely on the high side and very probably the total expenditure on education in 1965-66 may lie between Rs 550 crores and Rs 600 crores.
