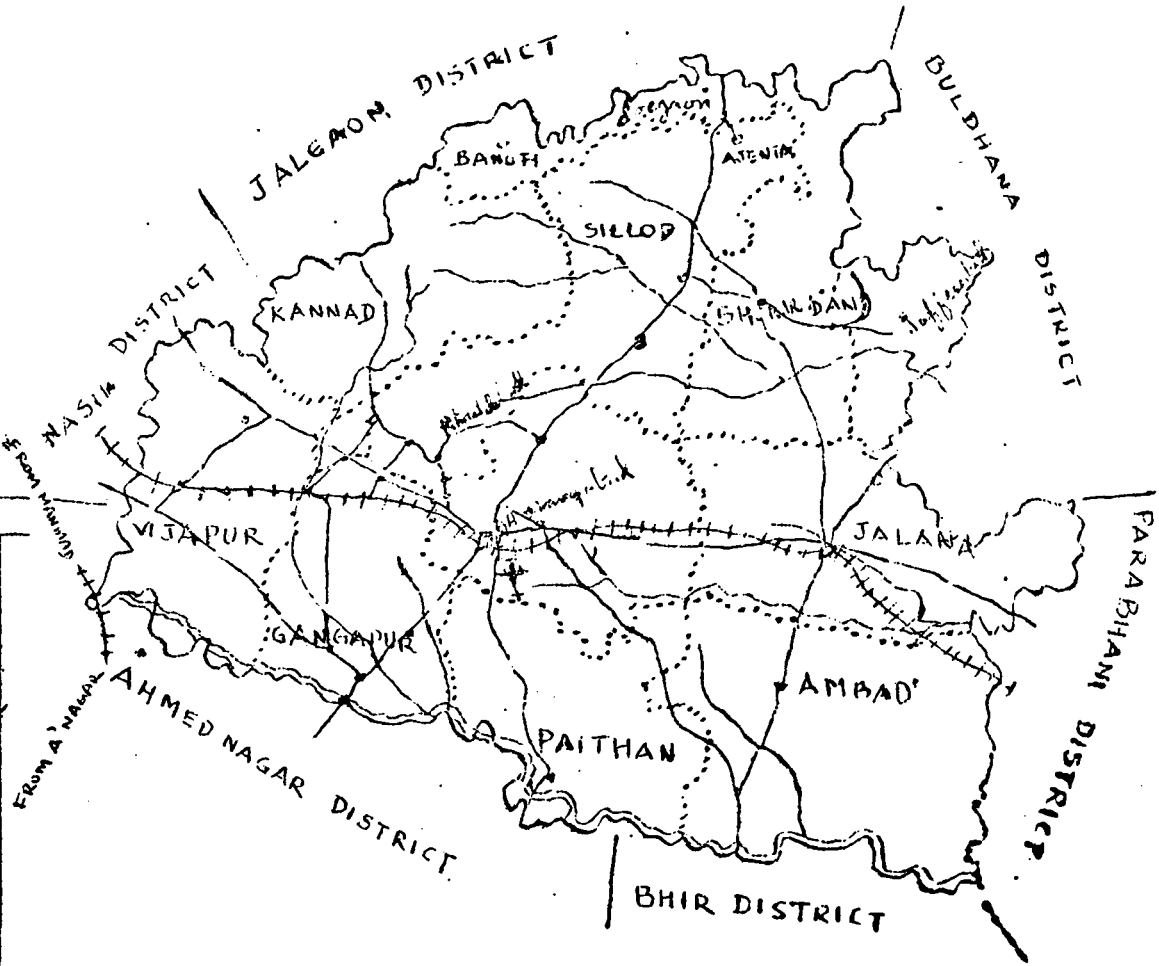
MAP OF AMRANGAHEAD DISTRICT

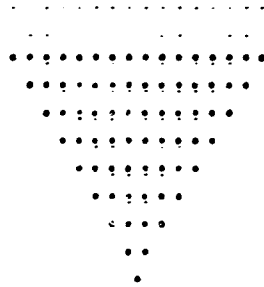
