Additional tables regarding economic classification of State Budget, wholesale prices in Bombay Market, Trade Union and Electoral Statistics have been included in this issue, while further details are given this time in the State-income tables. Attempts are made to give the latest data of 1970-71 in most of the tables and wherever possible, the districtwise data is also given.

It is hoped that this publication giving the districtwise data on most of the socio-economic characteristics of the State will serve as an important reference book for those interested in the Socio-Economic and regional studies of the State.

We thank the various departments and offices of State Government, Government of India and local organisations which extended considerable co-operation in supplying the requisite material for inclusion in the Abstract.
