Resolution on the General Report on Public Instruction in Assam for the year 1940-41

*Extract from the proceedings of the Government of Assam in the Education Department
No. EMI.222/42, dated the 10th August 1942.*

READ :—

The Report on Public Instruction in Assam for the year 1940-41.

R E S O L U T I O N

In spite of the abnormal times and the disturbed economic and political condition of the country, educational activities continued to expand. The Mass Literacy Campaign, the improvement and expansion of Primary Education and the expansion of education among the Tribal people received the special attention of Government. A post of Assistant Director of Public Instruction in Class I of the Assam Educational Service and another post of Assistant Inspectress of Schools in Class II of the same service (Women's Branch) were added to the cadre. A new class, *viz.*, Class III was added to the Assam Educational Service and 10 posts of Assistant Lecturers in different subjects were created, replacing the system of appointing tutors in July and discharging them in April every year. Institutions of all kinds increased by 2,101 and the number of pupils attending the educational institutions by 64,103 as compared with the previous year. Recognised institutions increased from 8,867 to 11,107 and their enrolment from 5,20,473 to 5,89,167. The total expenditure on public instruction increased from Rs.64,01,619 to Rs.67,04,270. The progress made in the different grades of institutions is summarised below :—

2. *Collegiate Education.*—The number of Government Colleges remained unchanged, but Private Colleges were increased by four. These were Madhab Choudhury College at Barpeta, the 'R. H. Girls' College at Gauhati and the Women's College and the Madan Mohan College at Sylhet. The enrolment in all the Colleges increased from 3,299 to 3,547. The Murarichand College was affiliated in Bengali as a second language up to the B. A. Standard. The Cotton College secured affiliation in Botany to the degree standard and Zoology up to the Intermediate Science. The total cost for each student in the Cotton College was Rs.257 of which Government paid Rs.171 or 67 per cent. and in the Murarichand College Rs.302 of which Government bore Rs.222 or 73 per cent. Government contribution to non-Government Arts Colleges for Women increased from Rs.6,000 to Rs.11,600.

3. *Secondary Schools for Boys.*—Taking High Schools, Middle English Schools and Middle Vernacular Schools together the number of institutions increased from 658 to 708 and their enrolment from 1,02,395 to 1,07,635. The number of High Schools increased by 16 and the enrolment therein by 4,345. The cost per pupil in a Government High School was Rs.67-12-0 of which Government paid Rs.51-1-0. The cost per pupil in an Aided High School was Rs.25 of which Rs.8-13-0 was met from Government grants, Rs.15-15-0 from fee income and the balance from other sources. In an Unaided High School the cost per pupil was Rs.24-9-0 of which Rs.15-15-0 was met from fees and the balance from other sources. As in the previous year the popularity of Middle Vernacular Schools was confined to the Assam Valley. The move for separation of English Classes and constituting them into independent Middle English Schools is taking shape in some places. It is gratifying to note that the introduction of vernacular as the medium of instruction has brought about a distinct improvement in the atmosphere of the Schools. In the Matriculation Examination of 1941 the results achieved by the Assam boys were remarkable, three of them securing the first, second and third places in the University.

4. *Primary Education for Boys.*—The number of institutions providing Primary Education for boys increased from 6,842 to 7,166 and the enrolment from 3,52,524 to 3,68,347. The expenditure increased from Rs. 14,49,887 to Rs. 14,85,388 of which nearly 2/3rd was borne by Government. The regrettable wastage in the number of pupils in the elementary schools continues. The defects of single teacher schools are too well known but Government are unable to improve matters appreciably at present due to financial and other difficulties.

5. *Female Education.*—Female Education during the year continued to make slow but steady headway. The number of girls reading in all institutions, both for boys and girls increased from 1,30,548 to 1,39,451. The number of institutions for Indian girls rose from 1,269 to 1,396 and their enrolment from 61,563 to 67,545. This marked increase in the number of both institutions and scholars is a clear indication of the rapidly awakening interest in female education. The number of Arts Colleges for women increased from 2 to 4 and their enrolment from 103 to 163. Besides, 146 girls were reading in Men's Colleges.

6. *Education of the Hill Tribes.*—All hill districts showed increased enrolment in Primary Schools except the Khasi and Jaintia Hills where a decline was recorded. A Government High School at Jowai in the Khasi and Jaintia Hills district was started and the Tura Government High School attained its full-fledged status. Schools for the Mikirs in the Mikir Hills increased only by three but there was a very marked increase in the number of schools for Miris.

The number of tea-garden schools increased by 63 but their enrolment decreased by 4,646. Government much appreciate the good services of the various public bodies to the cause of education of the backward and other classes.

7. *Training of Teachers.*—The total number of trained teachers increased from 4,191 to 4,318 but their percentage fell from 28.3 to 27.4. The number of trained women teachers increased from 328 to 347.

8. *Discipline, etc.*—Discipline was well maintained throughout the year with the exception of a few minor strikes. Moral and Physical Training proceeded successfully in the form of games and sports, Physical Training Camps, Boy-Scout, Girl Guide and Junior Red Cross Movements.

9. The present Government will do their utmost, within the limits of their resources to help the Director in coping with the various necessities mentioned in the Report.

10. The progress recorded and the maintenance of the efficiency of the Department reflect great credit on Mr. Small, who handed over charge of the Department shortly after the conclusion of the year, having served in it for 32 years and acted as its head since 1931. Government note with pleasure the names of the officers that have been specially mentioned for good work in the cause of education of this Province. Government also thank Mr. Roy for his interesting report.
