Except for the information on Literacy and Budget which have been taken from the Census Report, 1951 and the State Budget respectively, the data presented in this brochure have been collected from the Director of Public Instructions, Assam.

(1947-48 to 1959-59)**

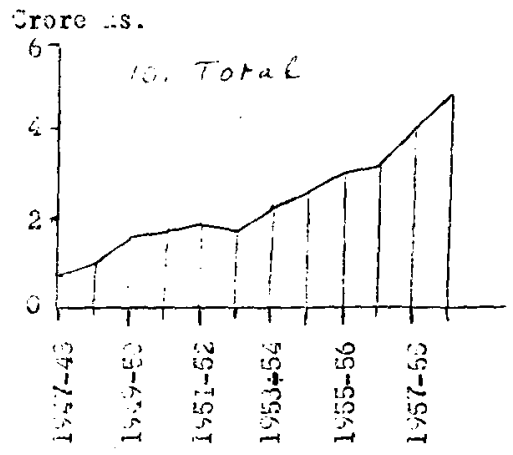
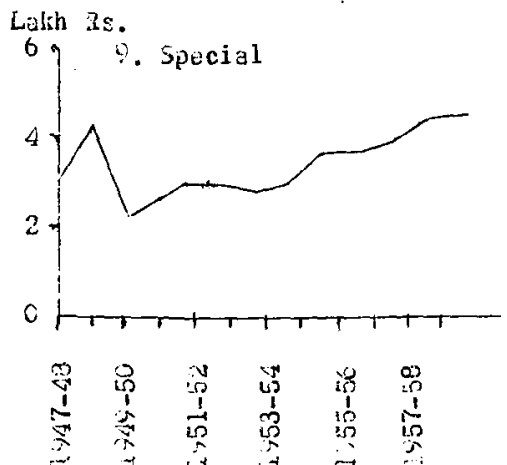
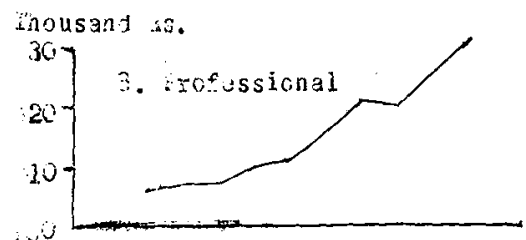
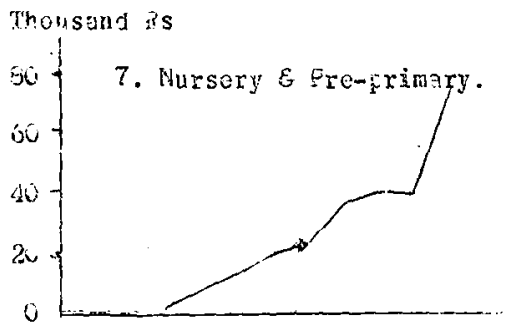
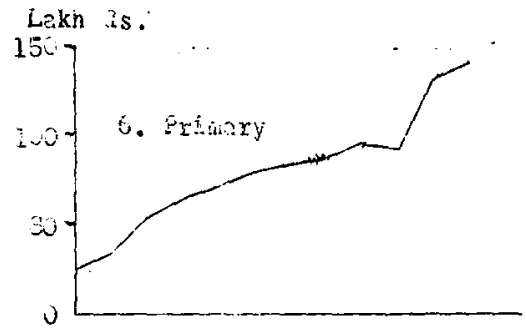
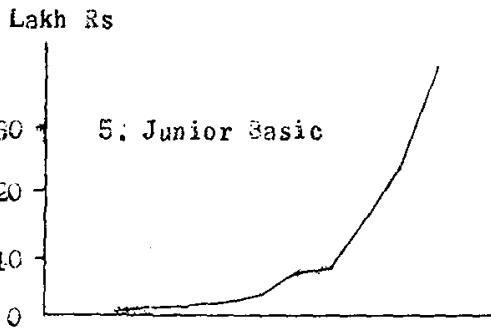
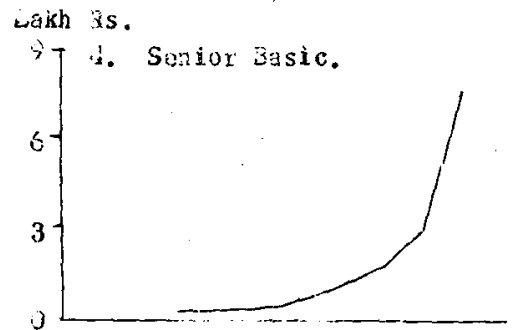
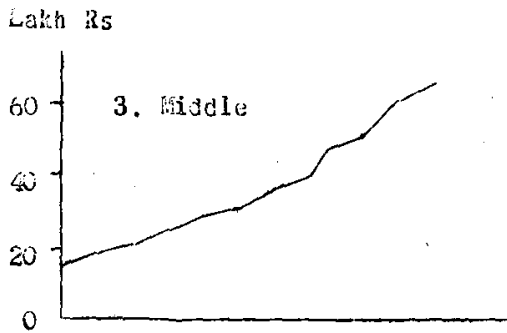
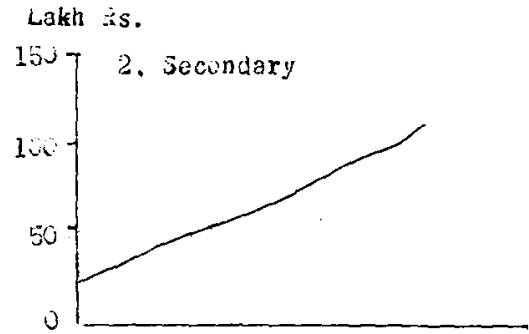
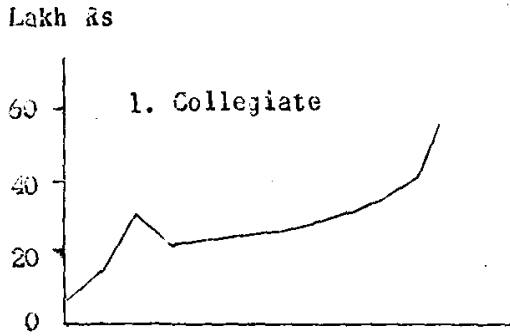

(1951-52 to 1959-60)

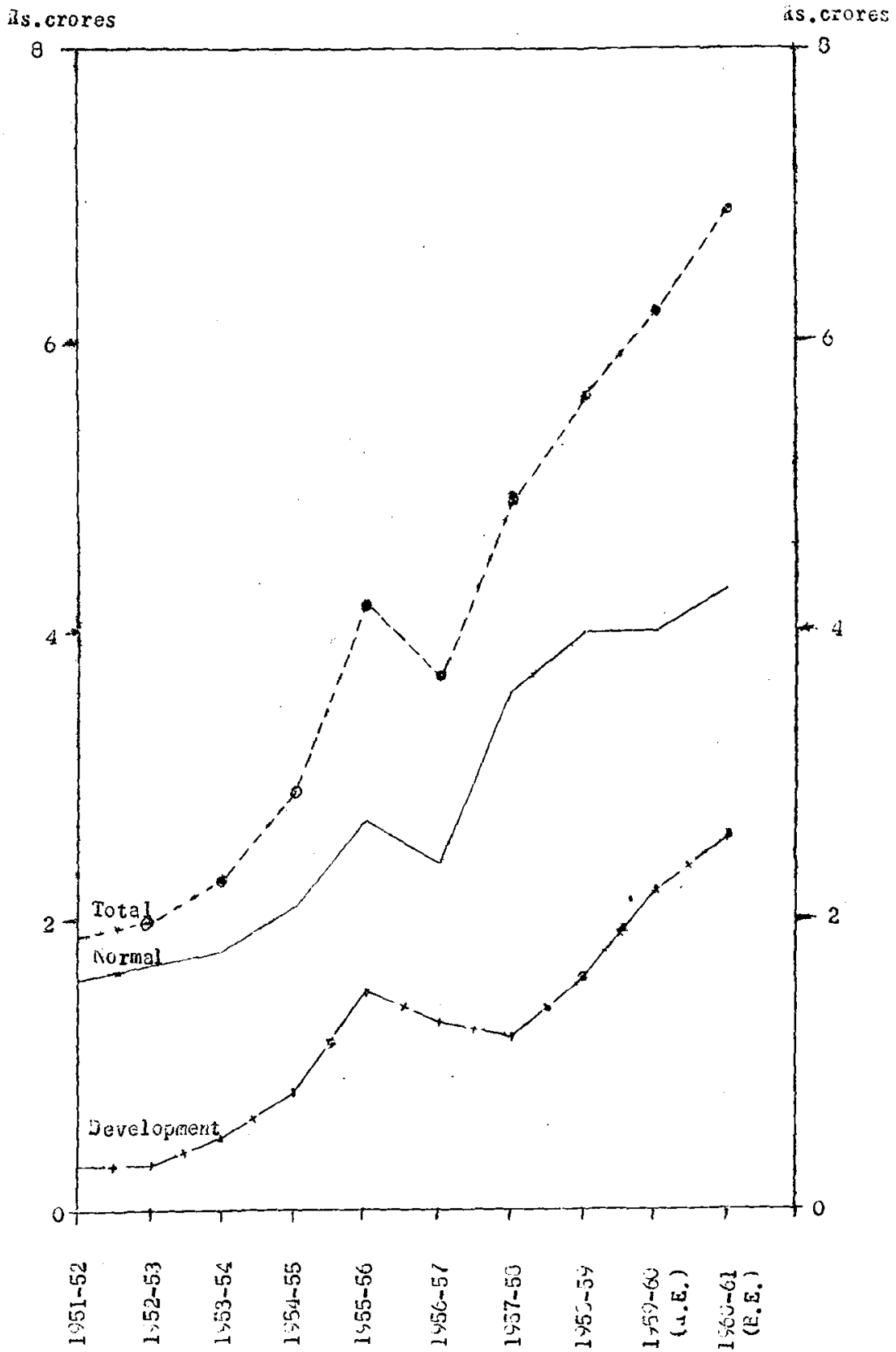
