EXPLANATIONS

PART—I

FORM ES-I(C) Numerical Data

1. Academic Year . For the sake of uniformity, the academic year is taken to coincide with the financial year i.e. from April 1st of one year to March, 31st of the next. The Numerical Data in this form should be reported as on 30th September of the Academic year.
2. Current year For the sake of clarity it may be mentioned that the current year, wherever it occurs in these tables, means the year for which the statistics are being furnished and the year in which the form is being filed.
3. Recognised Institutions .. Are those in which the course of study followed is that which is prescribed or recognised by the Department of Public Instruction or by University or by a board of secondary and or Intermediate Education constituted by law and which satisfy one or more of these authorities as the case may be, that they attain to a reasonable standard of efficiency. They are open to inspection and their students are ordinarily eligible for admission to public examination and tests held by the Deptt. or the University or the Board.
4. Government Includes both Central and State Govts., unless otherwise provided for.
5. Local Bodies Include District School Boards, Municipal School Boards, Cantonment Boards Town Area Committees, Panchayat Samities, Zila Parishads, etc.
6. Pre-Primary School/Classes . Include all nursery, infants, kindergarten and other such schools/Classes.
7. Higher Secondary Schools .. Are those schools after passing out from which the students can be admitted in degree classes of Universities.
(10+2) pattern
8. Under Graduate Engineering.. Includes Survey Schools.
Colleges
9. Schools for Oriental Studies .. Include Tools, Madrassas, Arabic, Sanskrit and vedic Schools, Sanskrit Pathshalas and other such schools.
10. School for Physical Education.. Exclude Gymnasia

THE STATISTICS GIVEN IN THESE TABLES INCLUDE STATISTICS OF CENTRALLY ADMINISTERED EDUCATIONAL AND/OR RESEARCH INSTITUTIONS.

PART-II

Form ES-II (C & S) Financial Data

1. Date of Reference .. Financial data should be reported for the year ending on 31st March of the year under report.
2. Income and Expenditure .. Should relate to financial year i.e. to the period 1st April of one year to 31st March of the next year.
3. Income means the receipts of the institutions
4. Expenditure means payments .. Expenditure should, however, relate to the amount actually spent during the year under report.
5. Income and Expenditure .. In respect of the following items will be excluded as these are neither income to the institutions, nor the amount incurred out of these constitution expenditure on the institutions:—
 - (a) Refundable security deposits such as Library deposits, Laboratory caution money, Hostel caution money etc.
 - (b) Money collected on behalf of other authorities such as State Government, Board etc., which is ultimately to be 'passed' on to these authorities such as Boards, Registration fee, Boards, Examination fee, etc.
 - (c) Fees Collected from some of the students for providing specific services to them such as bus fee etc.
 - (d) Repayment of loans (interest on loans) paid by the institutions will, however, be considered as an expenditure.
 - (e) If nursing or other educational classes are conducted in hospitals, the expenditure on these classes only will be shown against the relevant side-heads.
 - (f) The hostel fee should exclude the 'messing fee' However if the institution contributes any thing towards 'mess' from its own funds that amount should be shown under 'other items'
 - (g) Fees forgone by the institution on account of fee studentship should not be included in income from tuition fee, but in the case of reimbursement of fee by Government or any agency does receive that amount and it should be shown as income from tuition fees. Again this reimbursement is received by the student as financial assistance and is given by agency who pays towards this.

reimbursement, and as such should be included in income from that source and expenditure for scholarship, stipends and other financial assistance.

- (h) The deficit during the year has not been included under "other source" on income side, but if the deficit is met by the management from their own funds, this amount has been shown as non-recurring income from the management and institutions not considered in deficit. In case the deficit is met by raising loans, the amount thus received has not been treated as income of the institutions but has been shown in foot-note only. Similarly, the payment of such loans has not been considered as expenditure. Only the amount paid as interest on account of such loans if any has been shown on expenditure side. Surplus has not been shown against "other items" on the expenditure side.

6. Expenditure :

In calculating the expenditure from Govt. and local body funds entered in Table II, all payments of contributions from fees, endowments etc. and other source, which are credited to such funds or deducted.

7. Endowments etc.

Include subscription, contributions and income from endowments.

8. THE STATISTICS GIVEN IN THIS FORM RELATE TO ALL THOSE INSTITUTIONS WHOSE NUMERICAL STATISTICS HAVE BEEN FURNISHED IN FORM ES-I (C & S)

PART-III

(Form ES-III) Examination Results

1. Examination Results refer to those students who are educated during the year under report for which the statistics have been furnished in Form ES-I Numerical Data, besides, these include also results of private candidates.
2. The number of boys and girls appeared in and passed the various examinations have been given both for annual as well as supplementary examination.
3. For each course, the results may be given only of the final class and not of lower classes even if these are conducted by a public authority like University, Boards or State Governments, etc.
4. As regards primary and middle stages, the results of only the final class of these stages will be given through these are not conducted by Public authorities in certain states.
5. The results of final class of the junior basic and senior basic stages will be given separately from those of primary and middle stages.
6. Annual examination results may be submitted earlier separately and Supplementary results may follow as and when these are available.

 5. Pre-Primary School/Classes Include all Nursery, Infants, Kindergarten and other such school classes.
 6. Schools for Oriental Studies.. Including Toles, Madrassas, Arabic, Sanskrit and Vedic Schools, Sanskrit Pathshalas and other such schools.
 7. The Statistics given in these tables relate to all those Institutions whose Statistics are Furnished in Form ES(S). The Statistics of Centrally Administered Educational or Research Institutions should be Included.
