Bibliographic Record?

- Bibliographic description stored either manually or electronically.
- Information about an item, recorded in a standard format and held in a database. Cards / online catalog.
- Bib record includes call number, author, title, publication information, paging, subject headings, etc.
- Uses Character strings, including a record label, a directory, and a bibliographic data describing one entity.

Bibliographic Record Formats - Why?

- Different file formats for exchange of bibliographic data
- Exchange formats were developed in parallel with development of computers and other electronic storage devices
- Affects economies by reducing the duplication of effort.
- Different country and organization developed their own format. But there was no co-ordination between these organizations.
- UNESCO, IFLA, ICSU-AB, UNISIST, ISO have taken many steps towards the standardization of Bibliographic exchange format.

Exchange Formats

- Format: a carrier for data between two systems e.g. two library automation systems webserver and personal computer
- Format is the set of rules governing the data structure and content?
- ISO 2709: format for bibliographic information interchange on magnetic tape
- 3-digit tags for content, described in appropriate MARC, UNIMARC or CCF manual

MARC Machine Readable Cataloguing

- MARC standards are a set of digital formats for the description of items catalogued by libraries, such as books.
- American computer scientist **Henriette Avram** developed MARC in the 1960s to create records that could be read by computers and shared among libraries
- USMARC, UKMARC, UNIMARC, CANMARC
- MARC21

MARC – MAchine Readable Catalogue?

- MARC: MAchine-Readable Cataloguing record. "Machine-readable" means that one particular type of machine, a computer, can read and interpret the data in the cataloguing record.
- Cataloguing record: "Cataloguing record" means a bibliographic record, or the information traditionally shown on a catalogue card.
- MARC, UNIMARC and CCF formats which have the common record structure based on the ISO 2709 format
 - 3-digit tags
 - subfields \$a, \$b, \$4
 - indicators of 2 characters

Purpose

- International exchange of bibliographic data in MARC form between national bibliographic agencies.
- A model for the development of new machine-readable bibliographic formats

Users

- National libraries for international exchange
- Certain countries for exchange between national library and others

CCF: Common Communication Format

- Symposium organised by the UNISIST in 1978 on Bibliographic Exchange Formats
- On recommendations of the Symposium
- UNESCO formed the adhoc group on the establishment of the CCF.
- Published in 1984, second ed. in 1988.
- Users
 - S&T sector
 - Commonly in India
 - UN agencies

UNIMARC: Purpose and Scope?

Purpose

- Facilitate the international exchange of bibliographic data in MARC form between national bibliographic agencies.
- UNIMARC a model for the development of new machinereadable bibliographic formats.

Scope

- Specify the content designators (tags, indicators and subfield codes)
- Covers monographs, serials, cartographic materials, music, sound recordings, graphics, projected and video materials, rare books and electronic resources.


CCF Recommendations

- New format should follow ISO 2709 Structure
- Main record would comprise of a number of data elements essential for Bibliographical Description identified in a standard manner.
- The main record would have additional optional data elements recognized in standard manner.
- A standard technique would be proposed for accommodating levels relationships and links.
- It was to act as a bridge between major international bib exchange formats.

CCF: Purpose

- To provide a detailed and structured method for recording a number of mandatory and optional data elements in a computer-readable bibliographic record for exchange purposes between two or more computerized systems.
- It can also be useful within non computerized bibliographic systems
- Meant to be a specification to assist system designers in devising local procedures and computer programs for exchange of files.


Historical growth of MARCs

- LC and BL Meet : on 21 June 1994
 - To review principles for harmonization and simplification of USMARC and UKMARC
 - To increase the compatibility with ultimate goal to achieve one single MARC

MARC21

- In 1999 LC and NLC merged USMARC and CANMARC to MARC21
- Published MARC21 Format for Bibliographic Data
- MARC21 Documentation maintained by LC

Current Scenario

- MARC21 available in more than 20 Languages
- Many Countries / Libraries preferred to move to MARC21

MARC21: Users

- US and Canadian Libraries
- Australia, Spain, etc.
- Users of library systems which support no other format

MARC21

- Formerly called US MARC
- Marketed as international
- Universality of UNIMARC not satisfactory
- National Library of Canada adopted
- British Library abandoned UKMARC
- Uses the ISO 2709 record structure
- Huge number of records available
- Format not proprietary
- Allows variable length and repeatable fields and subfields

5. Community Information

• information about events, programs, services, etc. which can be integrated into public access catalogs

- Printed and manuscript textual materials, computer files, maps, music, continuing resources, visual materials, and mixed materials.
- Commonly includes titles, names, subjects, notes, publication data, and information about the physical description of an item.



MARC21 Structure

- MARC21 Formats are standards for the representation and communication of bibliographic and related information in machine readable format.
- It involves
 - Structure
 - Structure of MARC Record is an implementation of national and international standards like ISO 2709 / ANSI Z39.2
 - Content Designation
 - Codes and conventions established to identify explicitly and characterize further the data elements within a record and to support the manipulation of those data
 - Content
 - Data elements identified by standards outside the formats.
 - Ex. AACR, LCSH, NLMC

ISO 2709

- ISO 2709: standard for bibliographic descriptions, entitled Format for Bibliographic Information Interchange on Magnetic Tape.
- Developed in the 1960s by the Library of Congress to encode the information printed on library cards.
- First created as ANSI Standard Z39.2, called Information Interchange Format.
- 1981 version of the standard called Documentation—Format for bibliographic information interchange on magnetic tape.
- Latest edition of that standard is Z39.2-1994
- The ISO standard supersedes Z39.2. As of December 2008 the current standard is ISO 2709:2008.

MARC21 ISO 2709 Record Structure

Leader

- Contains coded values and are identified by relative character position
- Define the parameters for processing the record.
- Leader is a fixed in length, 24 Characters, and
- Occurs at the beginning of each MARC record.

Directory

- Contains the tag, starting location and length of each field within record.
- Length of directory entry is defined in the entry map of Leader/20-23
- In MARC21, length of a directory entry is 12 characters
- It ends with a field terminator character.

Variable Fields

- Data content of a record is divided into variable fields.
- Variable Control Fields Coded Fields 007 & 008
- Variable Data Fields

ISO 2709: Basic Structure

- A ISO 2709 record has **four sections**:
- **Record label:** the first 24 characters of the record.
 - Fixed in length.
 - Includes the record length and the base address of the data
 - It also has data elements that indicate how many characters are used for indicators and subfield identifiers.
- **Directory:** provides the entry positions to the fields in the record, along with the field tags.
 - Field tag (3 characters)
 - Length of the field
 - Starting character position of the field
 - (Optional) Implementation-defined part
- Datafields: a string containing all field and subfield data in the record
- **Record separator:** a single character


ISO 2709: Record Label

Each bibliographic record begins with a fixed-length label of 24 characters, the contents of which are as follows:

ISO 2709: Directory

- **Tag:** A three character code identifying the datafield which corresponds to directory entry
- Length of Datafields: A four-digit number showing how many characters are occupied the datafield, including indicators and datafield separator but excluding the record separator code if the datafield is the last field in the record.
- Starting character position: A five-digit number giving the position of the first character of the datafield relative to the base address of data, i.e. the first character of the first of the datafield
- **Segment identifier:** A single character (chosen from 0-9 and/or A-Z) which designates the datafield as being a member of particular segment
- Occurrence identifier: A single character (chosen from 0-9 and A-Z) which differentiates multiple occurrences of the datafields that carry the same tag within the same record segment



MARC21 Terminologies

Field:

- Each bibliographic record divided into Fields which are subdivided into subfields.
- E.g. Author, Title, Edition, etc.

• Subfield:

- Most fields contain several related pieces of data.
- Each type of data within the field is called subfield.
- E.g. Author Last Name, First Name, Date, etc

• Tag:

- Each Field is represented with a 3 digit number called a "tag"
- It identifies the field and the kind kind of data that follows.
- Tag can be Alphabetic or Numeric Z39.2, MARC21 uses only Numeric Tags
- Stored in the Directory and not in the field itself

• Indicator:

- Two character positions following the tag.
- One or both the positions are used. Undefined indicators are blank, i.e. #

Subfield Code:

One lowercase letter preceded by delimiter, indicates the type of data that follows it.

• Delimiter:

A Character used to separate subfields. It can be @, \$, _ or ^ as in WINISIS.


