



**REPORT ON THE THIRD GENERAL ELECTION TO THE
ORISSA LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY, 1961**

After the second general election to the Legislative Assembly of Orissa in 1957, the party position was as follows :—

A coalition Ministry consisting of representatives of the Indian National Congress and Ganatantra Parishad was formed in the State. Owing to differences arising between the two parties and coming to a head early in 1961, the Ministry resigned at the beginning of the budget session and the legislative assembly was dissolved by a Presidential proclamation on February 25. In the normal course, the third general election in the State was due a year hence in February or March 1962 when it could have been held simultaneously with the general election to the House of the People. Since, however, this would have meant the continuance of the Presidential rule for 12 months or more, the Central Government decided that the general election to the State Legislative Assembly should be held earlier as soon as practicable.

During the previous general election, 25 seats for the scheduled castes and 14 for the scheduled tribes had been reserved in two-member assembly constituencies. The two Member Constituencies (Abolition) Act enacted in January 1961 provided for the abolition of all such constituencies and for their division by the Election Commission into single member constituencies. The Commission had to take up this task first in Orissa and give it a very high priority. Its proposals for the division of 39 assembly constituencies and 6 parliamentary constituencies in this State were published on March 24, the objections and suggestions received from the public in regard to these proposals were considered on April 18 at a public sitting in Bhubaneswar and the Commission's final amendments to the Orissa Schedule to the Delimitation of Parliamentary and Assembly Constituencies Order, 1956, were published in the official gazette on April 22.

Electoral rolls

The electoral rolls for 120 assembly constituencies had been intensively revised after house to house enumeration during the three preceding years, and the rolls for the remaining 20 constituencies along with certain areas comprising 10 constituencies which were revised in 1958 were due for intensive revision during 1961. In view of the general election which had to be held at short notice, only a summary revision of the rolls could be attempted in this year. A few cases of omission of whole village from the electoral rolls came to the notice of the Commission and in every such case a special revision of the relevant part of the electoral rolls was ordered. After the revision, the total electorate in the State was found to be 85,40,861 as compared to 79,83,975 during the 1957 election. The number of electors varied a good deal from one constituency to another, the smallest being 40,557 in Kasipur constituency in Kalahandi district and the largest being 79,422 in Boudh constituency in Phulbani district.

gramme**

In fixing the dates of poll, the Commission had to take into account the advent of the monsoon which usually takes place about June 10. Once heavy rains set in, a considerable part of the State is inundated and communications are disrupted. The dates of poll had therefore to be fixed ahead of the onset of the monsoon in the State. The Commission recommended to the Governor that the notification calling upon the constituencies to elect should issue on April 26, and fixed the following programme for the other stages of the election :—

Last date for making nominations ..	May 6.
Date for scrutiny of nominations ..	May 9.
Last date for withdrawal of candidatures ..	May 12.
Dates of poll ..	June 2 to 8.
Date by which elections should be completed ..	June 20.

Poll was to be taken from 7.30 A.M. to 4.30 P.M.

Period of Poll

The period of poll was compressed to one week, beginning on June 2 and ending on June 8, which was a great improvement on the record of 1957 when the poll was spread over a period of 17 days from February 24 to March 12. In 107 constituencies, the poll was completed on a single day, in 8 on two days, in 15 on three days and in 10 on four days. But for the fear of onset of the monsoon and consequent disruption of communications and lack of polling and police

personnel, it would have been possible to complete the poll in a larger number of constituencies on a single day or at the most on two days.

8,648 polling stations in all were provided for the 140 assembly constituencies. Out of these, 550 were located in temporary structures and 243 in private buildings. All the remaining polling stations were located in Government Buildings. The number of polling stations set up during the 1957 general elections was 6,721.

Polling at each polling station was conducted by a polling party consisting of one presiding officer and four polling officers. The presiding officer was invariably a Government servant and the polling officers were either Government servants or school teachers. Each polling party had to conduct poll at three or four polling stations in succession.

The total police forces available for maintaining law and order during the poll period was only 6,500. In order to employ them to the best advantage, polling stations were divided into two categories, A and B. About one-third of the total number was categorised 'A' and for each polling station of this category, one sub-inspector or Assistant sub-inspector and one constable were allotted. At each of the other polling stations categorised 'B', there was only one constable on duty. A chowkidar or excise peon or forest guard was however detailed to assist the police men on duty at every polling station.

690 candidates filed their nomination papers for the election. Out of these, the nomination papers of 13 candidates were rejected and 144 candidates withdrew from the contest, leaving 533 in the field. The Congress Party set up candidates for all the 140 seats and the Ganatantra Parishad for 121 of them. 46 belonged to the Praja Socialist Party, 35 to the Communist Party and 9 to the Jharkhand Party, which was not 'recognised' in Orissa. The total number of independent candidates was 182.

The marking system of voting was adopted at the election throughout the State including remote and backward *adivasi* areas. Ballot papers for the different constituencies were printed at the Government press in Cuttack and sent out to the districts well in time.

31,26,245 electors forming 36.60% of the total electorate of 85,40,861 voted at the elections. This turn out was better than at the 1957 general election when 34.3% of the electorate exercised their franchise.

Poll

Results	Counting of votes started on June 8 which was the last polling day in the State and the results were announced by June 11. The Congress Party secured 82 seats, Ganatantra Parishad 37, the Praja Socialist 10 and the Communist Party 4. The remaining 7 seats went to independents.
Forfeiture of deposits	The number of candidates who forfeited their security deposit was large. As many as 154 independent candidates out of 182 forfeited their deposits. Even among the candidates sponsored by the political parties, the number who failed to obtain one-sixth of the valid votes polled was quite considerable —40 Ganatantra Parishad, 14 Praja Socialist, 10 Communist, 6 Jharkhand and 6 Congress.
Rejected ballot papers	The total number of ballot papers rejected as invalid in all the constituencies came to 193,960 being 6.20% of the total number of votes polled. The high percentage of rejection was mainly due to the fact that the electorate had no previous experience of the marking system of voting.
Cost of election	The expenditure incurred by the State Government on the conduct of the general election was approximately Rs. 13 lakhs.
Accounts of election expenses	Of the 533 contesting candidates, 103 were disqualified for not lodging their accounts of election expenses within the time or in the manner prescribed by law.
Election petitions	Election petitions were filed in respect of 14 elections. Out of these, 7 were filed by Ganatantra Parishad candidates, 4 by Congress candidates and 1 each by a Praja Socialist and an independent candidate and 1 by an elector. Six election tribunals were constituted for the trial of these petitions, of which one was presided over by a retired Judge of the High Court of Allahabad. All the petitions, except one the trial of which has been stayed by an order of the Supreme Court, were disposed of by the tribunals by the end of July, 1962.
