This is the sixth issue of the Bulletin on Food Statistics. In the previous issues, the Bulletin presented within a brief compass an integrated picture of the production, procurement, imports, distribution, rationing and prices of cereals in India. After the decontrol of foodgrains, procurement, rationing and price control have come to an end and the necessity for publishing these data in the present form is not so great now. It is, therefore, proposed to merge this publication in future with the other publication, 'Food Situation in India' brought out by the Directorate of Economics and Statistics. This is, therefore, the last issue of this publication.

In this issue information has been given for the last three years only; at the end of important tables, however, a summary has been given showing the all-India position for earlier years. Certain tables, e. g., Rationed Population, Size and Composition of Rations, Issue Rates, Incidental Charges from Procurement to Wholesale Issue Stage, etc., which have very little relevance now, have been dropped, while some other tables relating to Inland Rail and River Borne Trade, Purchases made under the Price Support Scheme, etc., have been added.

The detailed work in the preparation of this publication has been done by the Cereals and Pulses Section of the Directorate of Economics and Statistics, Ministry of Food and Agriculture.
