### FOREWORD

Keeping in view the importance of informed decision on agricultural price policy, a combined volume containing reports of the Agricultural Prices Commission on price policy for crops sown in 1982-83 season was brought out in 1984. The present volume contains the various price policy reports of the Commission for crops sown in 1983-84. The arrangement of reports in this volume is slightly different from the one adopted in the earlier volume. This follows from the decision of the Commission in the beginning of 1983-84 to discontinue its earlier practice of submitting price policy reports on crop to crop basis. Instead the Commission has now started submitting its reports on price policy for different crops on integrated seasonal basis broadly divided into kharif and rabi. However, for jute and sugarcane the Commission continues to submit separate reports since they do not fall under the general seasonal pattern.

Consistent with the Government's policy of providing remunerative prices to the farmer, the support|procurement prices have been further raised for the 1983-84 crops as will be seen from the following table:—
