




# Cataloguing – Normative Principles

- Law of Parsimony
  - Between two or more alternatives - Economy of Manpower, Materials, Money, Time
- Canon of Impartiality
  - Choice of Entry by sufficient Grounds and not Arbitrarily
- Laws of Interpretation
  - During conflict between rules – use laws of interpretation
- Law of Symmetry
- Principle of Local Variation
- Principles of Osmosis – Adaptability to News Schemes
