THE PERIODICAL PUBLICATIONS OF THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS

OFFICIAL JOURNAL

Published separately in French and English. Is, in principle, a monthly publication, though two numbers may occasionally be combined in one volume. Contains the Minutes of the Council sessions, the texts of reports and resolutions adopted by the Council and the principal official documents received or sent out by the Secretariat.

OFFICIAL JOURNAL: SPECIAL SUPPLEMENTS

Regularly contain the records of the Assembly, including the Assembly resolutions, and a list to date of the ratification of Agreements and Conventions concluded under the League's auspices.

Subscriptions to the special supplements begin with the "Resolutions adopted by the Assembly", which are despatched a few weeks after the Assembly has finished its work, and they entitle subscribers to receive all the special supplements published between two ordinary sessions of the Assembly.

TREATY SERIES (Publication of Treaties and International Engagements registered with the Secretariat of the League of Nations)

Every international treaty or undertaking concluded by a Member of the League has to be registered immediately with the Secretariat and published by the latter as soon as possible; none of these treaties or undertakings come into force before being registered.

The publication of the *Treaty Series* fulfils this provision of the League Covenant.

MONTHLY SUMMARY OF THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS

EPIDEMIOLOGICAL REPORT of the Health Section of the Secretariat of the League of Nations

The Service of Epidemiological Intelligence and Public Health Statistics, Health Section of the Secretariat of the League of Nations, receives current official reports on the prevalence of notifiable diseases from all countries where such information is available. This information was for years published and analysed in the *Epidemiological Reports*.

As from January 1937, the epidemiological monographs hitherto published in the *Epidemiological Reports* appear in the *Bulletin of the Health Organisation* and the statistical tables are issued separately every month. Although reduced to the convenient foolscap size, the tables contain in addition to current statistical data, for purposes of comparison, epidemiological indices based on an experience of thirteen years. Continuity of the statistical material of the new series with the old has been maintained.
