NOTIFICATION.

Bombay Castle, 4th August 1831.

The Right Hon'ble the Governor in Council having sanctioned the publication of a weekly paper to be styled the "Bunkay Government of the public papers of the government, will be printed in the Bombay Government of the signature of the secretaries, or other public notices, appearing in that paper, under the signature of the secretaries, or other public officers of the government, are they ordered and directed to be conformed to and obeyed accordingly. It is not intended that public intelligence, or private advertisements, and notifications should be inserted in the

Bombay Castle, 18th January 1832.

When official notifications from the government are inserted in the Bombay Government Gazette, no communication on the same subject will be made in writing to any department concerned; but all public officers are required to take notice of such official notifications in the same manner as if they had been directly communicated to them by letter from the secretary's office, and as heade of offices alone will be furnished by government with the Bombay Government Gazette, they will be expected to communicate to this subordinate officers all orders which may in any manner concern them.

The Bombay Government Gazettes furnished by government to public offices, are to be lodged with the records, and are not to be removed from the office.

THE 29TH JUNE, 1835.

The following draft of a proposed Act, was read in Council for the first time on the 29th June 1835:-

Act No .--of 1.835.

Be it enacted, that from thethe undermentioned silver coins only, shall be issued from the mints within the territories of the East India Company.

First.—A rupee, to be denominated the Company's rupee, of the weight of 180 grains troy, and of the following standard, vizt .-

44 or 165 grains of pure silver.

17 or 15. ditto of alloy.

Second .- A half rupce of proportionate weight, and of the same standard.

Third .- A quarter rupee of ditto. Fourth.-A double rupee of ditto.

2. And be it enacted, that these coins shall bear on the obverse the head and the name of the reigning Sovereign of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, and on the reverse the designation of the coin in English and Persian, and the words "East India Company" in English, with such other embellishment as shall from time to time, be approved and ordered by the Governor General in Council.

And be it enacted, that the Company's rupee, half rupee and double rupee, shall be legal tender in satisfaction of all engagements, without the demand of any batta for wearage, provided the coins have not been clipped, filed, or defaced otherwise than by use.

And be it enacted, that the said rupee shall be received as equivalent to the Bombay, Madras, Furruckabad and Sonat rupecs, and to fifteen-sixteenths of the Calcutta Sicca rupee, and the half and double

rupees shall respectively also be received as equivalent to the half and double of the abovementioned Bombay, Madras, Furruckabad and Sonat rupees, and to the half and double of fifteen-sixteenths of the Calcutta sicca rupee

5. And be it enacted, that the Company's quarter rupee shall be legal tender only, in

payment of the fraction of a rupee

6. Provided that, if in any contract it be specially stipulated that if discharged at Madras or at Bombay or in the Agra-presidency, payment shall be made in the rupces now current in those presidencies respectively at a different rate from that above declared to be the relative intrinsic value thereof with reference to the Calcutta sicca rupce, then, and in all such cases, the contract shall be satisfied when discharged in any of the said presidencies by payment there of an equivalent amount of the rupces, half rupees, and double rupees, authorized to be coined by this Act, for the Furruckabad, Madras, or Bombay rupees so specially stipulated.

7. And be it enacted, that the undermentioned gold coins only, shall henceforth be coined in the mints of British India.

First,—A gold mohur or fifteen rupee piece of the weight of 180 gains troy, and of the following standard, vizt.

++ or 165 grains of pure gold.

Second .- A five rupee piece equal to a third of a gold mohur of proportionate weight and of the same standard.

Third.-A ten rupee piece equal to two thirds of a gold mohur of ditto,

Fourth,-A thirty rupee piece or double

gold mohur of ditto.

8. And be it enacted, that these coins shall bear on the obverse the head and name

of the reigning Sovereign of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, and on the reverse the designation of the coin in English and Persian, and the words "East India Company" in English, with such other embellishment as shall from time to time be approved and ordered by the Governor General in Council.

9. And be it enacted, that no gold coin shall henceforward be a legal tender of payment in any of the territories of the East In-

dia Company.

10. And be it enacted, that it shall be competent to the Governor General in Council in his executive capacity to direct the coining and issuing of all coins, coined and issued under the authority of this Act, and to establish, regulate and remove mints, any law hitherto in torce to the contrary notwithstanding.

Ordered, that the draft now read, be pub-

lished for general information.

Ordered, that the said draft be reconsidered at the first meeting of the Legislative Council of India, after the 11th day of August next.
