## Legislative Department.

FORT WILLIAM. THE 13TH MARCH, 1837.

The following Draft of a proposed Act was read in Council for the first time on the 13th March 1837.

ACT No.--- of 1837.

I. It is hereby enacted, in modification of Section XVIII. Regulation V. 1831, of the Bengal Code, that from the day of no Zillah or City Judge within the Territories subject to the Presidency of Fort William in Bengal, shall be precluded, by reason of the amount or value of the property for the recovery of which a Suit is instituted from referring that Suit to any Principal Sudder Ameen.

II. And it is hereby enacted, that if any Suit which according to the rules now in force, would be appealable to the King in Council, shall under the authority of this Act, be referred to a Principal Sudder Ameen, the Appeal from the decision of such Principal Sudder Ameen, shall be direct to the Court of Sudder Dewanny Adawlut, and shall be conducted in all respects according to the same rules as if it were an Appeal from the decision of a Zillah Judge to the said Court of Sudder Dewanny Adawlut.

Ordered, that the Draft now read be published

for general information.
Ordered, that the said Draft be re-considered at the first Meeting of the Legislative Council of India after the 28th day of April next.




