Legislative Council of India.

24th October 1857.

The following Act, passed by the Legislative Council of India, received the assent of the Right Honorable the Governor General on the 23rd October 1857, and is hereby promulgated for general information:—

ACT No. XXX. of 1857.

An Act for the Levy of Port-Dues and Fees in the Port of Calcutta.

Whereas it is necessary to fix the amount of the Port-dues and fees to be hereafter levied and taken in the Port of Calcutta, in accordance with the provisions of Act XXII. of 1855; It is enacted as follows:—

I. A Port-due, at a rate not exceeding the rate of

Port-due chargeable on sea-going vessels of twenty tons and upwards entering the Port.

four annas for every ton of burden, shall be chargeable in respect of every sea-going vessel, of the burden of twenty, tons and upwards, which shall enter the said Port.

II. Provided that no such due shall be chargeable in respect of any vessel which, having left the Port, is compelled to re-enter it by stress of weather, or in consequence of having sustained any damage.

III. Provided also that the Port-due chargeable in respect of Dhonies and country vessels employed in the coasting trade shall be at a

rate equal to one-half the rate chargeable in respect of other vessels; and such due shall not be chargeable oftener than once in sixty days in respect of the same vessel.

IV. Vessels entering the Port in ballast shall be charged with three-fourths of the Port-due which would otherwise be chargeable.

V. Tug Steamers and River Steamers belonging to the said Port shall be liable to the Port-due specified in Section I. of this Act;

and the said due shall be chargeable in respect of every such Steamer once between the 1st day of January and the 30th day of June, and once between the 1st day of July and the 31st day of December, in each year. The provisions of Section XLVI. Act XXII. of 1855 shall not be applicable to such Steamers.

VI. Within the said Port, fees may be charged for the following services at rates not exceeding those hereinafter specified, namely,—

VII. This Act shall commence and have effect from and after the first day of January 1858; and the local Government shall on or before that date, pursuant to Section XLII. Act XXII. of 1855, declare, by notification to be published in the *Calcutta Gazette*, the rates at which Port-dues and fees shall be levied in the said Port subject to the provisions of and within the limits prescribed by this Act; and from and after the said date no Port-due or fee shall be levied at the said Port except under the authority of Act XXII. of 1855 and of this Act.

VIII. This Act shall be read with and taken as a part of Act XXII. of 1855.

The following Act, passed by the Legislative Council of India, received the assent of the Right Honorable the Governor General on the 23rd October 1857, and is hereby promulgated for general information:—

ACT No. XXXI. OF 1857.

An Act for the Levy of Port-Dues and Fees in the Port of Bombay.

Whereas it is necessary to fix the amount of the Port-dues and fees to be hereafter levied and taken in the Port of Bombay, in accordance with the provisions of Act XXII. of 1855; It is enacted as follows:—

I. A Port-due, at a rate not exceeding the rate of Port-due chargeable on two annas for every ton of burthen, shall be chargeable in respect of every sea-going vessel, of the burthen of ten tons and upwards (except fishing-boats), which shall enter the said Port.

II. Provided that no such due shall be chargeable in respect of any vessel which, having left the Port, is compelled to re-enter it by stress of weather, or in consequence of having sustained any damage.

III. The Port-due chargeable under this Act shall not be chargeable oftener than once in the same calendar month in respect of the same vessel.

No vessels to pay Port-due oftener than once a month.

IV. Vessels entering the Port in ballast shall be charged with three-fourths of the Port-due which would otherwise be chargeable.

V. Within the said Port, fees may be charged for the following services at rates not exceeding those herein-after specified, namely,—

And also, that at the same time and place will be holden a Session of Admiralty, for the trial of all Treasons, Murders, Piracies, Robberies, Trespasses, Misdemeanors, and other Crimes and Offences, had, done, perpetrated, or committed on the High Seas.

And I hereby give notice to all persons bound to prosecute and give evidence at the above Sessions, or in any way concerned therein, that they are to attend at the time and place above mentioned, and not to depart without leave of the Court.

Rules for the Conduct of Assemblies and Processions

in the Public Roads, Streets, and Thoroughfares on the Island of Bombay and Colaba, and for keeping Order therein; made under authority of Section LXXVII. of Act XIII. of 1856, with the sanction of the Right Honorable the Governor in Council.

1. Assemblies or Processions passing along any Public Street, Road, or Thoroughfare, shall keep on the left side, and shall not occupy more than one-half of such Road, Street, or Thoroughfare, in order that there may be no obstruction to the passing and repassing of Horses, Vehicles, and Foot Passengers.

2. Assemblies and Religious or other Processions meeting Carriages or Horses shall immediately cease playing Country or other Music, and shall not recommence playing such Music until such Carriages or Horses shall have passed.

3. No unnecessary noise will be permitted in the neighbourhood of any Place of Public Worship during the hours of worship, and all Processions passing such Places of Worship, during the time of worship, shall cease playing Country or other Music, and proceed on without noise.

4. Corpses from those parts of the Town which lie to the South of the Waree Bunder, Baboola Tank, Obelisk and Grant Road, shall be conveyed by the Grant Road to the new Junction Road leading to the Bridge on Bellasis Road, and thence to the Place of Cremation and Burial recently opened out on the Flats at Byculla.

5. Any person or persons who shall wilfully violate or infringe any of the foregoing Rules shall be liable to the Penalty prescribed in the above quoted Section LXXVII. of the said Act XIII. of 1856.
