ACT PASSED BY THE GOVERNMENT OF INDIA.

HOME DEPARTMENT (Legislative).

The following Act of the Governor of India in Council received the Assent of His Excellency the Governor General on the 24th December 1862, and is hereby promulgated for general information :—

No. XXIV. of 1862.

An Act to continue in force Act XX. of 1862 (to provide for the levy of Fees and Stamp Duties in the High Court of Judicature at Fort William in Bengal; and to suspend the operation of certain Sections of Act VIII. of 1859 in the said High Court).

Whereas it is expedient that Act XX. of 1862

(to provide for the levy of Fees and Stamp Duties in the High Court of Judicature at Fort William in Bengal; and to suspend the operation of certain Sections of Act VIII. of 1859 in the said High Court) should con-

tinue in force for a further period of one year from the 1st day of January 1863: It is enacted as follows :—

Act XX. of 1862 continued till the 1st of January 1864.

I. Act XX. of 1862 shall continue in force until the first day of January 1864.

II. The following words shall be read as if they had been added to Section VI. of the said Act XX. of 1862 :—“The High Court may also by its own rules fix the time

within which applications for the review of any judgment passed by any Division Court or by any Judge or Judges of the said High Court in the exercise of its original Civil jurisdiction shall be preferred.”
