PROCEEDINGS OF THE LEGISLATIVE DEPARTMENT, BOMBAY.

THE following Extract from the Proceedings of the Council of the Governor of Bombay, assembled for the purpose of making Laws and Regulations under the Provisions of the Act of Parliament, 24 and 25 Victoria, Chapter 67, is published for the information of all whom it may concern :—

The Council met at Bombay, on Wednesday, the 11th February 1863.

PRESENT :—

His Excellency Sir H. B. E. FRERE, K.C.B., Governor of Bombay, Presiding.

Mr. FRERE moved that the consideration of the Reports of Select Committees upon (1) Bills for regulating the District and (2) Village Police, (3) for enabling Magistrates to depute to Subordinate Magistrates the trial of certain offences, and (4) for entrusting Landholders with the charge of Police within their respective lands, be postponed until the next meeting of the Council.

Carried.

Mr. ROBERTSON moved the Second Reading of the Bill for the Summary Settlement of Claims to exemption from the payment of Land Revenue in the Districts not subject to the operation of Act XI. of 1852.

This was *carried*, and the Bill was read a second time and passed.

Mr. TRISTRAM then moved that a "Bill to confer certain powers on the Bombay Gas Company Limited" be read a first time and referred for report to a Select Committee composed of—

And the MOVER.

With instructions to report at the next Meeting but one of the Council.

This was put and carried.

The PRESIDENT then adjourned the Council until Wednesday the 18th Instant, at 2 P. M.
