PROCEEDINGS OF THE LEGISLATIVE DEPARTMENT, BOMBAY.

THE following Report of the Select Committee of the Council of the Governor of Bombay for the purpose of making Laws and Regulations, together with the Bill, is published for general information :—

Report of the Select Committee appointed to consider and report on a " Bill to amend Act XV. of 1858 for the levy of Port-dues in the Port of Aden."

The Committee have struck out the words included within the parenthesis at the end of the 1st Section as superfluous.

In Section II. they have substituted three for two annas per ton as the highest limit of the dues leviable. It appears necessary to the Committee that this margin should be left to the Government as the Aden Port Fund is considerably in debt, and some further outlay will probably have to be incurred in laying down buoys and in other improvements which they understand on good authority are much required.

With these alterations the Committee recommend the Bill for adoption.

A Bill to amend Act XV. of 1858 for the levy of Port-dues in the Port of Aden.

Whereas the proceeds of the Port-dues levied in the Port of Aden have been found insufficient to defray the ordinary expenses of the harbour, and it is expedient that the said dues be increased, it is enacted as follows:—

I. Section I. of Act XV. of 1858, of the Legislative Council of India is repealed from and after the 30th day of June, A.D. 1863.

Repeal of Section I. of Act XV. of 1858.

II. From and after the 1st day of July 1863, it shall be lawful to charge and levy in respect of every sea-going vessel of the burden of ten tons and upwards which shall enter the Port of Aden, port-dues at such rate not exceeding three annas for every ton of burden, as the Governor in Council may order.

Section II. of the Act to be read as part of Act XV. of 1858.

III. Section II. of this Act shall be read and taken as a part of Act XV. of 1858.
