MEMORANDUM required by paragraph 4 of the Government Circular, General Department, No. 3314, dated the 13th November 1856.

The scheme of taxation sanctioned by Government for all the Municipalities in the Belgaum Collectorate consists simply of a House-Tax, the maximum and minimum rate of which in each town, and the No. and date of the Government sanction are as follows:—

2. The items of Revenue surrendered by Government to the Municipalities are the fines imposed under the provisions of Act XVI. of 1841. The sanction of Government to this measure was accorded provisionally in paragraph 1 of their Resolution No. 895, dated the 10th April 1853. This will cease in future.

3. Realisations have been credited during the year to which the accounts relate from each and all of the sources of Revenue authorised by Government.

4. No Revenue has been derived from any unauthorised source during the year.

5. No conditions have been made with regard to the fines under Act XXI. of 1841 which have been surrendered to the Municipalities.

6. A Statement of the Strength and Cost of each Municipal Establishment authorised by Government is appended, with the No. and Date of the Government authority.

7. The Strength and Cost of the Establishment during each month of the year to which the accounts relate have been within the limits of the authority accorded.

SIR,

With reference to the Municipal Accounts of the Town of Hoongul for the year ending 30th April 1862, which form accompaniment No. 9 to your letter No. 22, dated 20th January 1863, I have the honour to request that you will inform me why the large balance of Rs. 2,026-15-0, brought to account at the beginning of the year, was allowed to accumulate up to that date, and why no expenditure was made during the year last accounted for, either for cleansing the town or in any way improving it.

2. I observe that the operation of Act XXVI. of 1850 should have been suspended in this town in A.D. 1860-61 on receipt of the Government order dated 24th January 1861. You will kindly explain from what date the suspension took effect, and under what authority taxes to the amount of Rs. 325-5-6 were levied during the year 1861-62, and a disbursement of Rs. 20-10-2 made on account of establishments, though none was made on account of works on scavenging.
