





tion, and which shall have been or shall be remanded by any Appellate Court, shall be tried before the Court that would be competent to try such suit if instituted after the date on which the said Act came into operation.

IV. All applications for Execution, and Execution of Decrees. all Decrees or Orders, which, but for the passing of the said Act, would have been

made to, or executed by, any Court or Officer existing at the date on which the said Act came into operation, shall be made to or executed by the Court or Officer who would have had jurisdiction in respect of such matter, had the suit or proceeding in which the application, decree, or order was made, been instituted after the date on which the said Act came into operation.
