SENATE.

A Meeting of the SENATE was held in the Durbar Room, Town Hall, on *Tuesday*, the 2nd July 1867, at 4½ P.M.

The Minutes of the last Meeting were read and confirmed.

2. It was proposed by the Rev. John Wilson, D.D., F.R.S., and seconded by J. G. Bühler, Ph.D., that the words "and Licentiate" be inserted between the words "Master" and "of Civil Engineering" in line 19, and the words "or Licentiates of Civil Engineering" after the word "Medicine" in the last line, on page 116 of the University Calendar for 1867-68.—*Carried.*

3. It was proposed by Bál Mangesh Wágale, M.A., LL.B., and seconded by T. B. Kirkham, Esq., that for the words "I assent to this Application" (Date) in Form A. on page 91 of the Calendar for 1867-68, the following words be substituted:—

"I certify that _____ has been (in my School) or (under my tuition) from _____ to _____ and that I assent to the above Application."

Enter day and year. }

N. B.—If the period of school attendance or tuition named in the certificate be less than one year, the Applicant must forward *another* application with the certificate signed by his last previous Teacher, so as to cover altogether more than a year."

It was proposed as an amendment by the Rev. John Wilson, D.D., F.R.S., which was seconded by F. Broughton, F.R.C.S., that the above proposition be carried with the substitution of the words "not less than a year" for the words "more than a year" in the N. B. of the same.

The amendment was put to the vote and *Carried.*

4. Proposed by the Rev. John Wilson, D.D., F.R.S., and seconded by the Rev. James Aitken, that the words "at Bombay" be inserted between the words "year, and commencing" in Arts Reg. 1, and that Reg. 2 in Arts be removed, and that the numbers of the Regulations following be changed accordingly.—*Carried.*

5. Proposed by the Rev. John Wilson, D.D., F.R.S., and seconded by K. M. Chatfield, B.A.,

That Reg. 28 in Arts after the words "commencement of the examination," read thus:—"The Examiners will arrange in two classes, each in alphabetical order, and publish the names of the Candidates who have passed. Those placed in the First Class will be considered to have taken Honours in the B. A. Examination."—*Carried.*

6. Proposed by the Rev. John Wilson, D.D., F.R.S., and seconded by Náráyan Vásudev, Esq.,

That Reg. 30 run as follows:—

"MASTER OF ARTS.

The Examinations for the Degree of Master of Arts will be held annually in Bombay, commencing on the First Monday in the First Term in Arts."—*Carried.*

7. Proposed by the Rev. John Wilson, D.D., F.R.S., and seconded by F. Broughton, F.R.C.S., That Regulations 31, 32, 33, 35, 36, 37, and 42 be omitted.—*Carried.*

8. Proposed by the Rev. John Wilson, D.D., F.R.S., and seconded by Bál Mangesh Wágale, M.A., LL.B.,

That in Reg. 38 the word "other" be omitted, and after the words "pass the examination," be added the words "in any one of the above branches."—*Carried.*

9. Proposed by the Rev. John Wilson, D.D., F.R.S., and seconded by T. B. Kirkham, Esq.,

That Reg. 43 stand as follows:—

"In the week following the Examinations, the Examiners in each branch will arrange in two classes alphabetically, and publish the names of those Candidates who have passed. Those placed in the First Class in any branch of the M. A. Examination shall be considered to have taken Honours in that branch. Certificates of having passed the M. A. Examination will be given under Form L."—*Carried.*

10. Proposed by the Rev. John Wilson, D.D., F.R.S., and seconded by J. G. Bühler, Ph.D., that the following recommendation of the Syndicate be referred back to the Syndicate for review:—

That a new Regulation be added as follows:—

"44. There will be no objection to any Candidate who has passed in one branch of the M. A. Examination voluntarily presenting himself subsequently for examination in a second branch on a new application being forwarded and fresh fee paid."—*Carried.*
