Applications for land required for Cotton Yards on the shore of Beilcool Cave, at Karwar, North Canara, will be received by the Collector of Canara, on the following Conditions:—

1. The land will be assigned free of rent, on thirty years' lease, resumable by Government (if the land is required for public purposes) after 15 years, by giving one year's notice, and renewable for 15 years longer or 45 years in all, if the land is not required for a public purpose at the end of 30 years' lease. The value of the buildings on the sites will be paid by Government on resumption, by the usual terms of arbitration when land is resumed for public purposes.

2. The sites will be of from one to two acres in extent each.

The lessee shall, during the first official year, commencing 1st May immediately following the date of his being put in possession, export from Karwar 1,000 pressed bales of Cotton, or 3,000 doceras for each acre of his grant, and double that amount for each subsequent year, under certain penalties.

Full particulars as to terms and conditions of grant can be ascertained on application to the Collector of Canara, or Superintendent of Karwar.
