BOMBAY TO WIT.—By virtue of a Precept to me directed, I hereby Proclaim and give Notice, that the Fourth Sessions of 1867 of Oyer and Terminer, and General Gaol Delivery, will be holden before the High Court of Judicature at Bombay, at the Court House, on TUESDAY, the 10th day of September next, at 10 o'clock in the forenoon, for the trial of all Treasons, Murders, and other Felonies, Perjuries, Trespasses, and other Crimes, Misdemeanors, and Offences, had, done, or committed within the Town and Island of Bombay, and the Limits thereof, and the Factories subordinate thereto; and also to inquire, hear, and determine in the like manner all Treasons, Murders, Felonies, Forgeries, Perjuries, Crimes, Extortions, Misdemeanors, Offences, Wrongs, and Oppressions, had, done, or committed, by any of Her Majesty's British Subjects in any of the Territories which now are subject to, or dependent upon, the Government of Bombay, or within any of the Dominions of the Native Princes of India in alliance with the said Government.

And also, that at the same time and place, will be holden a Session of Admiralty, for the trial of all Treasons, Murders, Piracies, Robberies, Felonies, Misdemeanors, Offences, and other Maritime Crimes whatsoever, done or committed on the High Seas.

And I hereby give Notice to all persons bound to prosecute and give evidence at the above Sessions, or in any way concerned therein, that they are to attend at the time and place abovementioned, and not to depart without leave of the Court.

And I hereby give Notice to all Justices of the Peace, Coroners, Escheators, and also all Chief Constables and Bailiffs of the Town and Island of Bombay and the Limits thereof, that they be then and there in their own persons, with their Rolls, Records, Indictments, and other remembrances, to do those things which to their offices in that behalf appertain to be done.—Dated the 24th day of August 1867, and in the Thirty-first year of the Reign of Her Majesty Queen Victoria.

3. They will also be cashed by the Currency Officer in charge of the Circle of Currency, Kurra- chee, to the extent of one Lakh of Rupees.

4. From and after this date the Bombay series of Nagpore Notes will be counterstamped by the Assistant Commissioner of Currency at Nagpore, and this series of counterstamped Notes will be transferred by debit to the Issue Department for issue in exchange for current coin of the Government of India.

The Public are also informed that the new pattern of Currency Notes for Rupees 1,000, from this date will be issued from the Exchange Department, Nagpore. They will circulate concurrently with the old pattern notes of Rupees 1,000, until the latter are gradually withdrawn from circulation. The distinguishing marks of the new pattern Notes of Rupees 1,000 have been described in the Currency Notification of the *Calcutta Gazette*, dated 1st July 1867. They are as follows:—The value of the Note is printed in letters at the upper part and in figures

at both sides of the Note in the Persian, Muhujonie Nagree, and Bengali characters. The value is also printed in green across the Note. The number of the note is printed in Black Ink on a Green medallion.
