PROCEEDINGS OF THE LEGISLATIVE DEPARTMENT, BOMBAY.

The following Bill, together with the Statement of Objects and Reasons accompanying it, is published in accordance with Rule 15 of the Rules for the conduct of Business at Meetings of the Council of His Excellency the Governor of Bombay for making Laws and Regulations:—

Bill No. 8 of 1878.

A Bill to further amend Act XIII. of 1856.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the section substituted by section 2 of Bombay Act I. of 1872 for section 17 of Act XIII. of 1856, in manner hereinafter appearing; It is enacted as follows:—

1. For the word "pay" in the said	section the words

17, Act XIII. of 1856.	official allowances" shall be substituted.

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS.

It has recently been brought to the notice of Government that whilst sections 18 and 19 of Act XIII. of 1856, as amended by sections 4 and 5 of Bombay Act I. of 1872, entitle members of the Bombay Police Force to have their pensions calculated on their salary and "authorized official allowances," section 17 of the same Act, as amended by section 2 of Bombay Act I. of 1872, renders their "pay" alone liable to contributions to the Superannuation Fund, and that the word "pay" has been understood not to include "authorized official allowances." It appears, however, to be but reasonable that the contributions to the Fund should be calculated upon the same basis as the pensions. This Bill has, therefore, been drafted for the purpose of amending the law in this respect.
